

10797 Gabby's Party Room

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Gabby's Party Room (10797) is the ultimate disco playset for fans of DreamWorks Animation's Gabby's Dollhouse. This kids' entertainment toy develops confidence, concentration, and problem-solving skills in preschoolers aged 4+.

This toy for girls and boys is a disco party playset and lots more! With Gabby, Daniel James 'DJ' Catnip, Kitty Fairy, and Mercat characters and a variety of music party toys – including a push-along party bus with a built-in keyboard, a rotatable dance floor, guitar, 2 microphones, and a sparkling disco ball – the stage is set for endless imaginative play! Accessories include balloons and roller skates for the roller disco, popcorn and 2 glasses full of slush ice for the chill-out zone, and a catapult and cans for the knock-down game. There's a cake for Gabby and packages with gifts inside delivered down the playset's slide. The set comes with a large Starter Brick to help kids get building. A colorful picture-story guide provides intuitive instructions.

Dollhouse disco playset – Gabby's Party Room is a fun-packed kids' entertainment toy for boys and girls aged 4+ who love DreamWorks Animation's Gabby's Dollhouse.

Party toys for role play – Includes Daniel James 'DJ' Catnip's party bus with a rotatable dance floor, guitar, 2 microphones, balloons, speakers, popcorn, slushy machines, and a sparkly disco ball.

Gabby and animal figures – The set includes a Gabby mini-doll figure and Daniel James 'DJ' Catnip, Kitty Fairy, and Mercat figures from the Gabby's Dollhouse TV series.

Imaginative pretend play – Entertainment toys include a catapult with cans to knock down and a slide to deliver Gabby's gifts.

252-piece Gabby's Dollhouse disco playset – The large party room measures over 4 in. (11 cm) high, 14in. (37 cm) wide and 2 in. (7 cm) deep.

The front of the box shows Gabby's party room in the back! It is a large room that has its own cat ears! The room is equipped with juice dispensers, banners and balloons, music, a stage with a mic, and presents! In the front, there is a slide with a large cake as well as a truck with a piano!

The back of the box shows all the accessories that this set comes with! It comes with 4 minifigures, a guitar, balloon dog, helmet, cat ears, skates, a slide and cake, piano truck, catapult, and Gabby's Party Room!

The top of the box shows a real-sized image of Daniel James 'DJ' Catnip!

The build is 252 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the left side of the party room.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the middle of the party room.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the right side of the party room.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for the piano truck.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for the slide and cake.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/10797>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one

or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 5 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Cat Mermaid and Toys

Steps 6 to 7

Locate 1 mint blue cat head printed with blue and pink mermaid scales, big white and black eyes, and red cheeks and 1 mermaid body printed with a purple tail and a dress made of blue and purple scales.
Assemble your minifigure and put her aside.

Steps 8 to 11.1

Place 1 light blue 2x2 round tile on top of a transparent blue 2x2 round brick so there is no overhang.
Then place it in front of you!

Group 2 - Toys

Steps 8 to 11.2

Place 1 light pink 2x2 round tile on top of a transparent pink 2x2 round brick so there is no overhang.
Then place it in front of you!

Group 3 - Toys

Steps 8 to 11.3

Place 1 light yellow 2x2 round tile on top of a transparent yellow 2x2 round brick so there is no overhang.
Then place it in front of you!

Now stack the 3 parts into a tower. Put 2 on the surface next to each other then put 1 on top so it is centered!

Now let's make the catapult to knock down these toys!

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place a lime green 4x8 half-circle plate in front of you so the rounded side faces the front. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 tile with 2 holes on the back 2 rows and 3rd column from the left.

Steps 14 to 15

Insert a light grey 2L pin into the right-facing top hole of the previous tile. Then insert the hole of a black catapult into the pin so the studs are in the back.

Steps 16 to 17

Place a transparent pink 1x1 round brick on the rightmost stud of the 2nd row from the back. Then place a gold 1x1 star on the 2nd stud from the right and 2nd row from the front. It should sit diagonal to the previous round brick.

Steps 18 to 19

Now place another transparent pink 1x1 round brick on its side in the catapult. Then use your finger to fling it! Try to hit the tower of bricks! Now put everything away while we build the party room!

Group 4 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place a purple 8x16 plate in front of you.

Steps 22 to 23

Then horizontally place a light blue 1x6 brick in the back left corner so there is no overhang.

Steps 24 to 25

Then horizontally place a lime green 1x4 brick on top of the previous brick in the back left corner so there is no overhang.

You will have an extra lime green 1x2 brick. Save it for later.

Group 5 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place a lime green 1x2 brick from group 4 to the right of the 1x4 brick. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x2 brick on top of the bricks in the back left corner of the build.

Steps 28 to 29

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 brick to the right of the previous yellow brick.

Steps 30 to 31

Horizontally place an orange 1x3x2 sloped curved brick in the back left corner on top of the bricks so it slopes to the left. Then place an orange 1x1 brick to the right.

Steps 32 to 33

Place an orange 1x1 brick on top of the previous 1x1 brick. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick with an extended rounded part to the right so the extended part faces the back.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a transparent purple 1x6x5 brick printed with a banner with purple, blue, and yellow ribbons, a bunch of cat outlines, balloons, and a butterfly, all in the same colors to the right of all the previous bricks so it sits on the back row of the plate. Make sure the print faces the front!

Group 6 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 36 to 37

Place a black 1x1 brick with a clip in the back right corner of the plate so the clip faces the right. Then place a light blue 1x1 brick to the left. Then place a light blue 2x2 brick to the left so it sits on the back 2 rows.

Steps 38 to 39

Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 brick on top of the previous bricks so it sits in the back right corner of the build. Then horizontally place a transparent blue 1x2 panel in front of the left 2 studs of the previous 1x4 brick so it sits on the front row of the 2x2 brick and the long wall faces the front.

Group 7 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 40 to 41

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 brick on top of the previous brick so it sits in the back right corner.

Group 8 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 42 to 45

Horizontally stack 2 orange 1x4 bricks on top of the previous brick so it sits in the back right corner.

Steps 46 to 47

Horizontally place a pink 1x6 brick on top of the previous brick so it sits on the back right corner and does not overhang.

Steps 48 to 49

Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the left of the previous 1x6 brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 sloped curved brick to the left so it slopes to the left.

Steps 50 to 51

Vertically place 2 yellow 1x2 tiles with an overhead bar, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column in front of the bricks so the bars face the left.

Group 9 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 52 to 53

Vertically place a transparent yellow 1x2 brick on the leftmost column in front of the previous 1x2 tiles with an overhead bar. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile to the right of the back stud of the previous 1x2 brick.

Steps 54 to 55

Vertically place a transparent yellow 1x2 brick to the right of the previous 1x4 tile so the back stud is aligned with the tile.

Steps 56 to 57

Horizontally place a lime green 2x6 tile on top of the 2 previous transparent yellow 1x2 bricks.

Steps 58 to 59.1

Place a yellow 2x2 tile in the front right corner of the build so there is no overhang. Then place a white and grey 2x2 turntable plate to the left.

Group 10 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 58 to 59.2

Place an orange 2x2 tile behind the previous 2x2 turntable plate.

Group 11 - Left Side Of Party Room

Steps 58 to 59.3

Place a red 2x2 tile to the left of the previous 2x2 turntable plate.

Steps 60 to 61

Place a light blue 2x2 plate with 6 gear teeth on top of the 2x2 turntable plate so it is centered.

Steps 62 to 63

Place a gold 1x1 star to the left of the back row of the red 2x2 tile so there are 2 free columns in between. Then place another one behind the left column of the red 2x2 tile so there are 2 free rows in between.

Steps 64 to 65

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick in front of you. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front and there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick on top so there is no overhang. Then place another white 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front. Now place a transparent pink 2x2 dish upright on the lower side stud.

Steps 66 to 67

Now horizontally place your part on the 2 rightmost columns of the build so it sits in front of the bricks and the dish faces the front.

Steps 68 to 69

Place a pink music note-shaped tile upright on the top side stud of your previous part so the tip faces up. Then place a pink microphone with cat ears to the left so it sits in the transparent blue 1x2 panel.

Steps 70 to 71

Let's make a part! Place a red 2x2 inverted dome brick on the table. Then place a red 2x2 dome brick on top. Now insert the side with a stop of a white bar into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. Then insert the barhole of a white clip into the bottom of the bar! This is a balloon!

Steps 72 to 73

Now attach the clip of your balloon to the bar of the back 1x2 tile that is on the leftmost column.

Group 12 - Left Side of Party Room

Steps 74 to 75

Let's make a part! Place a lime green 2x2 inverted dome brick on the table. Then place a lime green 2x2 dome brick with cat ears on top so the ears are at the left and right. Now insert the side with a stop of a white bar into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. Then insert the barhole of a white clip into the bottom of the bar! This is a balloon with cat ears!

Steps 76 to 77

Attach the clip of your balloon to the bar of the front 1x2 tile that is on the leftmost column. Make sure the ears are still left and right!

Steps 78 to 79

Locate a large ear-shaped film. This film has a silver side and a side with a rainbow-shaped ear with a pink bottom. Vertically insert the gap of the film into the back-facing side on the left so it sits in the extended rounded part of the 1x2x2 brick. The ear should bend to the left and the rainbow side should face the front!

Steps 80 to 81

Now locate your tower of 3 round bricks with tiles on top. Place them on top of the 2x6 tile in the front left of the build so they make a tower! Now you can use your catapult to knock them over!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 13 - Middle of Party Room

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 pair of legs printed with a light blue skirt, purple leggings, and white shoes, 1 torso printed with a pink, white, light blue, and purple striped shirt with cat ears on each stripe, 1 tan head printed with black eyes and red lips, 1 pink hair, 1 pink cat ears, and 1 pink guitar with cat ears. Assemble your minifigure, put the cat ears on her hair, then put the guitar in her hands!

Steps 6 to 7

Let's make a mic stand now! Place a transparent pink 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Then place a black mic stand with a clip on top so the ridges at the bottom faces the front.

Steps 8 to 9

Attach a pink mic with cat ears to the clip so the mic faces the left. Now put Gabby in front of the mic so she can play guitar and sing!

Steps 10 to 11

Let's make a part! Place a light orange 2x2 box with a car face in front of you so the face faces the front. Now place a light orange 1x1 star inside. It should not attach to any studs!

Steps 12 to 13

Place a purple 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the box. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now put everything away so we can build the middle of the party room!

Steps 14 to 15

Place a purple 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front.

Steps 16 to 17

Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile on the back row so it is centered. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 brick with a bar to the left and right so the bars face outwards.

Steps 18 to 19

Horizontally place 2 teal 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, in front of the left 1x2 brick so they slope to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 20 to 21

Vertically place a transparent yellow 1x2 tile on top of the 2 sloped curved bricks on the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 22 to 23.1

Place a yellow 2x2 tile to the right of the 2 sloped curved bricks that are on the left.

Group 15 - Middle of Party Room

Steps 22 to 23.2

Place a red 2x2 tile to the right of the previous 2x2 tile.

Group 16 - Middle of Party Room

Steps 22 to 23.3

Place a lime green 2x2 tile in front of the previous red 2x2 tile.

Group 17 - Middle of Party Room

Steps 22 to 23.4

Place an orange 2x2 tile to the left of the previous lime green 2x2 tile. All together they should form a 4x4 tile area!

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place a transparent pink 1x2x5 brick in the back left corner of the build so it sits on the 1x2 brick with a clip. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place a pink 1x6 arch brick on top of the 2 previous bricks so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 28 to 29

Place a transparent pink 1x1 round brick to the left and right of the previous arch brick.

Steps 30 to 31

Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs on top of the arch brick so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

Steps 32 to 33

Horizontally place a pink 1x4 sloped curved tile on top of the previous plate so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 34 to 35

Locate a white 3x3 round tile printed with a cat disco ball with a grid of the colors, dark grey, blue, yellow, and pink. Place it upright on the front-facing 2x2 side studs of the 1x2 plate so it is centered. Make sure the cat ears of the disco ball are on top! Ask a sighted person to check!

Steps 36 to 37

Horizontally place a light pink 1x2 tri-sloped tile to the left and right of the 1x4 sloped curved tile so they slope to the back.

Steps 38 to 39

Locate your mic stand that you previously made! Place it in front of the front left 2x2 tile so the right column of your part aligns with the left column of the tile. Make sure the mic faces the back right.

Steps 40 to 41

Now place Gabby in front of the mic so she can sing!

You can attach this build to the left side of the party room by attaching the left-facing bar to the right-facing clip.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 18 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 4 to 5

Place a white 1x1 brick printed with vertical lines of red and white and a thought bubble with the word pop on it in front of you so the print faces the front. Then place a white 1x1 ice cream scoops on top! This is not ice cream scoops but actually popcorn! Then place a pink cat fairy with a light green dress and wings beside your popcorn! Now put this away while we build the party room!

Steps 6 to 7

Horizontally place a purple 8x16 plate in front of you.

Steps 8 to 9

Horizontally place a light blue 1x6 brick in the back right corner of the plate.

Steps 10 to 11

Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 brick on top of the previous brick in the back right corner.

You will have an extra light green 1x2 brick. Save it for later.

Group 19 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 brick on top of the previous 1x4 brick in the back right corner. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 brick from group 18 to the left of the 1x4 brick.

Steps 14 to 15

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 brick to the left of the yellow 1x2 brick that is in the back right corner.

Steps 16 to 17

Horizontally place an orange 1x3x2 sloped curved brick in the back right corner on top of the previous bricks so it slopes to the right. Then place an orange 1x1 brick to the left.

Steps 18 to 19

Place an orange 1x1 brick on top of the previous 1x1 brick. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick with an extended rounded part to the left so the rounded part faces the back.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place a transparent purple 1x6x5 brick printed with yellow, pink, and blue banners, and a bunch of balloons, in the shape of a balloon dog, butterfly, and cats all in the same colors!

Group 20 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 22 to 23

Place a black 1x1 brick with a clip in the back left corner of the build so the clip faces the left. Then place a light blue 1x1 brick to the right. Then place a light blue 2x2 brick to the right so it sits on the back 2 rows.

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place a lime green 1x4 brick in the back left corner on top of the previous bricks so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2 panel in front of the right 2 studs of the previous brick so the long wall faces the front.

Group 21 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 brick in the back left corner on top of the previous 1x4 brick.

Group 22 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 28 to 31

Horizontally stack 2 orange 1x4 bricks on top of the previous 1x4 brick.

Steps 32 to 33

Horizontally place a pink 1x6 brick in the back left corner on top of the previous bricks so there is no overhang.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick to the right. Then horizontally place a pink 1x6 sloped curved brick to the right so it slopes to the right.

Steps 36 to 37

Vertically place 2 yellow 1x2 tiles with a bar overhead, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column of the build so the bar faces the right.

Group 23 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 38 to 39

Vertically place a transparent yellow 1x2 brick on the rightmost column in front of the previous tiles with a bar. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile to the left of the back stud of the previous brick.

Steps 40 to 41

Vertically place a transparent yellow 1x2 brick to the left of the 1x4 tile so the back stud aligns with the tile.

Steps 42 to 43

Horizontally place a yellow 2x6 plate on top of the 2 previous bricks.

Steps 44 to 45

Horizontally place a white 1x3 brick in the back right corner of the previous 2x6 plate.

Steps 46 to 47

Then place a white 1x1 brick with a bar in front of the left and right studs of the previous 1x3 brick so the bars face the front.

Group 24 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 48 to 49.1

Vertically place a light blue 1x2 brick on top of the right 1x1 brick with a bar and right stud of the 1x3 brick so there is no overhang.

Group 25 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 48 to 49.2

Vertically place a transparent orange 1x2 brick on top of the left 1x1 brick with a bar and left stud of the 1x3 brick so there is no overhang. These are juice dispensers!

Steps 50 to 51

Vertically place a white 1x2 jumper tile on top of each of the 1x2 bricks of the juice dispensers so there is no overhang.

Steps 52 to 53

Let's make a part! Place a transparent wine glass in front of you. Then place a teal 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the back. Then place a pink 1x1 sphere with cat ears on top so the ears are at the left and right.

Steps 54 to 55

Now place your part on the front row and 2nd stud from the left on top of the 2x6 plate that the juice dispensers are on.

Group 26 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 56 to 57

Let's make a part! Place a transparent wine glass in front of you. Then place an orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the left. Then place a pink 1x1 sphere with cat ears on top so the ears are at the left and right.

Steps 58 to 59

Now place your part on the back left corner of the 2x6 plate so the leaves face the left.

Steps 60 to 61

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick in front of you. Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front and there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick on top so there is no overhang. Then place another white 1x2 brick with a side stud on top so the side stud faces the front. Now place a transparent pink 2x2 dish upright on the lower side stud.

Steps 62 to 63

Horizontally place your part on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the bricks so the dish faces the front.

Steps 64 to 65

Place a pink music note-shaped tile upright on the top side stud of your previous part so the tip faces up. Then place a white and pink headband with cat ears to the right so it sits in the transparent blue 1x2 panel.

Steps 66 to 67

Place a light blue 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front and the 5th and 6th columns from the left.

You will have an extra light green 1x2 slope tile. Save it for later.

Group 27 - Right Side of Party Room

Steps 68 to 69

Horizontally place a light orange 2x4 inverted sloped curved brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 panel on the back row so it is centered and the wall faces the back. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 jumper plate in front so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 slope tile to the left so it slopes to the right. Then vertically place a light green 1x2 slope tile from group 26 to the right so it slopes to the left.

Steps 70 to 71

Horizontally place your part on top of the previous 2x2 plate so it is centered horizontally. Make sure the 1x2 panel is still on the back!

Steps 72 to 73

Place a light orange 1x1 star on the 2nd row from the front and the 2nd column from the left. Then place another 1 on the 5th row from the front and the 9th column from the left.

Steps 74 to 75

Let's make a part! Place a light blue 2x2 inverted dome brick on the table. Then place a light blue 2x2 dome brick on top. Now insert the side with a stop of a white bar into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. Then insert the barhole of a white clip into the bottom of the bar! This is a balloon!

Steps 76 to 77

Attach the clip of your balloon to the bar of the back 1x2 tile that is on the rightmost column.

Steps 78 to 79

Let's make a part! Place a light green 2x2 inverted dome brick on the table. Then place a light green 2x2 dome brick with cat ears on top so the ears are at the left and right. Now insert the side with a stop of a white bar into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. Then insert the barhole of a white clip into the bottom of the bar! This is a balloon!

Steps 80 to 81

Attach the clip of your balloon to the bar of the front 1x2 tile that is on the rightmost column so the ears are left and right.

Steps 82 to 83

Locate a large ear-shaped film. This film has a silver side and a side with a rainbow-shaped ear with a pink bottom. Vertically insert the gap of the film into the back-facing side on the right so it sits in the extended rounded part of the 1x2x2 brick. The ear should bend to the right and the rainbow side should face the front!

Steps 84 to 85

Now locate the popcorn you previous made and place it on the front row on the 8th column from the right so the popcorn print faces the front!

You can attach this build to the middle of the party room using the left-facing clip!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

Group 29 - Cat and Piano

Steps 4 to 5

Locate a purple cat with big eyes, an open mouth, and cat symbol on its chest, and 4 legs. Place it in front of you!

Steps 6 to 7

Let's make a piano! Horizontally place a lime green 2x6 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front. Then horizontally place 2 white 1x2 tiles printed with piano keys on the back row so they are centered and the small black keys face the front.

Group 29 - Piano Truck

Steps 8 to 9

Horizontally place a purple 4x10 car base with arches and pins in front of you.

Steps 10 to 13

Insert 4 white wheels into 4 black tires.

Steps 14 to 15

Insert your wheels into the front and back pins of the car base so the concave side of the wheel faces outwards.

Steps 16 to 17

Place 3 lime green 2x2 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in the 2x6 gap of the car.

Steps 18 to 19

Vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the bar faces the left.

Steps 20 to 21

Place a light blue 2x2 sloped curved tile on top so it slopes to the right.

Steps 22 to 23

Place a purple 2x2 tile with a stud to the right. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 brick to the right. They should both be centered vertically.

Steps 24 to 25

Vertically place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous 1x2 brick. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 tile with an overhead bar to the right so the bar faces the left.

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place a purple 1x2x3 brick in the back left and front left corner of the build so there is no overhang.

Steps 28 to 29

Vertically place 2 pink 1x4 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous 2 bricks.

Steps 30 to 31

Horizontally place a purple 1x6 brick on the back row to the right of the 1x2x3 brick.

Steps 32 to 33

Horizontally place a purple 1x2 brick on the front row to the right of the 1x2x3 brick. Then horizontally place a dark purple 1x2 brick with a side stud to the right so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place another purple 1x2 brick to the right.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a light blue 1x6 tile on the back row on top of the 1x6 brick so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x6 plate on the front row on top of the previous bricks so there is no overhang.

Steps 36 to 37

Then place a light orange 1x1 star on the front-facing side stud.

Group 32 - Piano Truck

Steps 38 to 39

Vertically place a yellow 1x2 brick on the rightmost column of the build so it is centered vertically.

Steps 40 to 41

Vertically place a purple 1x2 brick with a side stud on top of the previous brick so the side stud faces the right.

Steps 42 to 43

Vertically place a yellow 1x2 brick on top of the previous brick so there is no overhang.

Steps 44 to 45

Horizontally place a purple 1x2x3 brick in the back right and front right corners of the build so there is no overhang.

Steps 46 to 47

Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a light purple 1x4 tile with 2 studs to the left so it is centered vertically.

Steps 48 to 49

Vertically place a pink 1x4 sloped curved tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.

Steps 50 to 51

Place a purple 1x1 slope brick on the front and back studs of the previous 1x4 tile so they slope inwards.

Steps 52 to 53

Place a light purple 4x4 dish printed with a cat face with whiskers and pink star-shaped eyes on the right-facing side stud of the 1x2 brick so it is centered.

Steps 54 to 55

Place a light blue 1x1 round tile on top of the previous 4x4 dish. Then horizontally place a pink 1x4 sloped curved tile upright on the upper row of the right-facing 2x4 set of side studs so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 56 to 57

Let's make a part! Place a red 2x2 inverted dome brick on the table. Then place a red 2x2 dome brick on top. Now insert the side with a stop of a white bar into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. This is a balloon!

Steps 58 to 59

Insert the bar of the balloon into the stud of the 2x2 tile that is to the right of the 2 1x4 sloped curved tiles that are on the 2 leftmost columns.

Steps 60 to 61

Place a white bar with a bar hole in front of you so the clip faces the right. Insert the bar of a curved thick bar into the bar hole of the clip.

Steps 62 to 63

Attach the clip of your part to the left-facing bar of the build so the curved thick bar is upright and faces the left.

Steps 64 to 65

Now locate the piano that you previously made. Horizontally place the back row of your piano on top of the 1x6 plate on the front row so the curved side faces the front.

Put this next to your party room so we can build the slide and cake!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 5):

Group 33 - Box and Balloon Dog

Steps 4 to 5

Place a light orange 2x2 box in front of you. Then place a pair of red cherries and a pink 1x1 tile printed with a red strawberry on top inside the box.

Steps 6 to 7

Place a purple 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the box. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top.

Steps 8 to 9

Now place a transparent light blue balloon dog next to your box! Now put everything away while we build the slide and cake!

Group 34 - Slide and Cake

Steps 10 to 11

Place a purple 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the left.

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place a lime green 2x4 brick in the back right corner so there is no overhang.

Steps 14 to 15

Vertically place a lime green 1x4 brick on the rightmost column in front of the 2x4 brick. Then vertically place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate in front of the 1x4 brick.

Steps 16 to 17

Vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile with a rounded side on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the left. Then place a light blue 2x2 plate to the right.

Group 35 - Slide and Cake

Steps 18 to 19

Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 brick in the back right corner on top of the previous 2x4 brick. Then vertically place a yellow 1x4 brick on the rightmost column in front of the previous 2x4 brick.

Group 36 - Slide and Cake

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick in the back right corner so it sits on top of the 2x4 brick and does not overhang. Then vertically place an orange 1x4 brick on the rightmost column in front of the previous brick.

Group 37 - Slide and Cake

Steps 22 to 23

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a lime green 4x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a yellow 1x4 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically.

Steps 24 to 25

Place a purple 1x1 slope tile on top of the previous brick on the front and back studs so they slope inwards. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x4 panel on the back row to the right of the 1x4 brick so the wall faces the back. Then horizontally place another 1 on the front row to the right of the 1x4 brick so the wall faces the front.

Steps 26 to 27

Vertically place the bottom of a yellow slide on the rightmost column so the top of the slide curves to the front.

Steps 28 to 29

Now horizontally place the top of the slide on the back right corner so it sits on the back row of the 2x4 brick.

Steps 30 to 31

Place a red 4x4 quarter plate in front of the slide so the curve faces the front left.

Steps 32 to 33

Place a purple 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the previous plate so it sits in the right 2 columns and 2nd and 3rd columns from the front. There should be 1 stud free from the quarter plate in front of the tile.

Steps 34 to 35

Let's make a part! Place a lime green 2x2 inverted dome brick on the table. Then place a lime green 2x2 dome brick with cat ears on top so the ears are at the left and right. Now insert the side with a stop of a white bar into the bottom of the inverted dome brick. This is a balloon with cat ears!

Steps 36 to 37

Insert the bottom of your balloon into the 1x2 jumper tile that is in the front right corner of the build so the cat ears are in the front and back.

Steps 38 to 39

Let's make a part! Place a light blue 4x4 round brick in front of you. Then place a mint blue 4x4 round plate with drips on the edges on top of the previous brick.

Group 38 - Slide and Cake

Steps 40 to 41

Place a light purple 2x2 round brick on top of the previous plate so it is centered. Then place a brown 2x2 plate with drips on the edges on top of the previous brick. Then place a pink 2x2 dome brick with cat ears on top so the cat ears are at the left and right. This is a cake!

Steps 42 to 43

Now place your cake on top of the 2x2 plate that is in the leftmost side of the 8x8 plate with a rounded side so it is centered and the cat ears face the front and back.

Steps 44 to 45

Place a light orange 1x1 star on the 2nd row from the front and the 3rd column from the right. There should be 2 free columns to the right in between the star and jumper plate.

Steps 46 to 47

Now place your box that you previously made in front of the slide so it sits diagonal on the 2x2 tile with a stud. It should also be centered. The face should face the front left!
