

11217 Brick-Built Bluey Family

Adapted by John Le and tested by Radar.

Bring Bluey, Bingo, Mum and Dad from the Bluey TV show to life with the Brick-Built Bluey Family (11217) figures. This set makes a great gift for girls and boys ages 5 years old and up. With 4 familiar figures and lots of accessories to mix and match, this customizable building toy is a great way to develop kids' creative skills. The figures have posable arms, hands and tails, and the hands can grip onto many of the accessories. Facial expressions can be changed to reflect different emotions as kids reposition the eyebrows and swappable eyes and snouts. The set includes a variety of toys and items that kids will recognize from the show: long dog, a bonfire, marshmallow, camera, watermelon, xylophone, juice, asparagus, Unicorse and an ice cream – all of which store away neatly inside the 4 figures. Each of the 4 characters has a separate building instructions booklet, so the whole family can build the set together at the same time. This set contains 466 pieces.

BLUEY FAMILY BUILDING TOY – Enjoy creative fun with all 4 of the Heeler family in this Brick-Built Bluey Family (11217) playset for fans of the popular TV show.

4 LARGE LEGO® FIGURES – Build Bluey, Bingo, Mum and Dad characters, then customize their facial expressions with adjustable eyebrows and swappable eyes and snouts.

MOVE AND POSE – The 4 figures have posable arms, hands and tails, helping kids develop fine motor skills as they play.

FAMILIAR ACCESSORIES – Toys and items from the show include a long dog, a bonfire, marshmallow, camera, watermelon, xylophone, juice, asparagus, Unicorse and an ice cream.

DIMENSIONS – This 466-piece building set includes Bluey and Bingo figures standing over 5 in. (13 cm) tall and Mum and Dad figures standing over 6 in. (15 cm) tall.

The build is 466 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: <https://bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers>. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the

table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/11217>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 5 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Bamboo

Steps 6 to 7

Stack 2 lime green 1x1 round bricks in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the back. Now place a lime green 1x1 round brick on top of the ppp. Now place a

green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top so the leaves face the front. Then place a green 1x1 egg on top. This is bamboo! Now put it away while we make Bluey!

Group 2 - Bluey

Steps 8 to 9

Place a light blue 8x8 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 10 to 11

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 2x8x3 rounded window frame in front of you so the rounded side faces up and the anti-studs face the front. Now horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate with 3 pinholes on top. Now place a black 2x2 round tile with a pinhole on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 12 to 13

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Let's make a part! Let's make a tail! Horizontally place a light blue curved tail with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the short end faces the left. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then insert a red 2L axle into the right-facing axle hole. Now place a dark blue 2x2 round brick upright on the right-facing axle so it is centered on it and the studs face the right.

Steps 16 to 17

Insert the left-facing pin of your part to the right-facing pinhole of the main build so it curves upward.

Group 3 - Bluey

Steps 18 to 19

Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the tail faces the back. Vertically place a light blue 1x4 brick on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place an aqua 1x4 brick with 3 pinholes on top of the ppp. Now repeat symmetrically to the left.

Steps 20 to 21

Vertically place a light blue 1x4 brick on the rightmost column on top of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a dark blue 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered

horizontally. Then place a dark blue 1x4 curved corner plate to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place a light blue 2x8x3 rounded window frame on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a light blue 2x4 tile printed with an aqua rounded rectangle upright on the front-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with side studs on 2 sides on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a dark blue 1x4 curved corner plate to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 26 to 27

Let's make a part! Let's make an arm! Horizontally place a light blue 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach an aqua paw to the right-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 28 to 29

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the middle right-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 30 to 31

Let's make a part! Let's make another arm! Horizontally place a light blue 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach an aqua paw to the left-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 32 to 33

Insert the right-facing pin of your part into the middle left-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Group 4 - Bluey

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a dark blue 1x4x3 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 36 to 37

Vertically place a dark blue 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

Steps 38 to 39

Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 tile upright on the right-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 40 to 41

Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a rail on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the front. Then place a yellow 1x1 brick to the left and right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate on top of the 3 ppp.

Steps 42 to 43

Horizontally place a light blue 1x2x2 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a yellow 1x1x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2 side studs to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Now place a dark blue 1x4 curved corner plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the rightmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically.

Steps 44 to 45

Vertically place a dark blue 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left.

Steps 46 to 47

Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 tile upright on the left-facing side studs of the ppp.

Group 5 - Bluey

Steps 48 to 49

Place a dark blue 1x4 curved corner plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the leftmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 50 to 51

Vertically place a dark blue 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a dark blue 1x2 curved corner tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Steps 52 to 53

Horizontally place a dark blue 1x4 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Steps 54 to 55

Vertically place a black 2x3 oval tile printed with a white surface and black eye upright on the top 2 rows of front facing side studs so it is centered on them. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 56 to 57

Let's make a part! Let's make the nose and mouth! Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a yellow 3x4 rounded brick printed with a mouth and nose on top so the curved side overhangs to the back.

Steps 58 to 59

Horizontally place the back row of the 2x4 plate of your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 60 to 61

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an aqua 2x4 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the back.

Group 6 - Bluey

Steps 62 to 63

Horizontally place an aqua 2x4 sloped curved brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place a light blue 2x2 brick on top.

Steps 64 to 65

Place a light blue 2x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a light blue 2x4 brick with inverted sloped curved sides on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 66 to 67

Flip your main build upside down so the tail faces the back. Now horizontally place your parts, 1 to the right of the other, on top so together they are centered horizontally and vertically. Now flip your build back over so it is right side up and the tail faces the back.

Steps 68 to 69

Let's make a part! Let's make the top of her head! Vertically place a light blue 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark blue 4x8 brick with curved corners on the right column so it is centered vertically, and the side with curved corners overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Steps 70 to 71

Vertically place a dark blue 1x4 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 1 on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

Steps 72 to 73

Horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now place a dark blue 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

Group 7 - Bluey

Steps 74 to 75

Place a light blue 2x2 tile with a round side on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back. Then vertically place a light blue 2x4 tile in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows, to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 76 to 77

Place a dark blue 2x2x2 pyramid brick printed with a yellow triangle on the 2 leftmost columns of studs so it is centered vertically and the print faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now diagonally place an aqua 1x2 rounded tile upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so 1 column overhangs to the left and it faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 78 to 79

Place your part on top of the main build so it is centered on it and the upright 1x2 rounded tiles face the front. Then bring back your bamboo and place it on her left hand. Now put her away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 8 - Juice

Steps 4 to 5

Stack 2 transparent pink 2x2 round bricks in front of you. Then place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place a white curved axle connector on top so it curves to the right. Now put your juice box away while we make Bingo!

Group 9 - Bingo

Steps 6 to 7

Place an orange 8x8 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 8 to 9

Let's make a part! Horizontally place an orange 2x8x3 rounded window frame in front of you so the rounded side faces up and the anti-studs face the front. Now horizontally place an orange 2x4 plate with 3 pinholes on top. Now place a brown 2x2 round tile with a pinhole on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 10 to 11

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the right.

Steps 12 to 13

Let's make a part! Let's make a tail! Horizontally place an orange curved tail with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the short end faces the left. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then insert a red 2L axle into the right-facing axle hole. Now place a light yellow 2x2 round brick upright on the right-facing axle so it is centered on it and the studs face the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the right-facing pinhole of the main build so it curves upward.

Steps 16 to 17

Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the tail faces the back. Now vertically place an orange 1x4 brick on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a light brown 1x4 brick with 3 pinholes on top of the ppp. Now repeat symmetrically to the left.

Steps 18 to 19

Vertically place an orange 1x4 brick on the rightmost column on top of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally place a light brown 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered

horizontally. Then place a light brown 1x4 curved corner plate to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place an orange 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place an orange 2x4 tile printed with a light yellow rounded rectangle upright on the front-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with side studs on 2 sides on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light brown 1x4 curved corner plate to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a light brown 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 10 - Bingo

Steps 24 to 25

Let's make a part! Let's make an arm! Horizontally place an orange 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach a light yellow paw to the right-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 26 to 27

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the middle right-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 28 to 29

Let's make a part! Let's make another arm! Horizontally place an orange 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach a light yellow paw to the left-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 30 to 31

Insert the right-facing pin of your part into the middle left-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 32 to 33

Horizontally place a light brown 1x4x3 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 34 to 35

Vertically place a light brown 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

Steps 36 to 37

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 tile upright on the right-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 38 to 39

Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a rail on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the front. Then place a yellow 1x1 brick to the left and right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate on top of the 3 ppp.

Steps 40 to 41

Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2x2 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a yellow 1x1x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2 side studs to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

Group 11 - Bingo

Steps 42 to 43

Place a light brown 1x4 curved corner plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the rightmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically.

Steps 44 to 45

Vertically place a light brown 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left.

Steps 46 to 47

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 tile upright on the left-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 48 to 49

Place a light brown 1x4 curved corner plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the leftmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 50 to 51

Vertically place a light brown 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a light brown 1x2 curved corner tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Steps 52 to 53

Horizontally place a light brown 1x4 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Steps 54 to 55

Vertically place a black 2x3 oval tile printed with a white surface and black eye upright on the 2 leftmost front-facing side studs so it is centered on them and the eye is on the bottom right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 56 to 57

Let's make a part! Let's make the nose and mouth! Horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a light yellow 3x4 rounded brick printed with a mouth and nose on top so the curved side overhangs to the back.

Steps 58 to 59

Horizontally place the back row of the 2x4 plate of your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

Group 12 - Bingo

Steps 60 to 61

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the back.

Steps 62 to 63

Horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 sloped curved brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place an orange 2x2 brick on top.

Group 13 - Bingo

Steps 64 to 65

Place an orange 2x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick with inverted sloped curved sides on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 66 to 67

Flip your main build upside down so the tail faces the back. Now horizontally place your parts, 1 to the right of the other, on top so together they are centered horizontally and vertically. Now flip your build back over so it is right side up and the tail faces the back.

Steps 68 to 69

Let's make a part! Let's make the top of her head! Vertically place a light yellow 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light brown 4x8 brick with curved corners on the right column so it is centered vertically, and the side with curved corners overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Steps 70 to 71

Vertically place a light brown 1x4 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 1 on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

Steps 72 to 73

Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now place a light brown 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

Group 14 - Bingo

Steps 74 to 75

Place a light yellow 2x2 tile with a round side on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back. Then vertically place a light yellow 2x4 tile in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a light brown 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows, to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 76 to 77

Place a light brown 2x2x2 pyramid brick printed with an orange triangle on the 2 leftmost columns of studs so it is centered vertically and the print faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now diagonally place a light yellow 1x2 rounded tile upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so 1 column overhangs to the left and it faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 78 to 79

Place your part on top of the main build so it is centered on it and the upright 1x2 rounded tiles face the front. Then bring back your juice and place it on her left hand. Now put her away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 15 - Watermelon

Steps 4 to 5

Horizontally place a green 2x4 brick with inverted sloped curved sides in front of you. Then horizontally place a light green 2x4 plate on top. Now place a red 2x2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 2 red 1x2 double slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top so they slope to the left and right. Now put away your watermelon while we make Dad!

Group 16 - Dad

Steps 6 to 7

Place a light blue 8x8 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 8 to 9

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 2x8x4 rounded window frame in front of you so the side studs face up and the anti-studs face the front. Now horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate with 3 pinholes on the front 2 rows. Then horizontally place a light blue 2x4 tile behind the ppp. Now place a black 2x2 round tile with a pinhole on top of the 2x4 plate so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 10 to 11

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

Steps 12 to 13

Let's make a part! Let's make a tail! Horizontally place a black curved tail with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the short end faces the left. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then insert a red 2L axle into the right-facing axle hole. Now place a light blue 2x2 round brick upright on the right-facing axle so it is centered on it and the studs face the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the right-facing pinhole of the 2x2 round tile with a pinhole so it curves upward.

Steps 16 to 17

Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the tail faces the back. Now vertically place a light blue 1x4 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically stack 2 more on the rightmost column so they are centered vertically.

Steps 18 to 19

Vertically place an aqua 1x4 brick with 3 pinholes on the rightmost column on top of the ppp. Then vertically place a light blue 1x4 brick on top of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a black 1x4 curved corner plate to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place a light blue 2x8x4 rounded window frame with side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now place a light blue 4x4 tile printed with a light orange rounded rectangle upright on the front-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with side studs on 2 sides on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a black 1x4 curved corner plate to the left of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 17 - Dad

Steps 26 to 27

Let's make a part! Let's make an arm! Horizontally place a light blue 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach an aqua paw to the right-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 28 to 29

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the middle right-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 30 to 31

Let's make a part! Let's make another arm! Horizontally place a light blue 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach an aqua paw to the left-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 32 to 33

Insert the right-facing pin of your part into the middle left-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a black 1x4x3 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 36 to 37

Let's make a part! Vertically place a black 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs in front of you so the side studs face the right. Then horizontally place a black 2x4 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.

Steps 38 to 39

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the right.

Steps 40 to 41

Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a rail on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the front. Then place a yellow 1x1 brick to the left and right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate on top of the 3 ppp.

Steps 42 to 43

Horizontally place a black 1x2x2 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a yellow 1x1x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2 side studs to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Now place a black 1x4 curved corner plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the rightmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically.

Steps 44 to 45

Let's make a part! Vertically place a black 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a black 2x4 tile upright on the left-facing side studs.

Steps 46 to 47

Vertically place your part on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the left.

Steps 48 to 49

Place a black 1x4 curved corner plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light blue 1x2 plate on the leftmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 50 to 51

Vertically place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a black 1x2 curved corner tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Steps 52 to 53

Horizontally place a black 1x4 tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Group 18 - Dad

Steps 54 to 55

Vertically place a black 2x3 oval tile printed with a white surface and black eye upright on the top 2 rows of side studs. so it is centered on them and the eye is on the bottom right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 56 to 57

Let's make a part! Let's make the nose and mouth! Horizontally place a yellow 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a yellow 3x4 rounded brick printed with a mouth and nose on top so the curved side overhangs to the back.

Steps 58 to 59

Horizontally place the back row of the 2x4 plate of your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 60 to 61

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an aqua 2x4 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the back.

Steps 62 to 63

Horizontally place an aqua 2x4 sloped curved brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place a light blue 2x2x3 brick on top.

Steps 64 to 65

Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 brick with inverted sloped curved sides on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 66 to 67

Flip your main build upside down so the tail faces the back. Now horizontally place your parts, 1 to the right of the other, on top so together they are centered horizontally and vertically. Now flip your build back over so it is right side up and the tail faces the back.

Group 19 - Dad

Steps 68 to 69

Let's make a part! Let's make the top of his head! Vertically place a black 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 4x8 brick with curved corners on the right column so it is centered vertically, and the side with curved corners overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Steps 70 to 71

Vertically place a black 1x4 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 1 on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

Steps 72 to 73

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now place a black 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

Steps 74 to 75

Place a black 2x2 tile with a round side on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back. Then vertically place a black 2x4 tile in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows, to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 76 to 77

Place a black 2x2x2 pyramid brick printed with a yellow triangle on the 2 leftmost columns of studs so it is centered vertically and the print faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now diagonally place an aqua 1x2 rounded tile upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so 1 column overhangs to the left and it faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 78 to 79

Place your part on top of the main build so it is centered on it and the upright 1x2 rounded tiles face the front. Then bring back your watermelon and place it on his left hand. Now put him away while we make the next part!

Place an orange 8x8 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 8 to 9

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 2x8x3 rounded window frame in front of you so the side studs face up and the anti-studs face the front. Now horizontally place an orange 2x4 plate with 3 pinholes on the front 2 rows. Then horizontally place an orange 2x4 tile behind the ppp. Now place a brown 2x2 round tile with a pinhole on top of the 2x4 plate so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 10 to 11

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right.

Steps 12 to 13

Let's make a part! Let's make a tail! Horizontally place an orange curved tail with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the short end faces the left. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so

the pin faces the left. Then insert a red 2L axle into the right-facing axle hole. Now place an orange 2x2 round brick upright on the right-facing axle so it is centered on it and the studs face the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the right-facing pinhole of the 2x2 round tile with a pinhole so it curves upward.

Steps 16 to 17

Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the tail faces the back. Now vertically place an orange 1x4 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then vertically stack 2 on the rightmost column so they are centered vertically.

Steps 18 to 19

Vertically place a brown 1x4 brick with 3 pinholes on the rightmost column on top of the ppp. Then vertically place an orange 1x4 brick on top of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

Steps 20 to 21.1

Place an orange 1x4 curved corner plate on the back right corner so the curve faces the back right.

Group 22 - Mom

Steps 20 to 21.2

Place a brown 1x4 curved corner plate on the back left corner so the curve faces the back right. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on the back row, to the right of the ppp.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place an orange 2x8x4 rounded window frame with side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now place an orange 4x4 tile printed with a light yellow rounded square upright on the front-facing side studs of the ppp.

Steps 24 to 25.1

Place a light brown 1x4 curved corner plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 plate behind the leftmost column of the ppp.

Group 23 - Mom

Steps 24 to 25.2

Place an orange 1x4 curved corner plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the front right. Then vertically place an orange 1x2 plate behind the rightmost column of the ppp. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 brick with side studs on 2 sides on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 26 to 27

Let's make a part! Let's make an arm! Horizontally place an orange 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach a light yellow paw to the right-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 28 to 29

Insert the left-facing pin of your part into the middle right-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 30 to 31

Let's make a part! Let's make another arm! Horizontally place an orange 2L curved cylinder with 2 axle connectors in front of you so the axle holes face the front left and front right. Now insert a blue 2L pin axle into the left-facing axle hole so the pin faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach a light yellow paw to the left-facing pin so the stud faces up.

Steps 32 to 33

Insert the right-facing pin of your part into the middle left-facing pinhole so it curves to the front.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a brown 1x4x3 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 36 to 37

Let's make a part! Vertically place an orange 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs in front of you so the side studs face the right. Then horizontally place an orange 2x4 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.

Steps 38 to 39

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the right.

Steps 40 to 41

Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with a rail on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the front. Then place a yellow 1x1 brick to the left and right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate on top of the 3 ppp.

Steps 42 to 43

Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2x2 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a yellow 1x1x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2 side studs to the left and right of the ppp so the side studs face the front. Now place an orange 1x4 curved corner plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the rightmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically.

Group 24 - Mom

Steps 44 to 45

Let's make a part! Vertically place a brown 2x8x3 rounded window frame with side studs in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a brown 2x4 tile upright on the left-facing side studs.

Steps 46 to 47

Vertically place your part on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the rounded side faces the left.

Steps 48 to 49

Place a brown 1x4 curved corner plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 plate on the leftmost column, in between the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 50 to 51.1

Vertically place a brown 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a brown 1x2 curved corner tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 25 - Mom

Steps 50 to 51.2

Vertically place an orange 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place an orange 1x2 curved corner tile in front of the ppp so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 52 to 53

Horizontally place a brown 1x4 tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 54 to 55.1

Vertically place a black 2x3 oval tile printed with a white surface and black eye upright on the top 2 rows of side studs so it is centered on them and the eye is on the right.

Group 26 - Mom

Steps 54 to 55.2

Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the left using a black 2x3 oval tile printed with a closed orange eyelid.

Steps 56 to 57

Let's make a part! Let's make the nose and mouth! Horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a light yellow 3x4 rounded brick printed with a mouth and nose on top so the curved side overhangs to the back.

Steps 58 to 59

Horizontally place the back row of the 2x4 plate of your part upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 60 to 61

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a brown 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the back.

Steps 62 to 63

Horizontally place a light yellow 2x4 sloped curved brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and slopes and overhangs to the front. Then place an orange 2x2x3 brick on top.

Steps 64 to 65

Horizontally place an orange 2x4 brick with inverted sloped curved sides on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 66 to 67

Flip your main build upside down so the tail faces the back. Now horizontally place your parts, 1 to the right of the other, on top so together they are centered horizontally and vertically. Now flip your build back over so it is right side up and the tail faces the back.

Group 27 - Mom

Steps 68 to 69.1

Let's make a part! Let's make the top of her head! Vertically place a light yellow 2x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place an orange 4x8 brick with curved corners on the right column so it is centered vertically, and the side with curved corners overhangs to the right. Now vertically place an orange 1x4 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right.

Group 28 - Mom

Steps 68 to 69.2

Vertically place a brown 4x8 brick with curved corners on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically, and the side with curved corners overhangs to the left. Now vertically place a brown 1x4 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left.

Steps 70 to 71

Horizontally place a brown 1x4 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and slopes to the back.

Steps 72 to 73.1

Place an orange 1x1 brick with a side stud on the rightmost stud of the front row so the side stud faces the front.

Group 29 - Mom

Steps 72 to 73.2

Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 sloped curved brick on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Now place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left of the ppp so the side stud faces the front.

Steps 74 to 75.1

Vertically place an orange 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows of the 3rd column from the right so it sits to the right of the 1x2 sloped curved brick.

Group 30 - Mom

Steps 74 to 75.2

Place a light yellow 2x2 tile with a round side on the back 2 rows of studs so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the back. Then vertically place a light yellow 2x4 tile in front of the ppp. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 plate on the front 2 rows, to the left of the ppp.

Steps 76 to 77

Place a brown 2x2x2 pyramid brick printed with an orange triangle on the 2 leftmost columns of studs so it is centered vertically and the print faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now diagonally place a light yellow 1x2 rounded tile upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so 1 column overhangs to the left and it faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 78 to 79

Place your part on top of the main build so it is centered on it and the upright 1x2 rounded tiles face the front. Then bring back your ice cream and place it on her left hand. Now put her away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 5):

Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a red 1x2 tile on the 2nd column from the left.

Vertically place a yellow 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp.

Group 33 - Xylophone

Steps 4 to 5.3

Vertically place a green 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp.

Group 34 - Xylophone

Steps 4 to 5.4

Vertically place a blue 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp.

Steps 6 to 7

Let's make a part! Let's make the mallet for it! Place a brown 5.5L antenna in front of you.

Steps 8 to 10

Place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp so the stud faces up. Then place a red ball on top of the ppp. Now put everything away while we make the unicorn!

Group 35 - Unicorn

Steps 11 to 13

Horizontally place a light grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Vertically place a light blue 1x2x2 brick to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp.

Steps 16 to 17

Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2 handles on top of the ppp so it is centered vertically. Then place a white 2x2x2 slope brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left.

Steps 18 to 19

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column so it slopes to the right. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a side stud on the front row, to the left of the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 20 to 21

Place a white 1x1 round tile with a black eye upright on the front-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 22 to 23

Rotate your part 180 degrees so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place the rightmost column of your part on the leftmost column of studs of your unicorn so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place 2 short light blue 1x1 plates with a 1x1 sloped curved brick, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns of studs so they slope to the right. Then vertically place a light blue 1x2 jumper plate on top of the 2 ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.

Steps 26 to 28

Place a gold unicorn horn on top of the ppp. Now put it away while we make the next part!

Group 37 - Campfire

Steps 29 to 31

Horizontally place a tan 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 slope tile on the leftmost column so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 brick in between the 2 ppp.

Steps 32 to 33

Place an orange 1x2 plate with a 1x2 inverted sloped curved brick on top so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Now place another 1 on the left column of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

Steps 34 to 35

Place an orange 2x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns. Then vertically place an orange 1x2 tri-slope tile to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the right.

Group 38 - Campfire

Steps 36 to 37

Vertically place an orange 1x2 tri-slope tile on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Then vertically place an orange 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 tri-slope tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the right.

Steps 38 to 39

Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make marshmallows! Place a brown 5.5L antenna in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 round brick on top so the stud faces up.

Steps 40 to 42

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Put them next to the fire and roast them! Now put everything away while we make the next part!

Group 39 - Green Dog

Steps 43 to 45

Horizontally place a lime green 2x3 plate in front of you. Then place a lime green 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Steps 46 to 47

Vertically stack 2 dark green 1x2 bricks on the rightmost column. Then vertically place a lime green 1x2x3 brick to the left of the 2 ppp.

Steps 48 to 49

Horizontally place a lime green 2x3 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so 1 column overhangs to the left. Now horizontally place a lime green 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the front right corner so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 40 - Green Dog

Steps 50 to 51

Vertically place a lime green 1x2 brick printed with an eye lid on the rightmost column so the eye lid faces the front. Then place a lime green 2x2 sloped curved brick on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the left.

Steps 52 to 56

Lay your dog on its left-facing side so the anti-studs face the right. Now vertically place a dark green 1x2 rounded tile upright on the 2 front-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now put your dog away while we make the next part!

Group 41 - Camera

Steps 57 to 59

Horizontally place a dark tan 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2x2 brick on the rightmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Steps 60 to 61

Horizontally place a brown 1x2x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x2x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with 2x2 side studs in front of the ppp so the side studs face the front.

Steps 62 to 63

Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate with 2 upright side studs on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front.

Steps 64 to 65

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 plate on top.

Steps 66 to 67

Place a brown 2x2 round brick upright on the bottom 2 rows of front-facing side studs. Then place a dark grey 2x2 round tile with a stud upright on the ppp.

Steps 68 to 69

Place a transparent 2x2 dish upright on the ppp.

Steps 70 to 73

Vertically place a light brown 1x2 sloped curved brick on the 2nd column from the left so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a gold 1x1 star upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud.
