

40573 Christmas Tree

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Create an eye-catching festive display with this beautiful LEGO® Christmas Tree (40573) building kit. A perfect gift this holiday season, you can choose between building one tree or two smaller tree models. Decorate your very own miniature Christmas tree with colorful ornaments and candles. Add the yellow star to the top for the perfect final touch. Display your finished build on the red tree skirt for a beautiful holiday centerpiece with tabletop decoration.

A Christmas tree with a difference – Create a festive centerpiece with this LEGO® Christmas Tree (40573) building kit. Treat yourself or give it as a gift for kids and Christmas fans aged 12 and up.

2-in-1 build – Choose to build 1 tree or 2 smaller trees. With each option you can have lots of fun adding the festive decorations to the branches.

Measurements – The taller tree stands over 11 in. (30 cm) tall. The medium tree stands over 9 in. (23 cm) tall. The small tree stands over 6 in. (16 cm) tall. Choose to build 1 or 2 trees.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- “Anti-stud” is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).
- For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set:

As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3 and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 10 plastic bags which are not labeled and 2 sets of instructions. The first booklet guides you through building the large Christmas tree, while the second contains the steps to create both the medium-sized tree and the small tree. To build the second option, you'll need to reuse pieces from the large tree, which means you'll first have to disassemble them before starting the medium and small versions.

Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into different groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder. LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Before you begin building the main model, the Christmas tree, you may find it helpful to get a sense of what the finished tree looks like. This can make it easier to understand the structure as you build and how each layer fits into the whole. The tree is built in 13 stacked layers, each made of 4 branches arranged like a cross—pointing forward, back, left, and right. As the tree

risers, each layer becomes slightly smaller and is rotated so its branches sit between those of the layer below, creating a spiraling, interlaced effect. This staggered layout ensures that the decorations at the tips of each branch—red and white balls, candles, red hearts, and white and gold festive elements—remain visible and evenly spaced. The tree stands on a square colorful base with small gifts, and is topped with a golden star, forming a full, elegant silhouette that tapers gently from bottom to top.

Here are a few important placement guidelines:

Rows and Columns: Unless we say otherwise, rows and columns are counted across the whole build.

Choosing Columns: If a part spans more than one row, use the row with more columns to decide where to place it. Horizontally place a dark red 1x3 tile across the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back. If the 2nd row has more columns than the 3rd, we'll use the 2nd row to determine the column reference.

In some builds, especially those with irregular shapes or staggered layers, not all rows have the same number of columns. This means that counting columns across the entire build can be confusing or misleading.

To make things easier, we'll sometimes count columns from a specific row, rather than from the full build. This helps the builder focus on the exact area where the new piece will go. To reflect this change, we'll adjust our phrasing. Instead of saying: "Horizontally place a 1x2 plate on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right." We'll say: "Horizontally place a 1x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right of the front row."

This makes it clear that we're only counting columns within that row—not across the whole build—since other rows may have different lengths or shapes.

In some cases, to help the builder identify where to place the LEGO pieces, we will provide landmarks in addition to row and column references. These landmarks are nearby pieces that serve as tactile guides. Example: Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so the back row sits on the front row of the back left 2x2 corner plate, and the front row sits on the back row of the front left 2x2 corner plate.

All bags

Group 1: contains the pieces for steps 1-4 and 4 gold hearts you will use later in step 5.

Group 2: contains the pieces for step 5-16 and 8 green 1x1 quarter round tiles you will use later in steps 6 and 7.

Group 3: contains the pieces for steps 6 and 7.

Group 4: contains the pieces for steps 8-11.

Group 5: contains the pieces for steps 12-28.

Group 6: contains the pieces for steps 29-43.

Group 7: contains the pieces for steps 44-49 and 2 gold 1x1 flower plates you will use later in step 50.

Group 8: contains the pieces for steps 50-55.

Group 9: contains the pieces for steps 56-63.

Group 10: contains the pieces for steps 64-67.

Group 11: contains the pieces for steps 68-80.

Group 12: contains the pieces for steps 81-93.

Group 13: contains the pieces for steps 94-100.

Group 14: contains the pieces for steps 101-110.

Group 15: contains the pieces for steps 111-119.

Group 16: contains the pieces for steps 120-128.

Group 17: contains the pieces for steps 129-138.

Group 18: contains the pieces for steps 139-147.

Group 19: contains the pieces for steps 148-158.

Group 20: contains the pieces for steps 159-160.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (All bags, Book 1):

Group 1:

Step 1

Let's start by building the base! Place a white 8x8 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows. Place a red 4x4 round plate with axle hole underneath the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, and the axle hole is even with the axle hole of the ppp.

Step 2

Vertically place the 2 back rows of a dark red 4x6 plate in front of the ppp under the 2 front rows of your build, so it is centered horizontally, and 4 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a dark red 4x6 plate under the 2 right columns of your build, so it is centered vertically, and 4 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. You should have a cross shape.

Step 3

Turn your build upside down, so a vertical 4x6 plate is in front of you. Place a dark red 6x6 quarter round plate to the left of the front vertical 4x6 plate, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both placements symmetrically to the back.

Step 4

Turn your build right side up. Place a dark red 1x4 curved corner tile on the back right corner. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front. horizontally place a dark red 1x8 tile on the back row, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a dark red 1x8 tile on the leftmost column between the front left and the back left corners, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 2:

Step 5.1

Orient a red 1x4 curved corner tile so the round corner faces the back left. Place the rightmost column on the 5th row from the front on the 2nd column from the right counting the entire build. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both placements symmetrically to the back. You should have formed 4 quarter circles on the corners of the base.

Step 5.2

Place a white heart tile at the center of the front right quarter circle — on the 3rd row from the front on the 3rd column from the right, so the lobes of the heart face the front right and the tip faces the back left. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both placements symmetrically to the back.

Step 5.3

Place a gold heart tile on the 5th row from the front and the 5th column from the right, so the lobes face the front right and the tip faces the back left. It sits behind the back left corner of the front right red 1x4 curved corner tile from the previous step, diagonally aligned with the front right white heart. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both placements symmetrically to the back.

Group 3:

Step 6.1

Let's build the first decorative border! Let's call it decorative border A! Place a dark green 1x1 quarter round tile on the 2nd row from the front on the 6th column from the left to the right of the front row of the front left red 1x4 curved corner tile from the previous step, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Place another to the right of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front left, and the rounded edge faces the back right. Repeat both placements symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both to the back.

Step 6.2

Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 tile on the 3rd row from the front on the 6th and 7th columns from the left, so it sits behind the front left dark green 1x1 quarter round tiles. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 6.3

Place a green 1x1 quarter round tile to the right of the front left dark red horizontal 1x2 tile, so the right angle faces the front left, and the rounded edge faces the back right. place another to the right of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right and the rounded edge faces the back left. Place another in front of the ppp, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Place another to the left of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right and the rounded edge faces the back left. rotate your build 180 degrees then repeat the 4 last placements. You should have a symmetrical decorative border A on the front and on the back of the base.

Step 7.1

Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise, so the decorative borders face the left and the right. Let's make decorative border B! Place a green 1x1 quarter round tile on the 2nd row from the front on the 6th column from the left to the right of the front row of the front left red 1x4 curved corner tile from step 5, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Place another to the right of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front left, and the

rounded edge faces the back right. Repeat both placements symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both placements to the back.

Step 7.2

Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 tile on the 3rd row from the front on the 6th and 7th columns from the left, so it sits behind the front left dark green 1x1 quarter round tiles. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 7.3

Place a dark green 1x1 quarter round tile to the right of the front left dark red horizontal 1x2 tile, so the right angle faces the front left, and the rounded edge faces the back right. Place another to the right of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right and the rounded edge faces the back left. Place another in front of the ppp, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Place another to the left of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right and the rounded edge faces the back left. Rotate your build 180 degrees then repeat the 4 last placements. Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise so the last decorative border B you have just arranged faces the left and a decorative border A faces the front. You should have 4 decorative borders on the base, 2 decorative borders A and 2 decorative borders B. These decorative borders represent wrapped presents. Because the base of the tree is perfectly square and the only difference between Decorative Borders A and B is the color of the 1x1 quarter-round tiles, it can be difficult to tell which side is which without sight. To help track orientation later in the build, you may want to mark the front side of the base once Decorative Borders A and B are placed. One option is to temporarily attach a 1x1 round plate just in front of the front-left white heart (on Border A). Alternatively, one could place a small piece of tape on the quarter-round tiles in the front. Or you can ask for sighted help to confirm the front and remember its position throughout the build.

Group 4:

Step 8

Turn your build upside down. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on the build so it is centered horizontally and vertically, and the axle hole is even with the axle holes of the pieces beneath it. Place a green 2x2 plate on the 6th and 7th rows from the front on the 6th and 7th columns of antistuds, so the back right corner sits in front of the front left edge notch of the ppp. Place another symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 9.1

Place a black 1x6 curved corner plate on the front right corner, so the rounded edge faces the front right and is aligned with the front right corner of the base. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 9.2

Horizontally place a black 1x8 plate on the second row of anti-studs from the back, so it is centered horizontally, and the left column sits in front of the right column of the back left 1x6 curved corner plate, and the right column sits in front of the left column of the back right 1x6 curved corner plate. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a black 1x8 plate on the 2nd column of antistuds from the right, so it is centered vertically. The front row should sit to the left of the back row of the front right 1x6 curved corner plate, and the back row should sit to the left of the front row of the back right 1x6 curved corner plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 10

Turn your build right side up. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on your build, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Let's surround it! Horizontally place a green 3x6 half round plate with cutout in front of the ppp, so the cutout faces the back. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 11

Horizontally place a green 3x6 half round plate with cutout on the ppp, so the cutout faces the front. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Group 5:

Step 12

Let's make a part! Let's build the first branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 13

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the leftmost column of your part, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 14

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x4 plate underneath the 2 right overhanging columns of the ppp, so 2 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place the 2 back rows of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front overhang, so 2 rows are exposed to the front. repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 15

Vertically place the 2 front rows of a green 2x4 plate on the 2 back rows of the ppp, so 2 rows overhang to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x4 plate on the 2 right columns of your part, so 2 columns overhang to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 16

Place a red 4x4 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 17

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place the back row of a green 1x6 plate to the left of the ppp, so it sits centered vertically on the left horizontal green 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 18

Vertically place a green 2x6 plate to the right of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate in front of the front horizontal 1x4 plate from the previous step, on the 4th and 5th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 19.1

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally, and it sits on the back vertical green 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 2x4

plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so it is centered vertically. It sits on the left horizontal green 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 19.2

Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the right of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part, so it sits in front of the front horizontal green 2x4 plate you placed in this same step. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 20

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back, so it is centered horizontally. The back row sits on the back horizontal green 2x4 plate from the previous step, and the front row sits on the back horizontal green 2x6 plate. Vertically place a green 2x8 plate with 7 holes in front of the ppp. Then place another green 2x2 plate in front of the ppp on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front.

Step 21

Vertically place a green 1x2 plate on the 5th and 6th rows from the front to the left of the 2 front rows of the green 2x8 plate with 7 holes. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place the leftmost column of a green 2x3 plate behind the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place another horizontally behind the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then vertically place a green 1x2 plate behind the leftmost column of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 22

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right of your part, so it is centered vertically. It sits to the right of the 2 horizontal 2x3 plates from the previous step. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 23

Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on your part so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Place a white 1x1 flower plate on each jumper plate, you should place 4 in total.

Step 24

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp following the shape of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 25

Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, on top of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole.

Step 26

Turn your part upside down. Place a dark grey 2x2 brick with vertical grooves and axle hole, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. There is a recessed area where this part goes.

Step 27

Turn your part right side up so the green 2x8 plate faces vertically. Place a white candle stick upside down, so the bar faces down, on each of the 4 white 1x1 flower plates. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of each candle stick.

Step 28

Bring back your main build, the tree's base, so the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Place your part on the center of the main build, so the bottom dark grey 2x2 brick with vertical grooves and axle hole sits on the center of the main build on the square formed by the 3x6 half round plates with cutout from step 11. Make sure the green 2x8 plate with 7 holes faces vertically.

Group 6:

Step 29

Let's make a part! Let's build the 2nd branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows.

Step 30

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the leftmost column of your part, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 31

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x4 plate underneath the 2 right overhanging columns of the ppp, so 2 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place the 2 back rows of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front overhang, so 2 rows are exposed to the front. repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 32

Vertically place the 2 front rows of a green 2x4 plate on the 2 back rows of the ppp, so 2 rows overhang to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x4 plate on the 2 right columns of your part, so 2 columns overhang to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 33

Place a red 4x4 round plate with 2x2 open center on your part so it is centered horizontally and vertically. It sits on top of the 4 green 2x3 plates from step 30. Place a light grey 1x2 half round brick on the center hole on the right column, so the rounded edge faces the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 34

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 1x6 plate on the 6th column from the left, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 35

Vertically place a green 2x6 plate to the right of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate in front of the front horizontal 1x4 plate from the previous step, on the 4th and 5th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally.

The back row sits on the front row of the front vertical 2x3 plate and the front row on the green 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 36.1

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate behind the ppp so it is centered horizontally, and it sits on the back vertical green 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so it is centered vertically. It sits on the left horizontal green 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 36.2

Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the right of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part, so it sits in front of the front horizontal green 2x4 plate you placed in this same step. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 37

Vertically place a green 2x3 plate on the 5th through 7th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally, and it sits in front of the 2 light grey 2x1 half round bricks. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the back right corner of a green 2x3 plate to the left of the front row of the ppp, so the front right corner sits to the left of the vertical left light grey 1x2 half round brick. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Place another horizontally in front of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 38

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left of your part, so it is centered vertically and sits to the left of the horizontal left green 2x3 plates from the previous step. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate to the right of the 2 front rows of the front vertical green 2x3 plate on the 5th and 6th rows from the front on the 7th column from the right counting the entire build. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back, so it is centered horizontally and sits behind the vertical back green 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 39

Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the front row on the 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 40

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp following the shape of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 41

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 42

Turn your part right side up, so the green 1x1 round plates with open stud face the front and the back. Place a red ball on the leftmost column of your part on the vertical green 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then insert the bar of a red heart with bar into the front green 1x1 round plate with open stud so the flat face of the heart faces forward in the horizontal orientation. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Rotate your part 45 degrees counterclockwise, so the branches we just made are diagonal.

Step 43

Bring back your main build, the tree's base, so the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Place your part on the main build so it is centered horizontally and vertically. The 4 branches of your part should sit between those of the layer below.

Group 7:

Step 44

Let's make a part! Let's build the 3rd layer! Place a red 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, So the studs form columns and rows.

Step 45

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x6 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so 5 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x6 plate underneath the rightmost column of the 4x4 round plate with axle hole, so 5 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 46

Vertically place a green 1x4 plate on the 5th column from the left of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate behind the ppps, so it is centered horizontally on the 4th and 5th rows from the back of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 47

Vertically place a green 1x6 plate on the 4th column from the right, so it is centered vertically. It sits to the right of the vertical 1x4 plate and to the right of the 2 horizontal 2x6 plates. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 48

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate to the left of the vertical 1x6 plate, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of your part, so it is centered horizontally. It sits in front of the front horizontal green 2x6 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 49

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 3rd through 6th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically, and the left column sits to the right of the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Repeat symmetrically to the left. vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 3rd through 6th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the 2 front rows of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Group 8:

Step 50.1

Place a red 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 50.2

Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the rightmost column of your part on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 51

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp following the shape of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 52

Turn your part upside down. Place a tan 2x2 ridged short brick with axle hole on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 53

Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, so the ppp sits inside the open center.

Step 54

Turn your part right side up so the red 1x1 flower plates face the front and the back. Place a gold 1x1 plate with star on the rightmost column of your part on the gold 1x1 flower plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 55

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Take your part and attach it to the center of the main build, on top of the 2nd layer. Position it so that the branches of the 3rd layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. They do not need to align directly with the branches from the 1st layer, as the spacing shifts with each level. The branches of the 3rd layer with a red 1x1 flower plate face the front and the back.

Group 9:

Step 56

Let's make a part! Let's build the 4th layer! Place a red 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows.

Step 57

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x6 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so 5 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x6 plate underneath the rightmost column of the 4x4 round plate with axle hole, so 5 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 58

Vertically place a green 1x4 plate on the 5th column from the left of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate behind the ppps, so it is centered horizontally on the 4th and 5th rows from the back of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 59

Vertically place a green 1x6 plate on the 4th column from the right, so it is centered vertically. It sits to the right of the vertical 1x4 plate and of the 2 horizontal 2x6 plates. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 60

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate to the left of the vertical left 1x6 plate, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front of your part, so it is centered horizontally. It sits in front of the front horizontal green 2x6 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 61

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 3rd through 6th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically, and the left column sits to the right of the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 3rd through 6th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the 2 front rows of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 62

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on the front horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place another on the vertical left 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right. You should have 4 white 1x1 flower plates in total.

Step 63

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp following the shape of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Group 10:

Step 64

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 65

Turn your part right side up so the green 1x4 plates and 1x6 plates face vertically. Place a white candle stick upside down, so the bar faces down, on each of the 4 white 1x1 flower plates. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of each candle stick. Rotate your layer 45 degrees counterclockwise, so the branches are diagonal instead of horizontal and vertical.

Step 66

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Take your part and attach it to the center of the main build, above the 3rd layer. Position it so that the branches of the 4th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. They do not need to align directly with the branches from the 1st layer, as the spacing shifts with each level. As a landmark, the branches of the 4th layer should align with the white hearts from the base. This can be tricky to attach as the last attachment is not very stable.

Step 67.1

Let's make a part! Stack 2 yellow 2x2 round plates with axle hole. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on top of your stack. Insert the top end of a black 16L axle into the bottom axle hole of your part. Push the axle up through your part until it reaches the hole of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole.

Step 67.2

Stack 4 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole. Attach the stack to the bottom end of the 16L axle, push it up until it reaches the previous stack, so the top reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole attaches to the bottom yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole from the first stack.

Step 67.3

Insert the bottom end of the axle of your part into the center hole of your main build. Push it down through as far as you can securing the previous layers.

Group 11:

Step 68

Let's make a part! Let's build the 5th branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center in front of you.

Step 69

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the left column of the green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 70

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x3 plate under the right overhang of the ppp, so 1 column is exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place the 2 front rows of a green 2x3 plate under the back overhang of your part, so 1 row is exposed to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 71

Place a green 2x2 plate on the front row of the ppp, so 1 row overhangs to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 plate on the rightmost column of your part, so 1 column overhangs to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 72

Place a brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part so it is centered horizontally and vertically. It sits on top of the 4 green 2x3 plates from step 69.

Step 73

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place the back row of a green 1x6 plate to the left of the ppp, so it sits centered vertically on the left horizontal green 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 74

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate in front of the front horizontal 1x4 plate from the previous step, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. The back row sits on the front row of the front vertical 2x3 plate and the front row on the green 2x2 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 75

Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part, so it sits to the left of the vertical 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 76

Vertically place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and its front row sits behind the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically, and the left column sits to the right of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a green 2x2 corner plate behind the 2 right columns of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter J. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 77

Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the front row of your part on the horizontal jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 78

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the center hole. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 79

Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the front gold 1x1 flower plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a red ball on the vertical left 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 80

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Take your part and attach it to the center of the

main build, above the 4th layer. Position it so that the branches of the 5th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. Attach your part to the main build by aligning its central hole with the stacked round pieces at the center. Slide your layer gently downward until it meets the top layer, then press it into place.

Group 12:

Step 81

Let's make a part! Let's build the 6th branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center in front of you.

Step 82

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the left column of the green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 83

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x3 plate under the right overhang of the ppp, so 1 column is exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place the 2 front rows of a green 2x3 plate under the back overhang of your part, so 1 row is exposed to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 84

Place a green 2x2 plate on the front row of the ppp, so 1 row overhangs to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 plate on the rightmost column of your part, so 1 column overhangs to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 85

Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 86

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place the back row of a green 1x6 plate to the left of the ppp, so it sits centered vertically on the left horizontal green 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 87

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of the front horizontal 1x4 plate from the previous step, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. The back row sits on the front row of the front vertical 2x3 plate and the front row on the green 2x2 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 88

Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part, so it sits to the left of the vertical 2x4 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 89

Vertically place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the front row sits behind the center hole. Place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd

through 5th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically, and the left column sits to the right of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a green 2x2 corner plate behind the 2 right columns of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter J. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 90

Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the front horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. repeat symmetrically to the back. Place another on the left vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the 3rd column from the right, so it is centered vertically, and it sits on the right column of the horizontal 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place another on the 3rd row from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and it sits on the front row of the vertical 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place 4 green 1x2 curved corner tiles around the center hole of your part following the round shape of the hole.

Step 91

Insert the bar of a red heart with bar into the front green 1x1 round plate with open stud so the flat face of the heart faces the front in a horizontal orientation. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Insert the bar of another into the open stud of the left green 1x1 round plate with open stud, so the flat face of the heart faces right and left in a vertical orientation. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 92

Let's make 4 identical stacks! Stack 2 green 1x1 round plates with open stud. Then place a white 1x1 flower plate on top of your stack. You should now have 4 identical stacks. Place each stack on each free green 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 93

Rotate your part 45 degrees counterclockwise so The branches are diagonal. Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Take your part and attach it to the center of the main build, above the 5th layer. Position it so that the branches of the 6th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below as the spacing shifts with each level. Attach your layer to the main build by aligning its central hole with the stacked round pieces at the center. Slide your layer gently downward until it meets the top layer, then press it into place.

Group 13:

Step 94

Let's make a part! Let's build the 7th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 95

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically, and 3 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 96

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of your part so it sits on the ppp, and it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place another on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it sits on the vertical 2x4 plate, and it is

centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 97

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically, and the left column sits to the right of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the right column of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 98

Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 99

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 100

Turn your part right side up, so a gold 1x1 flower plate faces the front. Place a black 4x4 turntable plate on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, so it covers the center hole. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on each gold 1x1 flower plate. Place a red ball on the leftmost column of your part on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Set the 7th layer aside.

Group 14:

Step 101

Let's make a part! Let's build the 8th layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 102

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically, and 3 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 103

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of your part so it sits on the ppp, and it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place another on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it sits on the vertical 2x4 plate, and it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 104

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the Left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 105

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on each of the 4 jumper plates.

Step 106

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 107

Turn your part right side up, so the corner plates face the left and right sides. Place a reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 108

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the ppp in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 109

Place a white candle stick upside down, so the bar faces down, on each of the 4 white 1x1 flower plates. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of each candle stick.

Step 110

Bring back the previous layer the 7th branch layer and place it in front of you, so the gold 1x1 round plate with star faces the front. Rotate your part 45 degrees counterclockwise. Then attach the bottom green 4x4 round plate with axle hole to the turntable plate, so it spins freely. The branches of the 2 layers should be interspaced. Set them aside.

Group 15:

Let's make a part! Let's build the 9th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 112

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically, and 3 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 113

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of your part so it sits on the ppp, and it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place another on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it sits on the vertical 2x4 plate, and it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 114

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the Left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 115

Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the front row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a red 1x1 flower plate on the rightmost column of your part, so it sits on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 116

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the center hole, so it sits on the back right corner of the front green 2x2 plate. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 117

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 118

Turn your part right side up, so a green 1x1 round plate with open stud faces the front. Insert the bar of a red heart with bar into the front green 1x1 round plate with open stud, so the flat side of the heart faces the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 119

Bring back the 2 attached layers, so a gold star from the bottom layer faces the front. Attach the bottom green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center of your part to the center of the top layer. Position it so that the branches of the 3rd layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. They do not need to align directly with the branches from the 1st layer, as the spacing shifts with each level.

Group 16:

Step 120

Let's make a part! Let's build the 10th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 121

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically, and 3 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 122

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left of your part so it sits on the ppp, and it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place another on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it sits on the vertical 2x4 plate, and it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 123

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the Left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 124

Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the rightmost column of your part on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 125

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the center hole, so it sits on the back right corner of the front green 2x2 plate. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 126

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 127

Turn your part right side up, so the gold 1x1 flower plates face the right and the left. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on each of the gold 1x1 flower plates. Place a red ball on the front row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 128

Bring back the 3 layers, so a gold 1x1 round plate with star from the bottom layer faces the front. Attach the green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on the center of the top layer remember that the branches of each layer should be interspaced, so the decorative elements are visible.

Group 17:

Step 129

Let's make a part! Let's build the 11th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 130

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 2 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x3 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 131

Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. place another horizontally on the front row of your part, so it sits on the vertical 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the 2nd column from the right, so it is centered vertically, and it sits to the left of the vertical right 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 132

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so The right column sits to the left of the center hole, and the left column is centered vertically on the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Place the right column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the left column of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter F. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 133

Place a red 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the leftmost column on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 134

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile on the right column in front of the center hole, so it sits on the back right corner of the front green 2x2 plate. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 135

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 136

Turn your part right side up, so a red 1x1 flower plate faces the front. Place a white ball on each of the green 1x1 round plates.

Step 137

Bring back the 4 staggered layers, so a gold star from the bottom layer faces the front. Attach the bottom green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center to the center of the top layer, so the branches are interspaced with the layers below.

Step 138.1

Let's make a part! Stack a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole. Insert the top end of a red 10L axle into the bottom axle hole of your part. Push the axle up through your part until it reaches the hole of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole.

Step 138.2

Stack 6 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole. Attach the stack to the bottom end of the 10L axle, push it up until it reaches the previous stack, so the top reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole attaches to the bottom yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole from the first stack.

Step 138.3

Insert the bottom end of the axle of your part into the center hole of the 5 staggered layers. Push it down through as far as you can securing the 5 layers.

Group 18:

Step 139

Let's make a part! Let's build the 12th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 140

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 2 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x3 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 141

Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. place another horizontally on the front row of your part, so it sits on the vertical 2x3 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the 2nd column from the right, so it is centered vertically, and it sits to the left of the vertical right 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 142

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the Left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 143

Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the rightmost column of your part on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 144

Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 145

Turn your part upside down. place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 146

Turn your part right side up, so a gold 1x1 flower plate faces the front. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on each of the gold 1x1 flower plates. Insert the bar of a red heart with bar into

the open stud of the left green 1x1 round plate with open stud, so the heart faces in a vertical orientation and the flat side faces the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 147

Bring back the sub build with the 5 staggered layers, so a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the bottom layer faces the front. Attach your part on top of the sub build, make sure when attaching that the branches of your part are staggered and interspaced with the branches of the layers below.

Group 19:

Step 148

Let's make a part! Let's build the 13th branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, So the studs form columns and rows.

Step 149

Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate on the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 150

Place the right column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the 3rd column from the left of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D and 1 column overhangs to the left and 1 row overhangs to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 151

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

152 Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Place another horizontally on the front row of your part, so it sits on the front row of 2 green 2x2 corner plates. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 153

Place 4 green 1x2 curved corner tiles around the ppp following its round shape. Place a red 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 154

Horizontally place a black 1x1x1 2/3 brick with side studs on 3 sides on the front row of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axel hole so the 2x2 side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 155

Place a green 2x2 plate on top of the ppps.

Step 156

Let's make 4 identical parts! Place a green 2x2 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the front row of the ppp. You should now have 4 identical parts! Now, attach each part upright to the 4 sides of the center structure of your part that have side-facing studs: front, back, left, and right. Make sure that the 1x2 plate on each part is facing downward, so it lies horizontally at the bottom when the part is standing upright.

Step 157

Place a green 2x2x2 cone brick with open stud on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, and it sits on top of the green 2x2 plate. Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the ppp.

Step 158

Bring back your sub build with the 6 staggered layers, place it in front of you, so a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the top layer faces the front. Attach your part to the center of the top layer, unlike the previous attachments, the red 1x1 flower plates should face the front and back aligned with the gold 1x1 round plates with star from the previous layer.

Group 20:

Step 159.1

Let's make a part! Place a yellow 4x4 plate with star and open stud in front of you. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the open stud of the ppp. Turn your part upside down. place a gold 1x1 flower plate on your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate with horizontal bar on the ppp so the bar faces the front.

Step 159.2

Bring back your sub build with the 7 layers and place it in front of you, so the red 1x1 flower plates face the front and the back on the top layer. Insert the bar of your part into the open stud of the top green 1x1 round plate with open stud from the sub build with 7 layers, so the star stands upright and is oriented vertically, and the face of the star is on the right and the antistud faces the left.

Step 160

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 6—is facing forward. Take your current build with 7 layers and the star and attach it to the center of the main build, above the 6th layer- the higher layer of the main build. Position it so that the branches of the 7th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. As you connect layers 6 and 7, make sure that at the front, the red ball from layer 7 sits between the white flowers from layer 6. Your big Christmas tree is complete!

With 160 steps of care and creativity, you've brought to life a magnificent Christmas Tree—layered with joy, lit with imagination, and crowned with festive spirit. Though the time has come to gently take it apart, the magic of Christmas is never lost. It simply reshapes itself. Within these same bricks lie two new stories waiting to unfold: a medium tree and a small one, each ready to sparkle with their own charm. Let the air of Christmas guide your hands once more... and let the building continue.

Let's make the alternative build!

Before you begin building the alternative model—the two smaller Christmas trees—you may find it helpful to get a sense of what they look like. This can make it easier to understand the structure as you build and how each part fits into the whole.

These two trees—a medium and a smaller one are built using many of the same pieces as the large Christmas tree, but with simpler silhouettes and fewer layers.

Both trees are built in layers, with each one forming a cross shape—branches extending to the front, back, left, and right. As the layers rise, they gradually taper to create a gentle, narrowing silhouette. Like in the large tree, the placement of each layer is carefully staggered: the branches of the upper layers are interspaced with those below to create a realistic appearance. The medium tree is tall and festive, with 10 layers and a variety of

decorations including colored balls, hearts, and stars. It stands on its own small base and is topped with a golden star. The small tree is more compact, with 6 layers and a charming presence. Unlike the medium tree, it features candles as decorations, giving it a cozy, traditional look. It also stands on its own base and is crowned with a golden star.

Here are a few important placement guidelines:

Rows and Columns: Unless we say otherwise, rows and columns are counted across the whole build.

Choosing Columns: If a part spans more than one row, use the row with more columns to decide where to place it. Horizontally place a dark red 1x3 tile across the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back. If the 2nd row has more columns than the 3rd, we'll use the 2nd row to determine the column reference.

In some builds, especially those with irregular shapes or staggered layers, not all rows have the same number of columns. This means that counting columns across the entire build can be confusing or misleading.

To make things easier, we'll sometimes count columns from a specific row, rather than from the full build. This helps the builder focus on the exact area where the new piece will go. To reflect this change, we'll adjust our phrasing. Instead of saying: "Horizontally place a 1x2 plate on the front row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right." We'll say: "Horizontally place a 1x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right of the front row."

This makes it clear that we're only counting columns within that row—not across the whole build—since other rows may have different lengths or shapes.

In some cases, to help the builder identify where to place the LEGO pieces, we will provide landmarks in addition to row and column references. These landmarks are nearby pieces that serve as tactile guides. Example: Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so the back row sits on the front row of the back left 2x2 corner plate, and the front row sits on the back row of the front left 2x2 corner plate.

Building Instructions (All bags, Book 2):

Medium Christmas tree

Group 1:

Step 1

Place a tan 2x2x2/3 ridged short brick with axle hole in front of you.

Step 2

Orient a dark red 6x6 quarter round plate so the right angle faces the front left, and the rounded edge faces the back right. Place the front left corner of the 6x6 quarter round plate underneath the back right corner of the ppp, so 5 columns are exposed to the right and 5 rows to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the left. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 3

Horizontally place a green 3x6 half round plate with cutout in front of the tan 2x2x2/3 short, ridged brick with axle hole, so the cutout faces the back, and it sits on the front ppps. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 4

Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 tile behind the ppp, so it is centered horizontally on the 3rd row from the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a dark red 1x2 tile on the 3rd column from the left, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Vertically place another on the rightmost column of your build, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place another on the front row, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 5

Place a dark green 1x1 quarter round tile to the right of the ppp, so the rounded edge faces the back right and the right angle faces the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a dark red 1x4 curved corner tile to the left of the ppp, so the rounded edge faces the back left following the shape of the base. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Place a dark green 1x1 quarter round tile in front of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front left, and the rounded edge faces the back right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place another in front of the vertical left dark red 1x2 tile, on the 5th row from the front on the leftmost column, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Place the right column of a dark red 1x4 curved corner tile in front of the ppp, so the rounded edge faces the front right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a dark green 1x1 quarter round tile to the right of the ppp on the front row, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Group 2:

Step 6

Let's make 4 motif bands which represent wrapped gifts. Place a green 1x1 quarter round tile on the 3rd row from the front on the 4th column from the left, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left, and it sits 2 rows behind the right column of the front left 1x4 curved corner tile. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Place a white 1x1 heart tile to the left of the first green 1x1 quarter round tile located on the front left, so the lobes of the heart face the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Place a green 1x1 quarter round tile behind the first white 1x1 heart tile located on the front left, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Place a gold 1x1 heart tile to the right of the left front green 1x1 quarter round tile, so the lobes face the back right. It should sit to the right of a green 1x1 quarter round tile and behind another green 1x1 quarter round tile. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. You should now have 4 motif bands.

Step 7

Vertically place a green 3x6 half round plate with cutout to the right of the light grey 2x2 tile with hole, so the cutout faces the left. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Group 3:

Step 8

Let's make a part! Let's build the 1st layer which will be the lower one! Place a red 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows.

Step 9

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x6 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so 5 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the left column of a green 2x6 plate underneath the rightmost column of the 4x4 round plate with axle hole, so 5 columns are exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 10

Vertically place a green 2x6 plate on the 4th and 5th columns from the left of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate between the ppps, so it is centered horizontally on the 5th row from the back of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 11

Horizontally place a green 1x6 plate in front of the ppp on the 4th row from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 12

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate behind the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it is centered vertically and sits to the right of the vertical right 2x6 plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 13

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 3rd through 6th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically, and the left column sits on the rightmost column of the red 4x4 round plate with axle hole. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 3rd through 6th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits on the front row of the red 4x4 round plate with axle hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the 2 front rows of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter H. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then place a red 1x1 flower plate on the vertical right 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 14

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp following the shape of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 15.1

Place a lime ball on the back row on the horizontal back 1x2 jumper plate.

Group 4:

Step 15.2

Place a yellow ball on the leftmost column on the vertical left 1x2 jumper plate.

Group 5:

Step 15.3

Place a red ball on the red 1x1 flower plate.

Group 6:

Step 15.4

Place a turquoise ball on the front row on the horizontal front 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 16

Bring back your main build since all sides have the same decorative border, it doesn't matter which side is in front of you. Place your part on the center of your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower is on the right.

Step 17

Let's make a part! Let's build the 2nd branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows.

Step 18

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the leftmost column of your part, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 19

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x3 plate underneath the 2 right overhanging columns of the ppp, so 1 column is exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place the 2 back rows of a green 2x3 plate underneath the front overhang, so 1 row is exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 20

Place the front row of a green 2x2 plate on the back row of the ppp, so 1 row overhangs to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Place the left column of a green 2x2 plate on the rightmost column of your part, so 1 column overhangs to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 21

Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. It sits on top of the 4 green 2x3 plates from step 18. Vertically place a light grey 1x2 half round brick on the center hole on the right column, so the rounded edge faces the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 22

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green

1x6 plate on the 4th column from the left, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 23

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of the front horizontal 1x4 plate from the previous step, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 24

Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the leftmost column. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Vertically place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and its back row sits in front of the 2 light grey 2x1 half round bricks. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a green 2x2 corner plate behind the 2 right columns of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter J. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 26

Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the ppp in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp following the shape of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Group 7:

Step 27.1

Insert the bar of a red 1x1 heart with bar into the open stud of the horizontal front 1x2 jumper plate, so the flat side of the heart faces front and back in a horizontal orientation. Place a red ball on the vertical left 1x2 jumper plate.

Group 8:

Step 27.2

Place a blue ball on the vertical right 1x2 jumper plate

Step 27.3

Place a turquoise ball on the horizontal back jumper plate. Rotate your build 45 degrees counterclockwise so the red heart faces the front right.

Step 28

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate faces the right. Place your part on the center of the main build, so the branch with the red heart faces the front right. the branches of your 2nd layer should sit between those of the layer below.

Step 29

Let's make a part! Let's build the 3rd branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on top of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 30

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the leftmost column of your part, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 31

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a green 2x3 plate underneath the 2 right overhanging columns of the ppp, so 1 column is exposed to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place the 2 back rows of a green 2x3 plate underneath the front overhang, so 1 row is exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 32

Place the front row of a green 2x2 plate on the back row of the ppp, so 1 row overhangs to the back. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Place the left column of a green 2x2 plate on the rightmost column of your part, so 1 column overhangs to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 33

Place a red, brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. It sits on top of the 4 green 2x3 plates from step 30.

Step 34

Horizontally place a green 1x6 plate in front of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 1x4 plate on the 4th column from the left, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 35

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate to the right of the ppp, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate in front of the front horizontal 1x6 plate from the previous step, on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 36

Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate behind the ppp on the back row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Vertically place another on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 37

Vertically place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and its back row sits in front of the center light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place a green 2x3 plate on the 3rd through 5th columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place a green 2x2 corner plate behind the 2 right columns of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter J. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 38

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole in this step! Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the right column of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the left of the ppp following the shape of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile behind the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the back right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the front right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole, you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Insert the bar of a red 1x1 heart with bar into the open stud of the horizontal front 1x2 jumper plate, so the flat side of the heart faces front and back in a horizontal orientation. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a pink ball on the vertical left 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 39.2

Place a yellow ball on the vertical right 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 40

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate on the lower layer faces the right. Position it so that the branches of Layer 3 are interspaced with those of the layers below. They do not need to align directly with the branches from Layer 1, as the spacing shifts with each level. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on the rightmost column on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Place an orange ball on the back row on the horizontal back 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 48

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate on the lower layer faces the right. Position it so that the branches of the 4th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below as the spacing shifts with each level. Ensure that the branch with the white 1x1 flower plate faces the back right and the front left heart from the 3rd layer sits between the 2 silver balls from the 4th layer you have just attached.

Place a white ball on the horizontal back 1x2 jumper plate. Insert the bar of a red heart into the open stud of a vertical right 1x2 jumper plate, so the flat face of the heart faces left and right in a vertical orientation.

Step 56

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate on the lower layer faces the right. Position it so that the branches of the 5th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. They do not need to align directly with the branches from Layer 1, as the spacing shifts with each level. Ensure that the branch with the blue ball faces the front left between the 2 branches with 2 silver balls from the layer below.

Let's make a part! Let's build the 6th branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center in front of you.

Step 58

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 3 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x4 plate on the left column of the green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center, so it is centered vertically, and 3 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 59

Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. It sits on top of the 4 green 2x4 plates from the previous step.

Step 64

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate on the lower layer faces the right. Place your part on the center of the top layer. Position it so that the branches of Layer 6 are interspaced with those of the layers below. Ensure that the branch with the white ball faces the front left between the left golden star and the front left blue ball from the layer below, and the heart faces the back left between the gold star and the back white ball from the layer below.

Let's make a part! Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole in front of you. Then stack 2 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole. Place the stack on top of the ppp. Place a light

grey 2x2 round tile with hole on top of your part. Insert the top end of a black 16L axle into the bottom axle hole of your part. Push the axle up through your part until it reaches the hole of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole.

Stack 3 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole. Attach the stack to the bottom end of the 16L axle, push it up until it reaches the previous stack, so the top reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole attaches to the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole from the first stack.

Insert the bar of a red heart with bar into the open stud of the vertical left 1x2 jumper plate, so the flat side of the heart faces left and right in a vertical orientation. Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the back row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 80.3

Place a red ball on the rightmost column on the green 1x1 round plate with open stud.

Step 81

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate on the lower layer faces the right. Attach your layer to the main build by aligning its central hole with the stacked round pieces at the center. Slide your layer gently downward until it meets the top layer, then press it into place. Position it so that the branches of the 8th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below, so the branch with the red heart faces the back left between the left branch with a silver ball and the back branch with a red ball from the layer below.

Step 82

Let's make a part! Let's build the 9th branch layer! Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round open center in front of you.

Step 83

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate on the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 2 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x3 plate on the left column of the green 4x4 round plate

with 2x2 round open center, so it is centered vertically, and 2 columns overhang to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 84

Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. It sits on top of the 4 green 2x3 plates from the previous step.

Step 85

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate in front of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd column from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 86

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the right column of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Group 21:

Step 87.1

Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal front 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 87.2

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on the leftmost column on the vertical 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 88

Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the front row. Repeat symmetrically to the back. They sit on the gold 1x1 flower plates from the previous step. Place a green 4x4 round plate on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 89

Bring back your main build so the red ball on top of a red 1x1 flower plate on the lower layer faces the right. Attach your layer to the main build by aligning its central hole with the stacked round pieces at the center. Slide your layer gently downward until it meets the top layer, then press it into place. The top center round piece of the main build should attach to the bottom of the green 4x4 round plate from your part. Position it so that the branches of the 9th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below, so The front branch with the gold 1x1 round plate with star sits between the front right branch with a pink ball and the front left branch with a red 1x1 flower plate from the layer below.

Step 90

Let's make a part! Let's build the 10th branch layer which will be the top one! Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows.

Step 91

Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate on the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 92

Place the right column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the 3rd column from the left of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D and 1 column overhangs to the left and 1 row overhangs to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 93

Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so the back row sits on the front row of the back left 2x2 corner plate, and the front row sits on the back row of the front left 2x2 corner plate. repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 94

Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right. place another horizontally on the front row of your part, so it sits on the front row of 2 green 2x2 corner plates. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 22:

Step 95

Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Place 4 green 1x2 curved corner tiles around the ppp following its round shape. Place a red 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 96

Horizontally place a black 1x1x1 2/3 brick with side studs on 3 sides on the front row of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole, so the 2x2 side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 97

Place a green 2x2 plate on top of the ppps.

Step 98

Let's make 4 identical parts! Place a green 2x2 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the front row of the ppp. You should now have 4 identical parts! Now, attach each part upright to the 4 sides of the center structure of your part that have side-facing studs: front, back, left, and right. Make sure that the 1x2 plate on each part is facing downward, so it lies horizontally at the bottom when the part is standing upright.

Step 99

Insert the bar of a red heart with bar into the open stud of the left 1x2 jumper plate, so the flat side of the heart faces the left and right in a vertical orientation. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 100

Place a gold 2x2x2 cone brick with open stud on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, and it sits on top of a green 2x2 plate.

Step 101

Bring back your main build with the 9 staggered layers, place it in front of you, so a gold 1x1 round plate with star from the top layer faces the front. Attach your part to the center of the top layer, unlike the previous attachments, the red 1x1 flower plates should face the front and back aligned with the gold 1x1 round plates with star from the previous layer.

Step 102.1

Let's make a part! Place a yellow 4x4 round plate with star and open stud in front of you. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the open stud of the ppp. Turn your part upside down. place a gold 1x1 flower plate on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate with horizontal bar on the ppp so the bar faces the front.

Step 102.2

Bring back your main build, place it in front of you, so the red 1x1 flower plates face the front and the back on the top layer. Insert the bar of your part into the open stud of the top 1x1 cone brick, so the star stands upright in a horizontal orientation, the face of the star should face the front and the antistud the back! You've just built a lovely medium Christmas tree! It stands with joy and sparkle, full of holiday cheer. Its branches are layered like cozy winter blankets, and its shape brings a smile—just like a tree waiting for presents underneath. But the magic isn't over yet... There's still one tiny tree waiting to be built. It's the little companion that will stand beside the medium one, making the scene even more special. Let's bring it to life and complete this magical Christmas pair!

Building Instructions (All bags, Book 2):

Small tree

Group 23:

Step 1

Place a white 8x8 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows

Step 2

Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round center hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole in the center hole.

Group 24:

Step 3.1

Place 4 red 1x4 curved corner tiles around the edge of the base following its round shape.

Step 3.2

Let's make the first decorative border! Place a dark green 1x1 quarter round tile on the 2nd row from the front on the 4th column from the right counting the entire build, so the right angle faces the back left and the rounded edge faces the front right. Place another symmetrically to the left. Repeat both placements symmetrically to the back! You have built the front and back decorative borders, let's call them decorative border A!

Step 3.3

Let's build the decorative border B! Place a green 1x2 quarter round tile on the 4th row from the front on the 2nd column from the left, so the right angle faces the back right and the rounded edge faces the front left. Place another symmetrically to the back. Repeat both placements symmetrically to the right. You have built the decorative border on the left and right sides of the base. You should have 4 decorative borders, 2 decorative borders A and 2 decorative borders B. They represent wrapped presents! Because the base of the tree is perfectly square and the only difference between Decorative Borders A and B is the color of the 1x1 quarter-round tiles, it can be difficult to tell which side is which without sight. To help track orientation later in the build, you may want to mark the front side of the base once Decorative Borders A and B are placed.

One option is to temporarily attach a 1x1 round plate just in front of the front-left white heart (on Border A). Alternatively, one could place a small piece of tape on the quarter-round tiles in the front. Or you can ask for sighted help to confirm the front and remember its position throughout the build.

Step 4

Stack 3 red 4x4 round plates with axle hole. Place these on your build, so they are centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 5

Place a dark grey 2x2 round brick with vertical grooves and axle hole on your build, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, on top of the stacked round plates. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of the ppp.

Step 6

Let's make a part! Let's build the 1st branch layer which will be the lower one! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 7

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the leftmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 8

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 9

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter J. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 10

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on each 1x2 jumper plate, so that there are 4 in total.

Step 11

Turn your part upside down. Horizontally place a green 3x6 half round plate with cutout on the 3rd through 5th rows of antistuds from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the cutout faces the back. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 12

Turn your part right side up. You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the center hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a

black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 13

Place a white candle stick upside down, so the stud faces down, on each of the 4 white 1x1 flower plates. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of each candle stick.

Step 14

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 3.2—is facing forward. Take the lower layer you've built separately and align it above the main build. As you lower it into place, make sure the center hole of the lower layer lines up with the dark grey 2x2 brick and yellow 2x2 round plate from Step 5, which are fixed in the center of the main build. These pieces should slide up into the center hole of the lower layer. Once aligned, attach the two bottom green 3x6 half-round plates with cutout from the layer to the top reddish brown 4x4 round plate of the main build. Press down to secure the connection.

Group 25:

Step 15

Let's make a part! Let's build the 2nd branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 16

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the leftmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 17

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 18

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally, and the back row sits in front of the center hole. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter J. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the front.

Step 19

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the center hole. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have

surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 20

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round center hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 21

Turn your part right side up, so a 2x2 plate faces the front. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the front horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a red ball on the rightmost column. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Rotate your build 45 degrees clockwise.

Step 22

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 3.2—is facing forward. Attach your part to the center of the main build, so the branches of your part sit between those of the layer below. A branch with a red ball should face the front right.

Group 26:

Step 23

Let's make a part! Let's build the 3rd branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 24

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x4 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally, and 3 rows are exposed to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a green 2x4 plate underneath the leftmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 25

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 26

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Place the left column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the right column of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 27

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on each 1x2 jumper plate, so that there are 4 in total.

Step 28

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the center hole, so it sits on the left column of the back row of a 2x2 corner plate. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1

round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 29

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round center hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 30

Turn your part right side up. place a white candle stick upside down, so the bar faces down on each of the 4 white 1x1 flower plates. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of each candle stick.

Step 31

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 3.2—is facing forward. Take your part and attach it to the center of the main build, on top of the 2nd layer. Position it so that the branches of the 3rd layer are interspaced with those of the layers below. They do not need to align directly with the branches from the 1st layer, as the spacing shifts with each level.

Step 32.1

Let's make a part! Stack a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole on a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole. Insert the top end of a red 10L axle into the bottom axle hole of your part. Push the axle up through your part until it reaches the hole of the light grey 2x2 round tile with hole.

Step 32.2

Stack 2 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole. Attach the stack to the bottom end of the 10L axle, push it up until it reaches the previous stack, so the top reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole attaches to the bottom yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole from the first stack.

Step 32.3

Stack 2 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole. Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of your stack. Attach the stack to the bottom end of the 10L axle, push it up until it reaches the previous round stacked pieces.

Step 32.4

Stack a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on a reddish brown 2x2 round brick with axle hole. Attach the stack to the bottom end of the 10L axle, push it up until it reaches the previous round stacked pieces. The bottom piece is a reddish brown 2x2 round brick. You should have 3 yellow 2x2 round plates with axle hole and 5 reddish brown 2x2 round bricks with axle hole and a light grey 2x2 round tile with hole in total.

Step 32.5

Insert the bottom end of the axle of your part into the center hole of your main build. Push it down through as far as you can securing the 3 layers.

Group 27:

Step 33

Let's make a part! Let's build the 4th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 34

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the leftmost column of a green 2x3 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 35

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the front of your part, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd column from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 36

Place a green 2x2 plate in front of the ppp, so it sits on the horizontal back 1x4 plate and on the reddish brown 2x2 plate with 2x2 open center. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Place the front row of a green 2x2 corner plate to the left of the back row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 37

Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the front row on the horizontal front 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a gold 1x1 flower plate on the rightmost column of your part on the vertical right 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 38

You will be placing 1x1 round pieces around the center hole in this step! Place a black 1x1 round tile in front of the right column of the center hole, so it sits on the 3rd row from the front on the 4th column from the right. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the left of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back left of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate behind the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the back right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate to the right of the ppp. Place a black 1x1 round tile to the front right of the ppp. Place a reddish brown 1x1 round plate in front of the ppp. You have surrounded the center hole; you should have placed 4 black 1x1 round tiles and 4 reddish brown 1x1 round plates interspaced.

Step 39

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round center hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 40

Turn your part right side up, so a green 1x1 round plate with open stud faces the front. Place a red ball on the front row. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the rightmost column on the gold 1x1 flower plate. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 41

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 3.2—is facing forward. Attach your layer to the main build by aligning its central hole with the stacked round pieces at the center. Slide your layer gently downward until it meets the top layer, then press it into place. Position it so that the branches of the 4th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below, so the 2 branches with a red ball face the back right and the front left.

Group 28:

Step 42

Let's make a part! Let's build the 5th branch layer! Place a reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center in front of you.

Step 43

Vertically place the back row of a green 2x3 plate underneath the front row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Horizontally place the leftmost column of a green 2x3 plate underneath the rightmost column of the reddish brown 4x4 plate with 2x2 open center, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 44

Horizontally place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the front of your part, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a green 1x4 plate on the 2nd column from the right, so it is centered vertically. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right. Horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the front row of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 45

Place a green 2x2 plate in front of the ppp, so it sits on the horizontal back 1x4 plate and on the reddish brown 2x2 plate with 2x2 open center. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Place the front row of a green 2x2 corner plate to the left of the back row of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 46

Place a white 1x1 flower plate on each 1x2 jumper plate, so that there are 4 in total.

Step 47

Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 48

Turn your part upside down. Place a green 4x4 round plate with 2x2 round center hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 49

Turn your part right side up. Place a white candle stick upside down, so the bar faces down on each of the 4 white 1x1 flower plates. Place a transparent orange candle flame on top of each candle stick.

Step 50

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A—the one you built in Step 3.2—is facing forward. Attach your layer to the main build by aligning its central hole with the stacked round pieces at the center. Slide your layer gently downward until it meets the top layer, then press it into place. Position it so that the branches of the 5th layer are interspaced with those of the layers below.

Group 29:

Step 51

Let's make a part! Let's build the 6th branch layer which will be the top one! Place a green 4x4 round plate with axle hole in front of you, so the studs form columns and rows.

Step 52

Horizontally place a green 2x6 plate on the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and vertically.

Step 53

Place the right column of a green 2x2 corner plate in front of the 3rd column from the left of the ppp, so it looks like a braille letter D and 1 column overhangs to the left and 1 row overhangs to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the right. then repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 54

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 55

Vertically place a green 1x2 jumper plate on the leftmost column of your part. Repeat symmetrically to the right. place another horizontally on the front row, so it sits on the front row of 2 green 2x2 corner plates. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 56

Place a yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Place 4 green 1x2 curved corner tiles around the ppp following its round shape. Place a red 1x1 flower plate on the front row on the horizontal 1x2 jumper plate. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 57

Horizontally place a black 1x1x1 2/3 brick with side studs on 3 sides on the front row of the yellow 2x2 round plate with axle hole, so the 2x2 side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 58

Place a green 2x2 plate on top of the ppps.

Step 59

Let's make 4 identical parts! Place a green 2x2 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a green 1x2 plate on the front row of the ppp. You should now have 4 identical parts! Now, attach each part upright to the 4 sides of the center structure of your part that have side-facing studs: front, back, left, and right. Make sure that the 1x2 plate on each part is facing downward, so it lies horizontally at the bottom when the part is standing upright.

Step 60

Insert the bar of a red heart with bar into the open stud of the left 1x2 jumper plate, so the flat face of the heart faces the left and the right in a vertical orientation. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 61

Place a green 2x2x2 cone brick with open stud on top of your part, so it is centered horizontally and vertically, and it sits on top of a green 2x2 plate. Place a green 1x1 round plate with open stud on the ppp.

Group 30:

Step 62

Insert the bar of a gold 1x1 round plate with horizontal bar into the open stud of the ppp so the 1x1 round plate faces upright to the right. Place a gold 1x1 round plate with star on the ppp, so the star faces the right.

Step 63

Bring back your main build and place it in front of you so that the side with decorative border A — the one you built in Step 3.2—is facing forward. Attach your part to the center of the top layer, unlike the previous attachments, the red 1x1 flower plates should face the front and back aligned with the front and back branches from the previous layer.

Your small Christmas tree's build is complete! You have achieved it! Your alternative build is complete! The small Christmas tree sits beside the medium one, their branches layered like soft winter coats, each one holding a tiny surprise. Together, they create a cheerful corner where presents wait patiently underneath—wrapped in bright colors, ready to be opened with wide eyes and giggles. The room feels ready now, as if Christmas could arrive at any moment.

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
