

40721 Halloween Barn

Halloween-loving kids will have fun building the barn before discovering its spellbinding ramshackle exterior and exploring all the thrilling details inside. They'll delight in finding teeth hidden behind the door, bat and lamp toys, as well as special elements including a decorated eye, a green bottle, a black jar, and an old tree.

The set also includes a skeleton minifigure, who brings the magic to life and encourages imaginations to bubble over as kids role-play fun Halloween stories. Once playtime is over, the barn will enchant friends when displayed as Halloween decor in kids' bedrooms. Enter...if you dare!

Enter...if you dare – Halloween-loving kids will have fun building the barn before admiring its run-down exterior and exploring all the interior details.

Packed with details – Features teeth hidden behind the door, bat and lamp toys, as well as a decorated eye, a green bottle, a black jar, and an old tree.

Skeleton toy – The magic is brought to life by a skeleton minifigure that has an open mouth, conjuring hours of creative role-play.

Dimensions – The 205-piece building toy measures over 5.5 in. (14 cm) high, 6.5 in. (17 cm) wide and 2.5 in. (6 cm) deep.

Bags 1 through 5 include the pieces for the skeleton and the Halloween barn.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.

- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/PPP: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/40721>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 through 5, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 5 - Steps 12-13 and 1 brown 1x2 masonry brick from Step 14.

Group 6 - Rest of Step 14, Step 15, and 1 black 1x1 round plate from Step 16.

Group 7 - Rest of Step 16 and Steps 17-19.

Group 8 - Steps 20-21.

Bag 3 - Halloween Barn

Group 9 - Step 22 and 2 black 1x1 bricks with a side stud from Step 23.

Group 10 - Rest of Step 23 and Steps 24-25.

Group 11 - Step 26.

Group 12 - Steps 27-28 and 1 brown 2x2 plate and 1 brown 1x1 plate from Step 29.

Group 13 - Rest of Step 29, Steps 30-32, and 1 dark green 1x2 masonry brick from Step 33.

Group 14 - Rest of Step 33.

Bag 4 - Halloween Barn

Group 15 - Step 34 and 1 brown 1x2x3 slope brick from Step 35.

Group 16 - Rest of Step 35, Steps 36-43, and 1 brown 2x2 plate from Step 44.

Group 17 - Rest of Step 44 and Step 45.

Bag 5 - Halloween Barn

Group 18 - Steps 46-49.

Group 19 - Steps 50-58.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Skeleton

Sub-build 1. Locate 2 white skeleton legs and 1 white skeleton body. Place the body in front of you so the head pin faces the back. Then attach the legs to the front bars so the feet face the front! Then stand it up so the head pin faces up. Now attach a bent skeleton arm to each of the bars on the left and right so the arms face the front! Now locate a white skeleton head printed with black eyes and scary teeth and put it on top of the head pin so the print faces the front!

Group 2 - Halloween Barn

Step 1

Horizontally place a yellow 8x16 plate in front of you. Then place a black 1x1 round plate on the rightmost column on the 3rd row from the back. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x8 plate to the left so it sits in the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back.

Step 2

Place a light grey 1x1 plate behind the rightmost column of the previous 2x8 plate. Then horizontally place a light grey 2x6 plate to the left of the previous 2x8 plate. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x3 plate on the back row behind the 3 leftmost columns of the 2x6 plate.

Step 3

Horizontally place a brown 1x2 log brick to the left of the previous 1x1 plate. Then horizontally place a sand green 1x2 plate in front of the 2 rightmost columns of the 2x8 plate. Then place a sand green 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner in front so the cutoff corner faces the right.

Step 4

Vertically place a sand green 2x3 plate to the left of the previous 1x2 and 2x2 plates. Then horizontally place a sand green 1x10 plate to the left of the back row of the 2x3 plate.

Step 5

Place a sand green 2x2 plate with a missing corner to the left of the front 2 rows of the previous 2x3 plate so the missing corner faces the front left. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile to the left of the back row of the previous plate. Then place a dark grey 1x1 tile with a rounded side to the left so the rounded side faces the front. Then place a sand green 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner to the left so the cutoff corner faces the front right.

Step 6

Horizontally place a sand green 1x3 plate to the left of the back row of the previous 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner. Then horizontally place a sand green 1x2 plate in front of the 2 right studs of the previous plate.

Group 3 - Halloween Barn

Step 7

Place a black 1x1 round plate in the front left corner of the build. Place a dark grey 2x2 round tile in front of the 1x1 round tile and 1x1 tile with a rounded side. Then place a light grey 1x1 round tile to the left of the front row of the 2x2 round tile. Then place another light grey 1x1 round tile on the front row on the 7th column from the right. Then place a dark grey 1x1 round tile with an upward bar on the 2nd row from the front on the 4th column from the right. Then place another black 1x1 round plate on the 2nd row from the front and 2nd column from the right.

Step 8

Place a black 1x1 round plate on the 4th row from the front and 4th column from the left. Then place another 1 on the 4th row from the front and the 3rd column from the right. Then place another 1 on the 5th row from the front and the 2nd column from the right. Now horizontally place a dark grey 1x3 plate in front of the 1x2 log brick in the back right so the right 2 studs align with it. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with 2 teeth to the left of the slope brick so the curved side of the teeth face the front. Then horizontally place a red tri-sloped tile to the left so it slopes to the back. Then horizontally place another white 1x2 tile with teeth so the teeth face the front.

Step 9.1

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate in front of the 1x2 log brick that is in the back right.

Group 4 - Halloween Barn

Step 9.2

Horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate in front of the previous black 1x2 plate. Then horizontally place 2 dark grey 2x4 tiles, 1 to the left of the other, to the left of the previous brown 1x2 plate. Now horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate to the left of the back row of the 2x4 tile. Then horizontally place another brown 1x2 plate on the back row behind the left 2 studs of the 1x3 plate that is to the left of the teeth.

Step 10

Place a light grey 2x2 tile with a stud on the previous 1x2 plate and left 2 studs of the 1x3 plate so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right so it sits on the 1x2 plate and 1x2 log brick.

Step 11

Place a dark grey vase on the left 2x2 tile with a stud. Then place a transparent green bottle on the right 2x2 tile with a stud.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 5 - Halloween Barn

Step 12

Vertically place a black 1x2x3 slope brick to the right of the right 2x2 tile with a stud so it slopes to the back. Then place a black 1x1x3 brick in front.

Step 13

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate on top of the bricks from the previous step.

You will have an extra brown 1x2 masonry brick. Save it for later.

Group 6 - Halloween Barn

Step 14

Horizontally place a dark green 1x2 masonry brick to the left of the 1x1x3 brick so the brick grooves face the back. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 masonry brick from group 5 on top so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the back. Then horizontally place another dark green 1x2 masonry on top so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the back.

Step 15.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a red 2x4 plate in front of you.

Step 15.2

Vertically place a purple 1x3 tile on the rightmost column so it overhangs 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 15.3

Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 plates with a bar underneath the overhang so they sit next to each other and align with the 2x4 plate.

Step 15.4

Horizontally place a purple 1x2 tile on the front row. Then horizontally place a purple 1x2 jumper plate behind it, then horizontally place another purple 1x2 tile behind it.

Step 15.5

Place a brown 3x3 cross on top so it looks like the letter x.

Step 15.6

Place a black 1x1 round plate on top of a light grey 1x1x3 brick with 2 clips. Then attach the 2 clips to the front-facing bars so the 1x1 round plate faces the right.

Step 15.7

Place your part upright so the 3x3 cross plate faces the front and the 1x1x3 brick is on the right. Then rotate your brick so it sits behind the 2 bars.

Step 15.8

Now horizontally place your part on top of the stud that is to the right of the right 1x2 teeth plate so the cross faces the front. This is a door!

You will have an extra black 1x1 round plate. Save it for later.

Group 7 - Halloween Barn

Step 16.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a red 2x4 plate in front of you.

Step 16.2

Vertically place a purple 1x3 tile on the rightmost column so it overhangs 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 16.3

Horizontally place 2 light grey 1x2 plates with a bar underneath the overhang so they sit next to each other and align with the 2x4 plate.

Step 16.4

Horizontally place a purple 1x2 jumper plate on the back row. Then place a black 1x1 round tile printed with a yellow eye in front on the left stud.

Step 16.5

Place a purple 2x2 corner plate in front so it surrounds the eye. It should look like the braille letter j. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate on top of the 1x2 jumper plate.

Step 16.6

Place a black 1x1 round plate from group 6 on top of a light grey 1x1x3 brick with 2 clips. Then attach the 2 clips to the front-facing bars so the 1x1 round plate faces the left.

Step 16.7

Place your part upright so the eye faces the front and the 1x1x3 brick is on the left. Then rotate your brick so it sits behind the 2 bars.

Step 16.8

Now horizontally place your part on top of the stud that is to the left of the left 1x2 teeth plate so the eye faces the front. This is another door!

Step 17

Horizontally stack 3 dark grey 1x2 masonry bricks together so the brick grooves face the back. Then horizontally place them on the 1x2 plate that is in front of the left vase.

Step 18

Place a black 1x1x3 brick to the left of the previous stack of bricks. Then vertically place a black 1x2x3 slope brick behind it so it slopes to the back.

Step 19

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate on top of the bricks from the previous step.

Group 8 - Halloween Barn

Step 20

Place a black 1x1 plate on top of the right stud of the stack of 3 masonry bricks that are on the left. Then place a black 2x2 corner plate to the left so there is no overhang. It should look like the braille letter h. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 21

Place a black 1x1 plate on the front left corner of the left 2x2 corner plate. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 plate behind it so it connects to the back stud of the corner plate and 1x1 round plate. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 9 - Halloween Barn

Step 22

Rotate your build 180 degrees so the bottle and vase face the front! Now horizontally place a black 1x12 plate behind the previous 1x4 plates so it is centered horizontally between the 1x1 plates.

You will have 2 extra black 1x1 bricks with a side stud. Save them for later!

Group 10 - Halloween Barn

Step 23

Horizontally place a brown 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the 1x12 plate so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Then place a dark green 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left and right so the side studs face the front. Now place a black 1x1 brick with a side stud from group 9 to the left and right so the side studs face the front.

Step 24

Place a dark green 2x2 brick to the left and right of the previous 1x1 bricks with a side stud so there is no overhang.

Step 25.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with 2 teeth upright to the front-facing side studs so the curve of the teeth faces up.

Step 25.2

Horizontally place your part upright onto the left 2 front-facing side studs so the teeth face down.

Group 11 - Halloween Barn

Step 26.1

Horizontally place a dark green 1x2 plate in front of you. Then place 2 white 1x1 plates with a tooth on top next to each other so the teeth face the front.

Step 26.2

Horizontally place your part upright to the right of the previous part so the teeth face down.

Group 12 - Halloween Barn

Step 27.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a brown 1x2 plate on top so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with 2 teeth upright to the front-facing side studs so the curve of the teeth faces up.

Step 27.2

Horizontally place your part upright onto the right 2 front-facing side studs so the teeth face down.

Step 28

Horizontally place a black 1x6 tile upright onto the front-facing side studs.

Step 29.1

Rotate your build 180 degrees. Then place a brown 1x1 plate on the front left corner of the 2x2 brick that is in the back left. Now place a brown 2x2 plate to the right of the previous 1x1 plate so there is no overhang.

Group 13 - Halloween Barn

Step 29.2

Horizontally place a black 1x4 plate to the right of the front row of the previous 2x2 plate. Then place a black 2x2 plate to the right so there is no overhang. Then place a black 1x1 plate to the right so it sits on the front right stud of the 2x2 brick.

Step 30

Horizontally place a brown 1x10 plate on top of the previous 1x4 plate so it is centered horizontally and there is no overhang. Then place a black 1x1 round plate behind the 3rd stud from the left and right of the previous 1x10 plate.

Step 31

Vertically place a black 1x2x3 brick on top of the right 1x1 round plate and 1x10 plate. Then horizontally stack 3 dark green 1x2 masonry bricks together so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the back. Now horizontally place your part to the right of the front stud of the previous 1x2x3 brick so the brick grooves face the back.

Step 32.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x4 window frame in front of you so the thinner inner sides face the front. Then attach 2 dark tan shutters to the front of the window frame.

Step 32.2

Now horizontally place your part on the 1x10 plate to the left of the previous 1x2x3 brick so the shutters open to the front.

You will have an extra dark green 1x2 masonry brick. Save it for later.

Group 14 - Halloween Barn

Step 33

Vertically place a black 1x2x3 brick to the left of the window frame so there is no overhang. Then place a brown 1x1 brick on top of the 1x10 plate to the left of the previous brick. Then place a dark green 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place a dark green 1x2 masonry brick from group 13 on top so there is no overhang and the brick grooves face the back. Now horizontally place a brown 1x2 masonry brick on top so the brick grooves face the back.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Group 15 - Halloween Barn

Step 34

Vertically place a black 1x2x3 brick to the left of the previous 1x2 masonry brick so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 35.1

Horizontally place a brown 1x2x3 slope brick to the right of the front stud of the right 1x2x3 brick so it slopes and overhangs to the right.

Group 16 - Halloween Barn

Step 35.2

Horizontally place a black 1x2x3 slope brick behind the previous slope brick so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Now repeat these 2 slope bricks symmetrically to the left using 2 black 1x2x3 slope bricks!

Step 36

Place a black 2x2x2 slope brick on top of the left 2 1x2x3 slope bricks and 1x2x3 brick so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 37

Horizontally place a black 2x10 plate on top in between the 2 black 2x2x2 slope bricks so there is no overhang.

Step 38

Place a black 2x2 slope brick on top of the left slope brick and leftmost column of the 2x10 plate so it slopes to the left. Now place a black 1x1 brick on the front right corner of the previous 2x10 plate. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 slope brick behind it so it slopes to the right onto the 2x2x2 slope brick.

Step 39

Place a brown 1x1 brick with a side stud to the left of the previous 1x1 brick. Then place another 1 on the front row of the 2x10 plate to the right of the 2x2 slope brick so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 window with a spoked rounded top on the front row of the 2x10 plate so it is centered horizontally and the spokes face the front.

Step 40

Horizontally place a black 1x6 arch brick on top of the previous 1x4 window with a rounded top so it is centered horizontally.

Step 41

Place a black 2x2 slope brick to the left and right of the previous 1x6 arch brick so they slope outwards to the left and right and there is no overhang.

Step 42

Horizontally place 2 black 2x4 slope bricks next to each other on top of the arch brick and 2x2 slope bricks so they slope outwards to the left and right.

Step 43

Place a black 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the 2x4 slope bricks so there is no overhang.

You will have an extra brown 2x2 plate. Save it for later!

Group 17 - Halloween Barn

Step 44.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a black 1x4 plate upright onto the front-facing side studs so it overhangs 2 studs to the right.

Step 44.2

Horizontally attach the side studs of another black 1x2 plate with side studs behind the overhang of the 1x4 plate.

Step 44.3

Horizontally place a black 2x2 plate with angled sides on top so the short side overhangs 1 row to the back.

Step 44.4

Flip your part upside down so the overhang faces the back. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 plate upside down on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 44.5

Place a brown 2x2 plate from group 16 on top of a black 2x2 plate so there is no overhang. Now place your part upside down on top so it is centered horizontally and there is no overhang.

Step 44.6

Flip your part over so the upright 1x4 plate faces the front. Then place a black 2x2 round tile printed with an eye on top of the 2x2 set of studs.

Step 44.7

Rotate your barn 180 degrees. Then flip your part on its side so the eye faces the back and the 1x4 plate faces up. Now attach the 1x4 plate part underneath the 2x10 plate in front of the window frame so the eye faces the back. Now when you open the shutters, you see a scary eye!

Step 45

Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a black bat on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the barn. Then place a green 1x1 round tile with a plant on the front stud of the 2x2x2 slope brick that is on the right side of your barn so it overhangs to the right. Then place a brown 3x3 cross plate upright on the lower front-facing 1x1 side stud that is to the left of the shutters so it looks like the letter x. Now, place a brown 1x3 tile upright on the top left front-facing side stud so it is centered and diagonal and points to the back left and front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Group 5 - Halloween Barn

Step 46

Place a light orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the 2nd row from the front to the left of the 1x1 round tile with an upward bar so the leaves face the front left. Place a small black thorn on the 1x1 round plate that is on the 4th row from the front and the 4th column from the left so it faces the left. Place another 1 on the 1x1 round plate that is on the 2nd row from the front and the 2nd column from the right so it faces the right. Then place 1 more on the 1x1 round plate that is on the 4th row from the front and the 3rd column from the right so it faces the right. Now place 2 larger black thorns on the 1x1 round plates that are to the back right of the previous thorn so they face the right.

Step 47.1

Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 brick with a rounded brick and a side stud in front of you so the side stud faces the front. Then insert a brown bar of a candle stick to the front-facing side stud.

Step 47.2

Place a black 1x1 clip on top so the clip hands are in the front and back.

Step 47.3

Place a black lantern on top of a transparent yellow 1x1 round brick, then connect the handle to the clip so the 1x1 round brick faces the front.

Step 47.4

Attach the thicker bar to the upward bar that is on the 2nd row from the front and the 4th column from the right so the lantern is in the front.

Step 48

Place a brown 1x1 slope tile on the 4th row from the front and the 2nd column from the left so it slopes to the back.

Step 49

Place a yellow 1x1 plate to the left of the leftmost column and the 3rd row from the front so it touches the build. Now horizontally place a brown sloped curved brick on top of the 1x1 plate so it slopes to the left. It should connect to the main build and there should be no overhang. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right so it slopes to the right.

Group 19 - Halloween Barn

Step 50

Place a brown 1x1 round brick behind the 1x1 round plate that is in the front left corner. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 sloped curved brick to the right so it slopes to the front. Now place a light orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves to the right of the stud of the previous 1x2 sloped curved brick so the leaves face the front right.

Step 51

Place a short black thorn on the previous 1x1 round plate that is in the front left corner so it faces the left.

Step 52

Place a brown 2x2 plate behind the previous thorn so there is no overhang.

Step 53

Place a brown 1x1 brick with a scroll on the front left corner of the previous 2x2 plate so the scroll faces the left. Then place a brown 1x1 round brick behind it. Now horizontally place a brown 1x2 inverted slope brick to the right so it slopes and overhangs to the right. Then vertically place another brown 1x2 inverted slope brick on the front right corner of the 2x2 plate so it slopes and overhangs to the front.

Step 54

Place a brown 2x2 round plate on top of the previous bricks so there is no overhang.

Step 55

Vertically place a brown 1x2 jumper plate on the right column of the previous 2x2 round plate. Then place a brown 1x1 round plate in front. Then place another 1 to the left and right of the back row of the 1x2 jumper plate. Then place another 1 on top of the scroll part of the previous 1x1 brick.

Step 56

Place a brown 1x1 round brick on top of the previous 1x2 jumper plate. Then place a longer brown thorn on top of the 1x1 round plates that are to the left and right of the jumper plate so they face outwards to the left and right. Then insert a brown curved branch into the 1x1 round plate that is in front of the jumper plate so it overhangs to the right. Then insert another 1 into the 1x1 round plate that is on top of the scroll so it overhangs to the left. Then insert a brown bar with 3 sticks into the top of the branch.

Step 57.1

Let's make a part! Place a brown 1x1 plate with a side stud in front of you so the side stud faces the front. Then place a brown 1x1 round brick on top. Then place a brown bar with 3 sticks into the round brick.

Step 57.2

Place your part on top of the previous 1x1 round brick so the side stud faces the front.

Step 58

Let's make a part! Place a light orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in front of you so the leaves face the front. Then place a brown 1x1 clip on top so the clip hands are on the left and right. Then repeat again so you have 2 parts in total. Now attach the clip of 1 part to the left branch so the leaves face down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right branch! Then place another light orange 1x1 plate with 3 leaves upright onto the front-facing side stud of your previous part so the leaves face the top right.
