

21264 The Ender Dragon and End Ship

Adapted by John Le and tested by Jolene Nemeth.

Players enter the perilous End biome, where they must battle the Ender Dragon. All the limbs of this fully-jointed Minecraft model are movable and adjustable. The End Ship has a fully equipped interior, accessed via a lift-off roof and opening sides. A dragon's head at the ship's bow can be removed and worn as a helmet. Inside, kids will find a brewing stand with health potions. Minecraft characters include an Ender Explorer with elytra wings and firework rocket, an Ender Knight, a Shulker and an Enderman. Accessories include the prized dragon's egg.

The front of the box shows 2 heroes on an end ship defending themselves from the ender dragon! They have to be careful though because an Enderman just teleported to their ship to fight them as well!

The build is 657 pieces in total and is for ages 8+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for a hero, an enderman, a chest of loot, and the end portal with a dragon egg.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the ender dragon.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the ender dragon.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for a hero minifigure, and the end ship.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for the end ship.

Bag 6 includes the pieces for a brewing table and the end ship.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/21264>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 6 bags labeled 1 to 6, 2 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Hero

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 teal pair of legs, 1 dark blue and teal torso printed with white, tan, and green dots, 1 brown square head printed with a white hood and light blue eyes, 1 light purple helmet, and 1 light purple bow and arrow. Assemble your minifigure then attach the bow to his hand! Now put him away while we make an Enderman!

Group 2 - Enderman

Step 1

Place a tan 2x2 tile with 2 studs in front of you so the studs are in the back.

Step 2

Horizontally place a black 1x2x7 pair of Enderman legs with side studs and a thick bar on top.

Step 3

Place a square black head printed with purple eyes on top of the thick bar.

Step 4

Place a black 1x1 tile upright on the bottom left-facing side stud. Then place a black 1x1 plate upright above the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 5.1

Let's make a part! Place a dark tan 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a tan 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip on the back right corner so the side stud faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 5.2

Place a dark tan 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Now horizontally place a black 1x6 tile upright on the 2 left-facing side studs so it overhangs 4 rows to the back. Now attach the back row of your part upright on the left-facing side stud of your Enderman so it slopes to the front.

Step 6

Attach a black 1x6 tile to the 3 right-facing side studs so it is symmetrical with the left. This is an Enderman holding a block! Now put it away while we make a chest of loot!

Group 3 - Chest of Loot

Step 7

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4x2 chest bottom in front of you so the lower lip faces the back. Now horizontally attach a light brown 2x4 chest top to the back. Then place a gold 1x2 ingot tile, green 1x1 round plate, and a blue 1x1 round plate inside, then close it! There is gold, an emerald, and a diamond inside! Now put it away while we make the end portal and dragon egg!

Group 4 - End Portal and Dragon Egg

Step 8

Horizontally place a tan 6x10 plate in front of you. Then place a dark grey 2x2 corner plate on the back right corner so it looks like the braille letter d.

Step 9

Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 plate on the back row to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a light grey 1x4 plate on the front right corner.

Step 10

Place a black 6x6 plate on the front 5 rows to the left of the rightmost column so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

Step 11

Horizontally place a tan 2x10 plate underneath the front row so it is centered horizontally to the build and 1 row is exposed to the front.

Step 12

Place a dark grey 2x2 corner plate on the front right corner so it looks like the braille letter j. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x4 plate on the front row to the left of the ppp. Now place a dark grey 2x2 corner plate on the front 2 rows to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h. Then vertically place a light grey 1x4 plate behind the leftmost column of the ppp. Now place the left column of a dark grey 2x2 corner plate behind the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f.

Step 13

Place a dark tan 2x2 tile with a stud on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 14

Place a purple 1x1 brick on the back left corner on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud.

Step 15.1

Let's make a part! Vertically place a purple 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a purple 1x1 plate on the back row. Now place a purple 1x1 tile on the ppp.

Step 15.2

Place a purple 1x1 brick on the front row. Then place a black 1x1 brick with side studs on each side on the front row. Now place 5 light purple 1x1 round flower plates, 1 on each of the studs of the ppp.

Step 15.3

Vertically place your part on the back left corner on top of the 1x1 brick so it is centered vertically on it and the round flower plates are in the front.

Step 16.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a purple 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place a purple 1x1 plate on the leftmost column. Now place a light purple 1x1 round flower plate on the rightmost column.

Step 16.2

Place a purple 1x1 tile on the leftmost column. Then place a purple 1x1 brick underneath the rightmost column.

Step 16.3

Horizontally place your part on the front left corner on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud so it overhangs to the left.

Group 5 - End Portal and Dragon Egg

Step 17.1

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2 corner plate on top so it looks like the braille letter f. Then place a black 1x1 round plate on the front right corner.

Step 17.2

Place a dark grey 2x2 brick on top.

Step 17.3

Place a light grey 2x2 corner plate on top so it looks like the braille letter d. Now place a black 1x1 round plate on the front left corner.

Step 17.4

Place 2 dark grey 1x1 bricks with 2 side studs on the sides, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the left, front, and right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 17.5

Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a dark grey 1x1 tile with a clip upright on the front-facing side stud so the clip hands face left and right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left and right.

Step 17.6

Place your part on the 4th and 5th rows from the front and 4th and 5th columns from the right.

Step 18.1

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 2x2 brick in front of you. Then place a light grey 2x2 corner plate on top so it looks like the braille letter j. Then place a black 1x1 round plate on the back left corner.

Step 18.2

Place a dark grey 2x2 brick on top. Now place a black 2x2 inverted dome brick on top so it is centered in between the 4 studs. Then place a black 2x2 dome brick on top.

Step 18.3

Place your part on top of the previous part. This is the egg!

You will have 4 extra transparent orange 1x1 plates. Save them for later!

Group 6 - End Portal and Dragon Egg

Step 19.1

Let's make 4 identical parts! Place a brown 1x1 telescope bar in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 plate on top. Now place a transparent orange 1x1 plate from group 5 on top.

Step 19.2

Now you should have 4 identical parts! These are torches! Attach 1 to the front-facing clip so the stud faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now attach 1 to the right-facing clip. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now put your portal and egg away while we make the dragon!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 7 - Ender Dragon

Step 1

Horizontally place a black 4x10 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x4 plate on the leftmost column.

Step 2

Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball on the short side on the front 2 rows on the 2nd column from the left so the ball faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 3

Place a lime green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a white 1x2x1 panel to the right so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the right.

Step 4

Place a black 1x1 plate on the front row on the 4th column from the right. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 plate to the left of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 5

Vertically place 2 black 1x2 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column.

Step 6

Vertically place a dark red 1x2 plate on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a white 1x2x1 panel to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the left.

Step 7

Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 brick with a round ridge on the long side on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so the ridge faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 8

Place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the connector faces the right. A hinge connector has 2 fingers while a hinge has 1 finger. Now place a black 1x1 plate on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 9.1

Vertically place 2 purple 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so they are centered vertically. Now vertically place 2 black 1x2 plates with a stud and a hinge, 1

to the right of the other, in front of the 2 ppp so the hinges overhang 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 9.2

Horizontally place a black 1x3 brick on the front row on the 4th, 5th, and 6th columns from the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 10

Vertically place 2 purple 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so they are centered vertically. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 11

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 12

Place a black 1x1 brick with a side stud on the front left corner so the side stud faces the back. Then horizontally place a black 1x3 brick to the right of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 13

Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so it overhangs to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 14

Horizontally place a dark grey and light grey 1x4 bar shooter brick on the 4 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the larger hole faces the left.

Step 15

Vertically place a black 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 plate on the front row to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 4 black 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 4 leftmost columns.

Group 9 - Ender Dragon

There are no instructions in this group. You will have an extra red 1x2 plate. Save it for later!

Group 10 - Ender Dragon

Step 16.1

Place a light purple 2x2 inverted tile in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with a pinhole on the rightmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 16.2

Vertically place a red 1x2 plate from group 9 on the leftmost column. Then place a yellow 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the right column so it overhangs 1 column to the right and the studs are on the left.

Step 16.3

Place a lime green 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns.

Step 16.4

Vertically place 2 black 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the ppp.

Step 16.5

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 16.6

Horizontally place your part on the 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right so it is centered vertically.

Group 11 - Ender Dragon

Step 17

Vertically place a black 1x4 plate on the rightmost column. Then vertically place a black 2x4 plate to the left of the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the front row to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 18

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the hinge connector faces the left. Then place a black 1x1 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a black 4x4 plate to the right of the 3 ppp.

Step 19.1

Vertically place a black 2x4 tile on the 2 leftmost columns. Now horizontally place a black 1x8 tile on the front row to the right of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 19.2

Vertically place 2 black 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns. Then vertically place a black 1x2 tile to the left. Now vertically place 2 black 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then vertically place a black 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp.

Group 12 - Ender Dragon

Step 20

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on top. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on the 2 leftmost studs. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 21.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with a hinge connector on the short side on the back left corner so the hinge connector faces the left.

Step 21.2

Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Now horizontally place a black 2x2 brick with a pinhole and a round part on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the round part overhangs to the right. Now attach a black round part with 2 pins to the back-facing side of the round part of the ppp so the pin faces the right.

Step 21.3

Horizontally place a black 2x4 tile on top. Now flip the right-facing pin down so it faces down.

Step 22.1

Let's make a part! Place a black 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the leftmost column so the connector faces the left. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge on the long side on the rightmost column so the hinge faces the right. Now place a black 2x2 tile on top.

Step 22.2

Attach the right-facing hinge of your part to the left-facing hinge connector so the tile faces the back.

Step 23

Let's make a part! Vertically place a dark grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 plate with 2 studs and a hinge on the back 2 rows so the hinge is in the back. Then horizontally place 2 black 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the front 2 rows. Now attach the left-facing hinge connector of your previous part to the top-facing hinge of your current part so it is upright and the 2x2 tile faces the front. This is a dragon leg!

Step 24

Attach the pin of your part to the front-facing pinhole of your main build so the 2x4 tile faces the front.

Step 25.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 brick with a hinge connector on the short side on the back right corner so the hinge connector faces the right.

Step 25.2

Horizontally place a black 1x2 brick on the front right corner. Now horizontally place a black 2x2 brick with a pinhole and a round part on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the round part overhangs to the left. Now attach a black round part with 2 pins to the front-facing side of the round part of the ppp so the pin faces the left.

Step 25.3

Horizontally place a black 2x4 tile on top. Now flip the right-facing pin down so it faces down.

Step 26.1

Let's make a part! Place a black 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the rightmost column so the connector faces the right. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge on the long side on the leftmost column so the hinge faces the left. Now place a black 2x2 tile on top.

Step 26.2

Attach the left-facing hinge of your part to the right-facing hinge connector of your previous part so the tile faces the back.

Step 27

Let's make a part! Vertically place a dark grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 plate with 2 studs and a hinge on the back 2 rows so the hinge is in the back. Then horizontally place 2 black 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the front 2 rows. Now attach the right-facing hinge connector of your previous part to the top-facing hinge of your current part so it is upright and the 2x2 tile faces the front. This is a dragon leg!

Step 28

Attach the pin of your part to the back-facing pinhole of your main build so the 2x4 tile faces the back.

Step 29.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the short side in front of you so the connector faces the left. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on top so the socket faces the right. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 29.2

Let's make a part! Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and a hinge in front of you so the hinge is in the back. Now vertically attach the previous part to the top-facing hinge so the 1x2 tile faces the front and the socket faces up.

Step 29.3

Attach the ball of a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball and socket to the top-facing socket so the studs face the right. Now vertically place a black 1x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.

Step 29.4

Attach the socket of your part to the front-facing ball of the main build so the upper 1x2 tile faces the front.

Step 30.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the short side in front of you so the connector faces the left. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on top so the socket faces the right. Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 30.2

Let's make a part! Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a stud and a hinge in front of you so the hinge is in the back. Now vertically attach the previous part to the top-facing hinge so the 1x2 tile faces the front and the socket faces up.

Step 30.3

Attach the ball of a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball and socket to the top-facing socket so the studs face the left. Now vertically place a black 1x2 tile upright on the left-facing side studs.

Step 30.4

Attach the socket of your part to the back-facing ball of the main build so the upper 1x2 tile faces the back.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 13 - Ender Dragon

Step 31

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 4x4 plate on the front 3 rows so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

Step 32

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side underneath the 2 leftmost columns of the front row so the connector faces the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x6 plate underneath the front row to the right of the ppp so 4 columns are exposed to the right.

Step 33

Vertically place a black 2x8 plate on the leftmost column so the front row is aligned with the front row of the build and it overhangs 1 column to the left. Now place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate to the right of the back 4 rows of the ppp so the curve faces the back right.

Step 34

Place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the back right. Then place a black 1x1 plate behind the leftmost column of the ppp.

Group 14 - Ender Dragon

Step 35

Flip your part upside down so the inverted curves face the back right. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the front left corner so the connector faces the left. Then place a black 1x1 plate on the front row to the right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 1x6 plate to the right of the ppp.

Step 36

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the short side on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd row from the front so the connector faces the right. Now horizontally place another 1 behind it so the connector faces the right. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate to the left of the 2 ppp.

Step 37

Place 2 black 2x2 inverted round tiles with a rounded bottom, 1 in front of the other, on the front left corner. Then place a black 4x4 quarter circle plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the back right.

Step 38

Flip your build over so it is right side up and the inverted curves face the back right. Now vertically place a light grey 1x8 tile on the leftmost column.

Step 39

Let's make another part! Horizontally place a dark grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 4x4 plate on the front 3 rows so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

Group 15 - Ender Dragon

Step 40

Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 plate with 2 hinges on the long side underneath the front row so 2 columns are exposed to the right and the hinges face the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x6 plate underneath the front row to the left of the ppp so 4 columns are exposed to the left.

Step 41

Place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then place a black 1x1 plate behind the rightmost column of the ppp.

Step 42

Vertically place a black 2x8 plate on the rightmost column so the front row is aligned with the front row of the part and it overhangs 1 column to the right. Now place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate to the left of the back 4 rows of the ppp so the curve faces the back left.

Group 16 - Ender Dragon

Step 43

Flip your part upside down so the inverted curved plates face the back left. Now horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place the front row of a black 2x3 plate to the left of the ppp so it overhangs 1 column to the left.

Step 44

Place a black 3x3 plate with a cutoff corner underneath the front 3 rows of the leftmost column so 2 columns are exposed to the left and the cutoff corner faces the back left.

Step 45

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the front left corner. Now place a black 2x2 inverted round tile with a rounded bottom on the front right corner. Then place another 1 on the 2 rightmost columns on the 4th and 5th rows from the back.

Step 46

Flip your build over so it is right side up and the inverted curves face the front right. Now vertically place a light grey 1x8 tile on the front left corner. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 tile behind the ppp. Now place a light grey 1x1 tile behind the ppp.

Step 47

Bring back your previous part and attach it to the back-facing hinges so the inverted curves face the back right. This is one of the dragon's wings!

Step 48

Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the upright 2x4 tiles are on the right and face the front and back. Now attach the back-facing hinge connectors of your part to the front-facing hinges of the main build so it overhangs to the front.

Step 49

Put away your main build while we make another part!

Step 50

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 4x4 plate on the front 3 rows so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

Group 17 - Ender Dragon

Step 51

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side underneath the 2 rightmost columns of the front row so the connector faces the front. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x6 plate underneath the front row to the left of the ppp so 4 columns are exposed to the left.

Step 52.1

Vertically place a black 2x8 plate on the rightmost column so the front row is aligned with the front row of the build and it overhangs 1 column to the right. Now place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate to the left of the back 4 rows of the ppp so the curve faces the back left.

Step 52.2

Place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the back left. Then place a black 1x1 plate behind the rightmost column of the ppp.

Group 18 - Ender Dragon

Step 53

Flip your part upside down so the inverted curves face the back left. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the front right corner so the connector faces the right. Then place a black 1x1 plate on the front row to the left of the ppp. Now horizontally place a black 1x6 plate to the left of the ppp.

Step 54

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the short side on the 2 leftmost columns on the 2nd row from the front so the connector faces the left. Now horizontally place another 1 behind it so the connector faces the left. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate to the right of the 2 ppp.

Step 55

Place 2 black 2x2 inverted round tiles with a rounded bottom, 1 in front of the other, on the front right corner. Then place a black 4x4 quarter circle plate on the front left corner so the curve faces the back left.

Step 56

Flip your build over so it is right side up and the inverted curves face the back left. Now vertically place a light grey 1x8 tile on the rightmost column.

Step 57

Let's make another part! Horizontally place a dark grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 4x4 plate on the front 3 rows so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front.

Step 58

Horizontally place a light grey 1x4 plate with 2 hinges on the long side underneath the front row so 2 columns are exposed to the left and the hinges face the front. Now horizontally place a light grey 1x6 plate underneath the front row to the right of the ppp so 4 columns are exposed to the left.

Step 59.1

Place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate on the front right corner so the curve faces the back right. Then place a black 1x1 plate behind the rightmost column of the ppp.

Step 59.2

Vertically place a black 2x8 plate on the leftmost column so the front row is aligned with the front row of the part and it overhangs 1 column to the left. Now place a black 4x4 inverted curve plate to the right of the back 4 rows of the ppp so the curve faces the back right.

Step 60

Flip your part upside down so the inverted curved plates face the back right. Now horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place the front row of a black 2x3 plate to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 61

Place a black 3x3 plate with a cutoff corner underneath the front 3 rows of the rightmost column so 2 columns are exposed to the right and the cutoff corner faces the back right.

Step 62

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the front right corner. Now place a black 2x2 inverted round tile with a rounded bottom on the front left corner. Then place another 1 on the 2 leftmost columns on the 4th and 5th rows from the back.

Step 63

Flip your build over so it is right side up and the inverted curves face the back right. Now vertically place a light grey 1x8 tile on the back left corner. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 tile in front of the ppp. Now place a light grey 1x1 tile in front of the ppp.

Step 64

Bring back your previous part and attach it to the front-facing hinges so the inverted curves face the front right. This is one of the dragon's wings!

Steps 65 to 66

Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the wing overhangs to the front. Now attach the front-facing hinge connectors of your part to the back-facing hinges of the main build so it overhangs to the back.

Step 67.1

Let's make 4 identical parts! Place a black 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the right column so the connector faces the right. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge on the long side on the leftmost column so the hinge faces the left.

Step 67.2

Vertically place 2 black 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

Step 67.3

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 67.4

Now you should have 4 identical parts! Place 1 in front of you so the hinge connector faces the right. Now attach the hinge of another part to the right-facing hinge connector. Then repeat 2 more times to the right.

Step 67.5

Let's make a part! Place a black 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the rightmost column. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge on the leftmost column so the hinge faces the left.

Step 67.6

Vertically place 2 black 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

Step 67.7

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 67.8

Attach the hinge of your part to the right-facing hinge connector of your previous part. This is a dragon tail! Now bring back your main build so it is vertical and the inverted curves of the wings face the right. Now attach the left-facing hinge of your part to the right-facing hinge connector.

Step 68.1

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a black 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge on the long side on the leftmost column so the hinge faces the left. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the right column so the connector faces the right.

Step 68.2

Vertically place 2 black 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

Step 68.3

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate on top. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 69.1

Attach the hinge of a black 2x4 dragon head with a snout and ears to the right-facing hinge connector so the studs are on top and face the right.

Step 69.2

Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile printed with purple eyes upright on the right-facing side studs.

Step 70

Rotate your part 180 degrees so the head faces the left. Now attach the right-facing hinge of your part to the left-facing hinge connector of the main build so it is centered vertically and overhangs to the left.

Step 71

Insert a transparent purple bolt into the left-facing bar hole of the 1x4 bar shooter brick that is below the left-facing hinge you just connected the head to! Now put away your dragon while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 23 - Hero

You will have 2 extra red 1x1 round plates. Save them for later!

Group 24 - Hero

Sub-build 2.1. Locate a dark blue pair of legs, 1 torso printed with tan and dark blue armor, 1 transparent 1x2 rounded plate with a neck hole, 1 dark square head printed with a large teal eye, and 1 teal sword. Assemble your minifigure, make sure the studs are on his back and face the back, then attach the sword to his hand!

Sub-build 2.2. Attach a sand blue 1x3 rounded tile with ridges upright on the left back-facing side stud so it faces the bottom left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. These are elytra wings!

Sub-build 2.3. Let's make a part! Place a white 1x1 round plate with a hollow stud in front of you. Then place a red 1x1 pyramid tile on top. Now insert a light grey 3L bar into the anti-stud. Now insert a red 1x1 round plate with a hollow stud from group 23 into the bottom-facing bar so it goes all the way up.

Sub-build 2.4. Insert a white 1x1 round plate into the bottom-facing bar so it goes all the way up. Then insert a red 1x1 round plate from group 23 into the bottom-facing bar so it goes all the way up. This is a firework! Attach it to your hero's hand! Now put everything away while we make the end ship!

Group 25 - End Ship

Step 1

Place a dark grey 6x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back right corner.

Step 2

Place a magenta 2x2 tile with a stud on the back left corner.

Step 3

Vertically place a magenta 1x2 tile on the leftmost column in front of the ppp. Then vertically place a magenta 1x2 plate to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place a magenta 2x4 tile in front of the 2 ppp so it overhangs 2 rows to the front.

Step 4

Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise so the 2x4 tile overhangs to the right. Then place a dark grey 6x6 plate underneath the 2 rightmost column so it is centered vertically to the build.

Step 5

Horizontally place a black 2x10 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so it is centered horizontally.

Step 6

Place a magenta 2x2 tile with a stud on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tile on the front row to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate behind the ppp. Now vertically place 2 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the back right corner.

Group 26 - End Ship

Step 7

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Now vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, behind the ppp so they overhang 1 row to the back.

Step 8

Place 2 dark grey 6x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, underneath the back row so they are centered horizontally to the build.

Step 9

Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the tiles are on the left. Now horizontally place a black 2x6 plate on the 5 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 10

Horizontally place a dark grey 2x8 plate on the 8 rightmost columns of the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back. Now horizontally place 3 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back right corner.

Step 11

Horizontally place 3 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front right corner. Now place a dark grey 2x2 tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then horizontally place a dark grey 2x4 tile to the left of the ppp.

Step 12

Vertically place a magenta 1x2 tile on the 2nd column from the left and 3rd and 4th rows from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 27 - End Ship

Step 13

Vertically place a magenta 2x8 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left, on the 2nd - 9th rows from the front. Now horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of a magenta 2x8 plate behind the ppp.

Step 14

Horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick on the 3rd row from the front and the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then vertically place a tan 2x6 brick behind the ppp. Now place a light purple 2x2 brick behind the ppp. Then horizontally place a tan 2x6 brick to the right of the ppp.

Group 28 - End Ship

Step 15

Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd and 3rd row from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the brick grooves face outwards to the front and back. Now horizontally place a transparent pink 1x2 brick on the 2nd row from the back to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd and 3rd row from the back, to the left of the ppp so the brick grooves face outwards to the front and back.

Step 16

Place a light purple 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Now vertically place 2 tan 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so the brick grooves face outwards to the left and right. Then vertically place a transparent pink 1x2 brick on the

3rd column from the left, in front of the ppp. Now vertically place 2 tan 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so the brick grooves face outwards to the left and right.

Group 29 - End Ship

Step 17

Place a tan 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Now horizontally place a transparent pink 1x2 brick to the left of the back row of the ppp. Then place the back row of a tan 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter d.

You will have 3 extra tan 2x2 corner bricks. Save them for later!

Group 30 - End Ship

Step 18

Place a light purple 2x2 corner brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it looks like the braille letter f. Now place the back row of a tan 2x2 corner brick from group 29 to the right of the front row of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter f.

Step 19

Horizontally place a tan 1x2 masonry brick on the 5th row from the front on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the brick grooves face the front. Then vertically place a transparent pink 1x2 brick behind the left column of the ppp. Now place the left column of a tan 2x2 corner brick behind the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h.

Step 20.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 masonry brick on the back left corner so the brick grooves face the back. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with a down-facing pin on the front left corner so the pin is in the front left. Now attach a light purple 1x2 brick with an upright pinhole to the pin of the ppp so it overhangs to the left.

Step 20.2

Horizontally place the overhang of your part on the 2nd row from the front on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left.

Step 21

Place a light purple 2x2 brick on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left and 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Now horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp so the brick grooves face outwards to the front and back and they sit on the 1x2 brick with a pin.

Step 22

Place a tan 2x2 brick on top of the 2 ppp. Then place a light purple 2x2 corner brick to the left of the ppp so it looks like the braille letter h. Then place a tan 2x2 corner brick from group 29 behind the ppp so it looks like the braille letter d. Make sure there is no gap between the 2 ppp.

Group 31 - End Ship

Step 23

Place a light purple 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back and 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then horizontally place a tan 2x6 brick to the right of the ppp. Now vertically place 1 in front of the previous 2x2 brick.

Step 24

Horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick in front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 masonry brick to the right of the ppp so the brick grooves face the back.

Step 25

Horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick with an upright pin hole on the 2nd row from the front on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the pinhole is in the front right. Now horizontally attach the down-facing pin of a tan 1x2 brick with a pin to the hole of the ppp so the brick sits to the right of the ppp.

Step 26

Vertically place a magenta 2x4 tile on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th rows from the front. Now vertically place another 1 behind the ppp. Then horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of another 1 behind the ppp. Now horizontally place 2 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp.

Step 27

Vertically place a dark grey 4x10 plate underneath the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and 3 columns are exposed to the right.

Step 28

Horizontally place a dark grey 2x8 plate on the back right corner so it overhangs 4 columns to the right.

Step 29

Vertically place the back 2 rows of a dark grey 4x10 plate underneath the 4 rightmost columns.

Group 32 - End Ship

Step 30

Place a dark grey 2x2 tile on the front right corner. Then horizontally place 2 dark grey 2x4 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the ppp. Now vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the 8th column from the right so it is centered vertically.

Step 31

Horizontally place a black 1x6 plate on the 3rd row from the front so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a dark grey 2x8 plate underneath the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Now vertically place a dark grey 2x4 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate on the front right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 32

Place a dark grey 2x2 tile with a stud on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it is centered vertically.

Group 33 - End Ship

Step 33

Vertically place a magenta 2x8 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then place a magenta 2x2 plate on the back 2 rows to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate to the left of the ppp.

Step 34

Let's make a part! Place a magenta 2x2 corner plate in front of you so it looks like the braille letter h. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x8 brick on the left column so it overhangs 7 columns to the left.

Step 35

Place a magenta 2x2 plate underneath the 2x8 brick so it sits to the left of the 2x2 corner plate. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate underneath the brick to the left of the ppp.

Step 36

Place a magenta 1x1 brick on the front right corner. Then place 2 magenta 1x1 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 3rd column from the left.

Step 37.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally stack 2 transparent pink 1x2 bricks on the front left corner. Then horizontally place 2 tan 1x2 masonry bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 rightmost columns so the brick grooves face outwards to the front and back.

Step 37.2

Place a tan 2x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns. Now horizontally place a tan 2x4 brick on top so it is centered horizontally.

Step 37.3

Horizontally place your part on the 2 leftmost columns of your previous part so it overhangs 2 columns to the left and the transparent pink bricks are on the left.

Group 34 - End Ship

Step 38

Stack 2 light purple 2x2 bricks on the 5th and 6th columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 39

Stack 2 light purple 2x2 corner bricks on the 2 rightmost columns so they look like the braille letter h.

Step 40

Horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick on the front right corner so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Now place a magenta 1x1 brick behind the leftmost column of the ppp. Now horizontally place a magenta 2x8 brick to the left of the 2 ppp.

Step 41

Horizontally place a purple 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row on the 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th columns from the left. Then horizontally place 2 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp.

Now vertically place a magenta 1x2 tile to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp. Then place a magenta 2x2 plate to the right of the ppp.

Step 42

Place a magenta 1x1 plate on the front right corner. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.

Step 43

Horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front on the 6th and 7th columns from the left. It should sit on the part that rotates to the front!

Step 44

Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 tile on top of the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front on the 4th to 7th columns from the left.

Step 45

Make sure that the part that can rotate is horizontal and not overhanging to the front!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 1):

Group 35 - End Ship

Step 46

Place a white 2L bar with a stop on the 2x2 tile with a stud that is on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 47

Place a magenta 2x8 brick on the back 2 rows to the left of the 2 rightmost columns. Now place a light purple 2x2 brick to the left of the ppp.

Step 48

Stack 2 light purple 2x2 bricks on the back 2 rows on the 7th and 8th columns from the right. Then stack 2 more to the left so there are 2 columns in between them.

Step 49

Place a light purple 2x2 corner brick on the back 2 rows on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it looks like the braille letter f.

Step 50

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 brick on the back 2 rows to the left of the ppp so it sits on the stacks of 2x2 bricks and overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Step 51

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x8 plate in front of you.

Step 52

Vertically place 4 magenta 2x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top so they overhang 2 rows to the back.

Step 53

Place a magenta 1x1 brick on the front right corner. Then vertically place a magenta 1x4 brick behind the ppp so it overhangs 1 row to the back.

Step 54

Place a magenta 1x1 brick on the back row of the 2nd column from the right. Then place a tan 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp.

Step 55

Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick on the back 2 rows to the left of the 2 ppp.

Step 56

Place a magenta 1x1 brick on the back row on the 2nd column from the left. Then place a tan 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp.

Step 57

Vertically stack 2 magenta 1x4 bricks on the leftmost column.

Step 58

Vertically place a magenta 1x4 brick on the front right corner. Now horizontally place a light brown 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the back. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick to the left and right of the ppp.

Step 59

Place a magenta 2x2 corner brick on the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick on the back row to the right of the ppp. Now place a magenta 1x1 brick to the right of the ppp.

Step 60

Horizontally place a tan 1x2x2 brick on the 2nd row from the back so it is centered horizontally.

Step 61

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns of the main build so it is centered vertically and the shorter side overhangs 2 columns to the right and the side studs face the left.

Step 62

Place a light purple 2x2 brick on the back 2 rows on the 5th and 6th columns from the right. Then horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of a magenta 2x4 brick on top of the ppp.

Group 36 - End Ship

Step 63

Horizontally place 2 magenta 1x2 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row of studs to the right of the 1x2 tiles. Now horizontally place a 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front of the 2 ppp. Then vertically place a magenta 1x2 tile to the right of the 2 ppp.

Step 64

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate to the right of the ppp. Then vertically place a magenta 2x6 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it is centered vertically.

Step 65

Vertically place a magenta 1x2 tile on the back 2 rows of studs on the 11th column from the right. Then horizontally place 1 on the back row to the right of the ppp so there are 2 free columns in between them. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front. Now horizontally place 1 on the 2 rightmost columns of the front row.

Step 66

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Now place a magenta 2x2 corner brick on the back left corner so it looks like the braille letter f. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 67

Horizontally place a tan 1x2 log brick on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a magenta 2x4 brick behind the ppp so it overhangs 2 rows to the back.

Step 68

Vertically place a magenta 1x4 brick on the front left corner so it overhangs 2 rows to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 69

Horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick on the 3rd row from the back so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place the back row of another 1 to the left of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 70

Rotate your part 90 degrees clockwise. Now horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick on the 2 rightmost columns so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 log brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a light blue 2x2 brick on the 6th and 7th columns from the right so it is centered vertically.

Step 71

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 brick on the 7 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the right. Now horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick in front of the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the left of the ppp so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 72

Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick on the front left corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 73

Vertically place 4 magenta 2x6 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 8 leftmost columns from the left so they are centered vertically.

Step 74

Horizontally place a magenta 1x1 plate on the back row on the 4th column from the left. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate to the left of the ppp.

Step 75

Horizontally place a magenta 1x6 plate on the front row so it overhangs 2 columns to the left.

Step 76

Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tile on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left. Then horizontally place another 1 on the back row on the 4th and 5th columns from the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 77

Horizontally place your part on the 3 rightmost columns of the main build so it is centered vertically.

Step 78

Place a magenta 2x2 corner plate on the back 2 rows on the 11th and 12th columns from the right so it looks like the braille letter h. There is a 1 column gap in between this and a 1x2 tile that is to the right.

Step 79

Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 tile on the back row on top of the ppp so there is no overhang.

Group 37 - End Ship

Step 80

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 81

Vertically place a purple 2x4 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 3 rows to the front. Now vertically place a dark grey 2x3 plate underneath the overhang. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Now horizontally place a purple 2x4 brick on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and overhangs 3 columns to the left. Now horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 plate underneath the overhang of the ppp.

Step 82

Horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick on the back right corner of the 4x6 plate so it overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Step 83

Horizontally place the back left corner of a dark grey 4x6 plate underneath the 2 rightmost columns.

Step 84

Horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick on the back row on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick to the right of the ppp so it overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Step 85

Horizontally place the back left corner of a dark grey 4x6 plate underneath the 2 rightmost columns.

Step 86

Horizontally place 2 magenta 1x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front right corner. Now horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick to the left of the ppp. Then horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick to the left of the ppp.

Step 87

Horizontally place a purple 2x4 brick on the 3 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 88.1

Flip your part over so it is horizontal and the 2x3 part faces the right. Now place a dark grey 2x2 inverted round tile with a rounded bottom on the front 2 rows. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 88.2

Place a dark grey 2x2 inverted round tile with a rounded bottom on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it is centered vertically. Now place 2 dark grey 2x2 inverted round tiles with a rounded bottom, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so they are centered vertically.

Step 88.3

Place a dark grey 2x2 inverted round tile with a rounded bottom on the 7th and 8th columns from the left so it is centered vertically. This should connect the 2 4x6 plates! Now place another 1 on the 9th and 10th columns from the right so it is centered vertically. This should also connect the 2 4x6 plates!

Step 89

Flip your main build upside down so the angled side faces the left. Now horizontally place the rightmost column of your part on the rightmost column of the main build so it is centered vertically.

Step 90.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place another 1 on top so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Now horizontally place 1 more on top so it overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Step 90.2

Flip your main build over so it is right-side up and the angled end faces the right. Now horizontally place your part on the 10th, 11th, 12th, and 13th columns from the right so it is centered vertically and overhangs to the right.

Step 91.1

Let's make a part! Place a magenta 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a magenta 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.

Step 91.2

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the long side on the right column so the connector faces the right.

Step 91.3

Place a magenta 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a white 2L bar with a stop on top.

Step 91.4

Attach a black dragon head with 2 side studs to the right-facing hinge connector so the side studs are on top and face the right. Now place a black 1x2 tile printed with pink eyes upright on the right-facing side studs.

Step 91.5

Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so it is centered vertically and the head faces the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 6, Book 1):

Group 38 - Brewing Stand

Step 92

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 plate in front of you. Then place a yellow 1x1 round plate with a hollow stud on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 93

Place a light grey 1x1 plate on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place 1 on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Group 39 - Brewing Stand

Step 94

Place a transparent yellow head on the back right corner. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top of the head so the anti-stud faces up. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.

Group 40 - Brewing Stand

Step 95

Place a transparent red head on the back left corner. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top of the head so the anti-stud faces up. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of the ppp.

Group 41 - Brewing Stand

Step 96

Place a gold 3L bar on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 97.1

Let's make a part! Place a yellow 1x1 round plate with a hollow stud in front of you. Now place a black 1x1 plate on top. Then place a black 1x1 brick with a side stud on each side on top.

Step 97.2

Insert a black T-shaped bar into the left-facing side stud so the bar faces up and down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now insert another 1 into the front-facing side stud so the bar faces up and down.

Step 98

Vertically place your part on the main build on the 2 1x2 jumper plates that are to the right of the leftmost 2x4 tiles so it is centered vertically on them and the heads are on the left.

Group 42 - End Ship

Step 99.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick on the 4 rightmost columns.

Step 99.2

Vertically place a magenta 2x4 brick on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate underneath the front row of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 99.3

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 6 columns to the left.

Step 99.4

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate underneath the 6 leftmost columns so 2 columns are exposed to the left.

Step 99.5

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 6 columns to the left.

Step 99.6

Place a magenta 2x2 plate underneath the 2 leftmost columns. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate underneath the brick to the right of the ppp.

Step 99.7

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate on the 8 rightmost columns. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x2 plate in front of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 99.8

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2x2 anti side studs on the leftmost column so the anti-studs face the left. Now vertically place a magenta 1x2 plate to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate to the right of the ppp.

Step 99.9

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2x2 anti side studs underneath the leftmost column so the 2x2 anti side studs face the left.

Step 99.10

Place your part upright to the right of the brewing stand that is on the left side of the main build so there are 7 free columns in between them, it is centered vertically and the side studs face the right. It should sit to the right of the 1x2 plate! This is the ship's mast!

Step 100

Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 brick upright on the right-facing side studs of the ppp on the 5th and 6th rows from the top. Then repeat symmetrically to the left on the left-facing anti-studs of the mast.

Step 101

Make sure the front row of the build that can rotate is horizontal and not overhanging to the front.

Step 102

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light purple 1x6 plate underneath the rightmost column so 4 rows are exposed to the front.

Step 103

Horizontally place a light purple 6x10 plate underneath the 3 leftmost columns so it is aligned with the 1x6 plate.

Step 104

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate on the back 2 rows so it overhangs 1 column to the left.

Step 105

Vertically place a light purple 1x6 plate underneath the leftmost column so it is aligned with the 6x10 plate.

Step 106

Vertically place a magenta 2x8 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it overhangs 4 rows to the front.

Step 107

Vertically place a light purple 1x6 plate underneath the leftmost columns so 2 rows are exposed to the front.

Step 108

Horizontally place a light purple 6x10 plate underneath the 2x8 plate, to the right of the ppp.

Step 109

Horizontally place a magenta 2x8 plate on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp so 1 column overhangs to the right.

Step 110

Vertically place a light purple 1x6 plate underneath the front right corner so 4 rows are exposed to the back.

Step 111

Place a light purple 2x2 brick on the front left corner. Then place a magenta 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 112

Horizontally place 2 magenta 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2nd row from the front so they are centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 2 more, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd column from the left so they are centered vertically.

Step 113

Vertically place a magenta 2x8 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Step 114.1

Let's make a part! Place a magenta 2x2 inverted tile in front of you. Now place a magenta 2x2 tile with a stud with corner walls on top.

Step 114.2

Place a tan 1x1 plate on top. Then place a tan 1x1 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 114.3

Place a magenta 2x2 tile with side walls on top so the anti-studs face up.

Step 114.4

This is a shulker's box! Now flip it over so the anti-studs face down, then place it on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically.

Step 115

Place the leftmost column of your part on the 2nd column from the left of the main build so it is centered vertically and sits on the 2x4 tiles.
