

21268 The Baby Pig House

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The Baby Pig House (21268) is the ideal toy for Minecraft® players with a passion for home-building, animals and farms. This hands-on Minecraft toy for girls and boys makes a great birthday, holiday or any-day gaming gift for kids aged 7 and up.

Set in the Minecraft forest biome, this creative home-building toy includes many figures from the popular video game: a hero character in a wolf skin, a baby pig, bee, an adult pig and a zombified piglin. Kids can replicate action from the game, like saddling up the adult pig and dangling a carrot in front of it to take a ride around the pig-shaped house and garden. There's a farm plot with potatoes and beets to grow, and a field with a gate to guide the baby pig through. Kids can avoid the zombified piglin, who wants to spoil the fun, by going inside the house, where there's a bed, bookcase and a crafting table to inspire imaginative play.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the hero, a pig, and the pig house.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the pig house.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the zombified piglin and the pig house.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for a pig, accessories, and the pig house.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/21268>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 4 bags labeled 1 to 4, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same

brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Wolf Skin Hero

Sub-build 1.1. Locate 1 light grey pair of legs, 1 light grey torso printed with a dark grey v neck, 1 light brown square head printed with a light grey wolf mask with white and black ears. Assemble your minifigure then put him in front of you!

Sub-build 1.2. Locate 2 orange carrots, a brown whip, and a green stem. Attach the stem to 1 carrot and the end of the whip to the other! Now attach them both to your minifigure's hands! Now put him away while we make a pig!

Group 2 - Pig and Container

Sub-build 2.1. Let's make a pig! Stack 2 pink 2x3 plates so there is no overhang, then horizontally place them in front of you.

Sub-build 2.2. Vertically place a pink 1x2 brick with a vertical gap underneath the leftmost column so the gap faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Sub-build 2.3. Place a light brown 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 leftmost columns so the studs are on the left. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 tile with a square pig head printed with eyes and nose on the rightmost column so the head faces the right. Now put your pig away while we make a container!

Sub-build 3. Place a brown 2x2x2 container in front of you. Then insert a green stem and 2 brown bars inside! Then place 3 sand blue 1x1 round plates next to the container! Now put everything away while we make the pig house!

Group 3 - Pig House

Step 1

Horizontally place a green 8x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the back right corner.

Step 2

Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on the rightmost column in front of the ppp.

Step 3

Vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the front right corner so it overhangs 2 rows to the front.

Step 4

Horizontally place a green 6x8 plate underneath the overhang so the rightmost column aligns with the rightmost column of the build.

Step 5

Place a pink 2x2 brick to the left of the front 2 rows of the front 2x4 brick. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate to the left of the front row of the ppp. Then place a pink 2x2 brick to the left so it is aligned with the previous 2x2 brick.

Step 6

Vertically place a pink 2x4 brick to the left of the ppp so it overhangs 2 rows to the front. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 plate behind the left column of the ppp. Now vertically place a pink 2x4 brick behind it so it is aligned with the previous 2x4 brick.

Group 4 - Pig House

Step 7

Horizontally place a brown 6x8 plate underneath the overhang so the leftmost column is aligned with the leftmost column of the build.

Step 8

Place a transparent blue 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows on the 7th and 8th columns from the left. Then horizontally place the 2 leftmost columns of a transparent blue 2x4 plate behind it.

Step 9

Vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the back right corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2x2 brick in front of the left column of it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left on the 7th and 8th columns from the left.

Step 10

Place a bright pink 2x2 brick in front of each of the previous 1x2x2 bricks so there is no overhang.

Step 11

Horizontally place a pink 2x4 brick on the 4 rightmost columns in front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2x2 brick to the left of the back row of it. Now horizontally place a pink 2x4 brick to the left so there is no overhang.

Step 12

Place a bright pink 2x2 brick on the back right corner. Then place another 1 on the back 2 rows of the 7th and 8th columns from the left.

Step 13

Vertically place a pink 2x8 brick in front of each of the 2 ppp. Then horizontally place a pink 2x6 brick in between the front 2 rows of the 2x8 bricks.

Step 14

Vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the back right corner. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 brick with a vertical gap on the rightmost column in front of the ppp so the gap faces the left. Now vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the back 4 rows on the 7th and 8th columns from the left. Then place a bright pink 2x2 brick in front.

You will have an extra white 2x4 tile printed with a grass area with blue skies, and 2 pigs next to each other. Save it for later!

Group 5 - Pig House

Step 15.1

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with 2 side studs to the left of the 1x2 brick with a vertical gap from the previous step so the side studs face the left. Then vertically place a pink 1x4 brick on the rightmost column in front of the 1x2 brick with a vertical gap.

Step 15.2

Vertically place a pink 1x4 brick in front of the 2x2 brick on the 7th column from the left. Now place 2 pink 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 to the right of the other, to the right of the front 2 rows of the ppp so they are centered horizontally between the 1x4 bricks.

Step 16

Place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud on the back right corner. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 tile in front. Now vertically place a pink 1x4 tile on the rightmost column in front. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the left on the 7th and 8th columns from the left.

Step 17

Horizontally place the back right corner of a white 2x4 tile printed with a grass area with blue skies and 2 pigs next to each other, from group 4, upright on the left-facing side studs that are on the right, so it overhangs 2 columns to the left and 1 row down.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 6 - Pig House

Step 18

Let's make a part! Let's make the pig head of the house! Vertically place a pink 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the back 4 rows.

Step 19

Horizontally place a pink 2x8 brick on the front 2 rows so it overhangs 6 columns to the left. Then horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate underneath the overhang so the 2x8 brick still overhangs 2 columns to the left.

Step 20

Vertically place a pink 2x6 plate underneath the overhang so 4 rows are exposed to the back. Then vertically place a pink 2x4 brick on the back 4 rows of it.

Step 21

Vertically place a pink 2x6 plate on the 2 leftmost columns. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 22

Horizontally place a bright pink 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

You will have 4 extra brown 1x1 plates. Save them for later!

Group 7 - Pig House

Step 23.1

Let's make a part! Let's make the nose! Horizontally place a pink 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 23.2

Place a pink 1x1 plate on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 23.3

Stack 2 brown 1x1 plates from group 6 together, then place them on the front left corner. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 23.4

Horizontally place a pink 1x4 tile on the front row.

Step 23.5

Horizontally place your part on the front row of your previous part so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 1 row to the front. The 1x4 tile should be in the front!

Step 24

Horizontally place a pink 2x4 brick on the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a pink 2x8 brick in front of them so it is centered horizontally.

Step 25

Horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 26

Vertically place a pink 2x4 brick in front of each of the 2 ppp. Then horizontally place another 1 behind the 1x4 tile so it is centered horizontally.

Step 27.1

Place a black 1x1 brick on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 8 - Pig House

Step 27.2

Place a white 1x1 brick on the front row on the 2nd column from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 28

Horizontally place 3 pink 2x8 bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top so they are centered.

Step 29

Place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud on the back left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a pink 2x4 tile in between them. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the front. Then horizontally place 2 pink 2x4 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the middle 2 rows.

Step 30

Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the pig house is in the back right. Now horizontally place your part in between the front 1x4 tiles of the pig house so it overhangs 3 rows to the front. The pig nose should face the front!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 9 - Zombified Piglin

Sub-build 4. Let's make a piglin! Locate 1 brown pair of legs, 1 pink torso printed with green and red flesh, 1 pink head with ears and a nose printed with a large eye and a small eye, and 1 gold sword. Assemble your minifigure then attach the sword to his hand! Now put him away while we continue the pig house!

Group 10 - Pig House

Step 31

Horizontally place a light green 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the back 2 rows on the 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th columns from the left. Then place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left and 5th and 6th rows from the front. Now vertically place the front 2 rows of a light green 2x4 tile with 2 studs to the right.

Step 32

Place a nougat 2x2 brick on the back left corner. Then place another 1 to the left of the 2x2 tile with a stud from the previous step.

Step 33

Let's make a part! Let's make more land! Vertically place a green 6x8 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light green 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Step 34

Horizontally place a light green 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the front right corner so it overhangs 2 columns to the right. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 2 rightmost columns on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back so it overhangs 2 columns to the right.

Step 35

Attach the overhang of your part to the 2 leftmost columns of the main build in between the previous 2x2 bricks.

Step 36

Place a nougat 1x1 brick on each of the studs of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs that is to the right of the 2x2 brick on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front. Now place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of each of the 1x1 bricks.

Step 37

Place a nougat 2x2 corner plate on the 2x2 brick that is on the back row so it looks like the braille letter d. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 38

Place a brown 1x1 plate with a clip in front of the left column of the back 2x2 corner plate from the previous step so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Group 11 - Pig House

Step 39

Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the back ppp and 2x2 corner plate. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x4 tile to the right so it is centered horizontally on top of the 2 1x1 round plates. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 40

Horizontally attach the bar of a brown 1x2 plate with a bar on the short side to the front-facing clip so the tile side faces the left. Then horizontally place a nougat 1x2 tile upright on it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 41.1

Place an orange 1x1 round plate on the 2nd column from the left of the front row. Then place another 1 on the leftmost column of the 2nd row from the front.

Group 12 - Pig House

Step 41.2

Place a tan 1x1 round plate on the 4th column from the left of the front row. Then place another 1 on the 3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the front.

Group 13 - Pig House

Step 41.3

Place a pink 1x1 round plate on the 6th column from the left of the front row. Then place another 1 on the 5th column from the left of the 2nd row from the front.

Step 42

Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on the 2nd column from the left of the 3rd row from the front. Then place another 1 on the leftmost column of the 4th row from the front. Now place a yellow stem on top of each of them.

Step 43

Place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the 6 1x1 round plates you placed in step 41.

Group 14 - Pig House

Step 44

Place a green stem on top of the 2 leftmost 1x1 round flower plates from the previous step.

Step 45

Vertically place a light green 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the front right corner so it overhangs 2 rows to the front. Then vertically place another 1 on the front 2 rows of the 7th and 8th columns from the right so it overhangs 2 rows to the front. Now horizontally place a blue 4x8 plate underneath the overhang of them.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 15 - Accessories

Step 46.1

Let's make a table! Place a black 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a nougat 2x2 brick on top.

Step 46.2

Place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a tan 1x2 rounded tile on top so it is centered and the short ends face the front left and back right. Now put it away while we make a crafting table!

Step 47

Place a black 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 nougat 1x2 bricks printed with horizontal and vertical lines, 1 in front of the other, on top so the prints face outwards to the front and back. Now place a nougat 2x2 tile printed with a brown grid on top. Now put it away while we make the bed!

Group 16 - Accessories

Step 48.1

Let's make the bed! Horizontally place a brown 2x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 round plate underneath the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost columns.

Step 48.2

Place a white 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then horizontally place a blue 2x4 plate to the left.

Step 48.3

Place a white 2x2 tile on the 2 rightmost columns. Then horizontally place a blue 2x4 plate to the left. Now put away your bed while we make a flower pot!

You will have an extra red 1x1 round flower plate. Save it for later!

Group 17 - Accessories and Pig

Step 49

Place a short red 1x1 brown brick in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top. Now place a red 1x1 round flower plate from group 16 on top. Now put it away while we make a pig!

Step 50.1

Let's make a part! Place a black 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 brick with a vertical gap on the back row so the gap faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 50.2

Vertically place a pink 1x2 plate on the right column.

Step 50.3

Vertically place a pink 1x2 tile with a square pig head printed with eyes and a nose on top of the left column so the head faces the left. Now put it away so we can make the bookshelf!

Step 51.1

Let's make a part! Place a nougat 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a blue 1x1 brick on the back right corner.

You will have an extra white 1x1 plate. Save it for later!

Group 18 - Accessories

Step 51.2

Place a green 1x1 plate on the back left corner. Then place a white 1x1 plate from group 17 on top. Now place another green 1x1 plate on top!

Step 51.3

Place a lime green 1x1 brick on the front left corner.

Group 19 - Accessories

Step 51.4

Stack 2 red 1x1 plates together then place them on the front right corner.

Group 20 - Accessories

Step 51.5

Place a black 1x1 plate on the front right corner. Then place a nougat 2x2 tile with a stud on top so it is centered. Now put your bookshelf away while we make 2 torches!

Group 21 - Accessories

There are no steps in this group! You will have 2 extra transparent orange 1x1 plates. Save them for later!

Group 22 - Accessories

Step 52.1

Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make torches! Place a dark brown 1x1 telescope bar in front of you. Then place a transparent yellow 1x1 plate on top. Now place a transparent orange 1x1 plate from group 21 on top.

Step 52.2

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Put them away so we can continue building!

Step 53

Bring back your main build so it is horizontal and the pig house is in the back right corner. Now place a green 1x1 round brick with 4 petals on the front stud of the left 2x4 tile with 2 studs that is on the 3rd row from the front. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top.

Group 23 - Pig House

Step 54.1

Let's make a part! Let's make a sunflower! Place a green 1x1 round brick with 4 petals in front of you. Then place a green 4L bar on top.

Step 54.2

Attach the stud of a green 1x1 round plate with an angled bar underneath to the top of the bar so the bar faces the front.

Step 54.3

Attach the stud of a yellow 2x2 round tile with a stud to the angled bar so the anti-studs face the front.

Step 54.4

Place an orange 1x1 round flower plate upright on the anti-studs so it is centered.

Step 55

Place your sunflower on the back stud of the right 2x4 tile with 2 studs that is on the 3rd row from the front.

You will have an extra yellow 1x1 plate. Save it for later!

Group 24 - Pig House

Step 56.1

Let's make a part! Let's make a bee! Place a brown 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate from group 23 on top. Now place another brown 1x1 plate on top.

Step 56.2

Place a yellow 1x1 brick with a side stud and bottom lip on top so the side stud faces the left. Then place a yellow 1x1 tile printed with 2 eyes on top.

Step 56.3

Horizontally place a transparent 1x2 plate upright on the left-facing side stud so it is centered horizontally.

Step 56.4

Place a transparent 1x1 round plate upright on the right-facing anti-stud. Then attach the bar of a transparent bar with an anti-stud to the ppp. Now lift your part up so it sits on the bar with an anti-stud.

Step 57

Place your part on the front right corner so the 1x1 tile faces the front left.

Step 58

Place a green plant with 3 stems on the front stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs that is on the leftmost column. Then attach a yellow 1x1 round plate to each of the stems.

You will have an extra 2x2 red plate. Save it for later!

Group 25 - Pig House

Step 59

Let's make a part! Let's make hay! Stack 2 yellow 2x2 plates together so there is no overhang, then place them in front of you. Now place a red 2x2 plate from group 24 on top. Then place a yellow 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Now place your part to the left of the pig house and in front of the front 1x4 tile.

Group 26 - Pig House

Step 60

Let's make a part! Let's make a tree! Place a white 2x2 brick in front of you! Then place a white 2x2 corner brick on top so it looks like the braille letter d.

Step 61

Place a black 1x1 brick on the front left corner.

Step 62

Place a white 2x2 corner brick on top so it looks like the braille letter h. Now place a black 1x1 brick on the back right corner.

Step 63

Stack 2 white 2x2 bricks on top so there is no overhang.

Step 64

Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down on top of the left column so the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 65

Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down on top of the front row so the side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 66

Horizontally place a green 2x4 brick upright on the left-facing side studs so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 27 - Pig House

Step 67

Vertically place a dark green 2x4 brick upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered vertically on it. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 28 - Pig House

Step 68

Horizontally place a green 2x4 brick on top so it is centered horizontally. Now place a green 2x2 brick on top so it is centered.

Step 69

Place your tree on the back left corner of the main build.

Step 70

Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now vertically place your bed inside the pig house, skipping the front row, so it is centered horizontally inside, and the tile is in the back. Now place your crafting table to the left of the 2x2 tile of the bed. Then place your table to the right of the 2x2 tile of the bed.

Step 71

Place your bookshelf on the left 2x2 tile with a stud that is inside the pig head. Then place your flower pot to the right.
