

42636 Heartlake City Preschool

This social-learning toy is packed with details inspired by real preschool settings. Learn about nature and lifecycles in the classroom. Explore different emotions by getting arty in the painting area or have fun on the seesaw and slide. When it's time for a snack, the friends hang out at the picnic table before heading to the rooftop garden to water the veggies.

Pretend-play classroom playset for girls and boys aged 4 and up – The Heartlake City Preschool for kids comes with a buildable preschool, a seesaw, a slide, an art area, a classroom, and a rooftop garden.

Includes 2 mini-dolls and 4 micro-dolls – This pretend-play school comes with LEGO® Friends characters Liann and Colette, who care for Basem, Victoria, Peter, and Alba, plus a bunny.

Kindergarten playset with accessories – Comes with a pirate hat, toys, plates, mugs, snacks, a paint palette, magnifying glass, brush, and a watering can, plus frog, ladybug, and bee elements.

Measurements – 239-piece set with a building measuring over 8 in. (21 cm) high, 7.5 in. (19 cm) wide and 4 in. (10 cm) deep.

The build is 239 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for a minifigure and the art room.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for a minifigure and the pet room and bathroom.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for the rooftop garden and 2 minifigures.

Bag 4 includes the pieces for a minifigure and the slide.

Bag 5 includes the pieces for a minifigure, the seesaw, and the picnic table.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42636>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 through 5, 5 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Kid Minifigure

Steps 6 to 7

Locate 1 small dark tan kid body printed with blue overalls and blue shoes, 1 dark tan head printed with pink eyes, brown eyebrows, and pink lipstick, and 1 dark brown hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her in front of you!

Steps 8 to 9

Horizontally place a red 1x1 rollerskate in front of you so the lip faces the right. Then place a blue 1x1 bird on top so the face faces the right. Then put a brown brush with a green tip next to the minifigure and the bird. Now put everything away while we build the rest!

Group 2 - Art Room

Steps 10 to 11

Horizontally place a tan 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x4 plates on the back row so they sit in the 1x4 gaps. Then vertically place another 1 on the leftmost column so it sits in the gap.

Steps 14 to 15

Vertically place a light purple 2x4 plate on the rightmost column in the 1x4 gap so it overhangs to the right.

Steps 16 to 19

Horizontally place a yellow 2x8x6 window frame in the back left corner of the build so the frame faces the back. Then place a white 1x6 window printed with hooks holding up jackets, umbrellas, hats, backpacks, and scarfs in the window frame so the print faces the front.

Steps 20 to 21

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x3x2 cabinet in front of you. Then attach a cabinet door to the front so it opens to the left. The door should clip onto the left. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total!

Steps 22 to 23

Now horizontally place them next to each other so they sit in front of the white 1x6 window with a print so the doors open to the front.

Steps 24 to 25

Place a tan 1x1 round tile printed with a cookie inside the left cabinet. Then place a light blue 1x1 brick printed with milk inside the right cabinet.

Group 3 - Art Room

Steps 26 to 29

Horizontally place a yellow 2x8x6 window frame in the back right corner of the build so the frame faces the back. Then place a white 1x6 window in the window frame.

Steps 30 to 31

Vertically place 2 light purple 1x4 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, so they are centered horizontally on the build. There should sit in front of the rightmost and leftmost columns of the 2x8x6 window frames.

Steps 32 to 33

Vertically place a yellow 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the previous bricks so there is no overhang.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place a white 1x2 grill tile in front of the right 1x6 window. There should be 2 columns free to the left and right.

Steps 36 to 37

Horizontally place a black 1x2 tile with an overhead bar in front of the previous grill tile so the bar is in the back.

Steps 38 to 39

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the long side in front of you so the clips face the front. Then vertically place a white 2x4 tile printed with a bee, lady bug, and a fox on top of the plate so it overhangs 3 rows to the back.

Steps 40 to 41

Now attach the clips to the previous overhead bar of the 1x2 tile so the tile is upright and faces the front.

Steps 42 to 43

Place a brown palette with yellow, blue, green, and red paint on top of the front stud of the 2x4 tile that is centered horizontally on the build.

Steps 44 to 45

Vertically place a yellow 1x2x2 brick on the leftmost column in front of the leftmost column of the window frame. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 46 to 47

Vertically place a yellow 1x2x2 brick on top of the previous bricks.

Steps 48 to 49

Vertically place another yellow 1x2x2 brick on top of the previous bricks.

Steps 50 to 51

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x4x6 door frame in front of you. Then horizontally attach a teal 1x6 door to the left side of the door so it opens to the left. Then place a red 1x1 flower plate onto the front-facing side stud of the door.

Steps 52 to 53

Vertically place your door on the leftmost column so it sits in front of the stack of bricks and opens to the left.

Steps 54 to 55

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x4x6 door frame in front of you. Then horizontally attach a 1x6 transparent white window to the frame.

Steps 56 to 57

Vertically place your part on the rightmost column in front of the stack of bricks.

Steps 58 to 59

Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x8 bricks next to each other on the back row so there is no overhang.

Group 4 - Art Room

Steps 60 to 61

Vertically place a light purple 1x4 brick on the leftmost column in front of the leftmost column of the 1x8 brick. Then vertically place a yellow 1x3 brick on the leftmost column in front of the previous brick.

Steps 62 to 63

Place a tan 8x8 plate with a rounded side on the right-facing side of the build so it is centered vertically underneath the overhang and the rounded side faces the right.

Steps 64 to 65

Vertically place a white 1x2 grill tile on the front left corner of the 8x8 plate in front of the 1x4 overhang from the previous step.

Steps 66 to 67

Horizontally place 2 tan 1x4 arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the previous 1x2 grill tile.

Steps 68 to 69

Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 plate on top of the previous 2 arch bricks.

Steps 70 to 71

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 brick on the back row of the previous 2x4 plate. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate in front of the previous brick.

Steps 72 to 73

Place a light purple curved staircase on top of the previous 1x4 brick so it attaches to the door frame and bricks to the left. It should sit in front of the rightmost column of the 1x8 brick that is on the back row.

Steps 74 to 75

Place a light purple curved staircase on top of the 1x4 plate that is in front of the previous staircase so the staircase curves to the left.

Steps 76 to 77

Vertically place a yellow 1x3 brick on top of the door frame so it sits in front of the leftmost column of the staircase that is in front of the 1x8 brick.

Steps 78 to 79

Vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the previous 1x3 brick so there is no overhang. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 tile behind it. Repeat symmetrically to the left on the leftmost column.

Steps 80 to 81

Horizontally place a tan 1x6 tile on the back row so it is centered in between the 1x4 tiles. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs to the left and right. Now put this build aside while we build the top floor!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 5 - Kid Minifigure

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 tan body printed with an orange dress printed with a butterfly necklace and orange shoes, 1 tan head printed with brown eyes and pink lipstick, 1 black hair, and 1 light orange bowtie. Assemble your minifigure and put the bowtie in her hand!

Group 6 - Pet Room and Bathroom

Steps 6 to 7

Horizontally place a tan 8x16 plate with 6 1x4 gaps in front of you.

Steps 8 to 9

Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x4 plates on the back row so they sit in the 1x4 gaps. Then vertically place another 1 on the leftmost and rightmost columns so they sit in the 1x4 gaps.

Steps 10 to 11

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 2x8x6 window frame in front of you so the frame faces the back. Then horizontally place a 1x6x6 white window printed with the lifecycle of a frog, how bees pollinate, and the schedule inside the window frame so the print faces the front.

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place your part on the back right corner of the build so the window frame faces the back.

Steps 14 to 15

Place a light purple 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the window frame so it is centered between the frame.

Steps 16 to 17

Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 brick in front of the previous tile so it is centered horizontally to the tile.

Steps 18 to 19

Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row of the previous brick so there is no overhang.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place 2 transparent 1x2 panels on the front row of the 2x4 brick so the walls face the front and there is no overhang.

Steps 22 to 23

Place a light green frog on the left stud of the 1x4 tile and place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the right stud of the 1x4 tile.

Steps 24 to 25

Let's make a part! Place a light grey 1x1 round plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the front. Then horizontally place a light yellow butterfly printed with purple, black, and green wings on top so the larger side faces the back.

Steps 26 to 27

Now insert the bar into the previous 1x1 round flower plate so the butterfly faces the front.

Group 7 - Pet Room and Bathroom

Steps 28 to 29

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 2x8x6 window frame in front of you so the frame faces the back. Then horizontally place a 1x6x6 white window inside the window frame.

Steps 30 to 31

Now horizontally place your part on the back left corner of the build so the window frame faces the back.

Steps 32 to 33

Vertically place a teal 2x4 brick in the center of the 8x16 plate so it sits in front of the rightmost and leftmost columns of the window frames.

Steps 34 to 35

Horizontally place 2 teal 1x2 bricks, 1 in front of the other on the 2 back rows of the previous 2x4 brick. Then place a light purple 2x2 tile with a stud in front of the previous 1x2 bricks.

Steps 36 to 37

Vertically place a light aqua 1x2 jumper plate on the right column of the 2 previous 1x2 bricks.

Steps 38 to 39

Horizontally place the handle of a black magnifying glass on the previous jumper plate.

Steps 40 to 41

Vertically place a white 1x2x3 panel to the left of the jumper plate so the wall faces the left.

Steps 42 to 43

Vertically place a teal 1x2 brick on top of the previous panel.

Steps 44 to 45

Vertically place a teal 2x4 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. It should overhang the magnifying glass. Then horizontally place a teal 1x6 brick on the back row to the left and right of the previous 2x4 brick.

Steps 46 to 47

Horizontally place a light purple 2x6 plate in front of the white window that is on the left side. It should sit in between the 2 walls of the window frame!

Group 8 - Pet Room and Bathroom

Steps 48 to 49

Horizontally place a light aqua 1x2 brick on the back right corner of the previous 2x6 plate.

Steps 50 to 51

Horizontally place a transparent light blue 1x2 panel with 3 walls in front of the previous brick so the long wall faces the front. This is a sink! Then vertically place a 2x3 plate with a rounded side and a hole to the left so the rounded side overhangs to the front.

Steps 52 to 53

Horizontally place a light aqua 1x2 brick on the back row of the previous 2x3 plate with a rounded side. Then place a white 2x2 round tile with a hole in front of the previous brick. This is a toilet!

Steps 54 to 55

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with a pin in front of you so the pin faces the front. Then insert a white 1L pin connector to the front-facing pin.

Steps 56 to 57

Now horizontally place your part to the left of the previous 1x2 brick so the pin faces the front. This is toilet paper!

Steps 58 to 59

Horizontally place a light aqua 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous 1x2 brick with a pin. Then horizontally place another one to the right so it sits behind the transparent light blue 1x2 panel with 3 walls.

Steps 60 to 61

Vertically place a yellow faucet on the right jumper plate you previously placed so the faucet faces the front. Then place a red 1x1 cone brick to the left so it sits on the left stud of the 1x2 brick.

Steps 62 to 63

Insert a blue hair brush into the previous cone brick so the bristles face the front.

Steps 64 to 65

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x4 door frame in front of you. Then attach a transparent 1x4 window to the front of the door frame.

Steps 66 to 67

Now vertically place your part on the leftmost column in front of the 2x8x6 window frame so the window faces the left.

Steps 68 to 69

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x4 door frame in front of you. Then attach a light purple door to the right side of the door frame so it opens to the right. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate upright on the front-facing stud of the door.

Steps 70 to 71

Vertically place your part on the rightmost column in front of the window frame so it opens to the right.

Steps 72 to 73

Vertically place a teal 1x2 inverted curved sloped brick on the front left and front right corners of the build so they sit in front of the door frames and slope to the front.

Steps 74 to 75

Vertically place a teal 1x6 brick on the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 76 to 77

Place a tan 2x2 corner tile on the back left corner. It should look like the braille letter h. Then vertically place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the leftmost column in front of the previous tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 78 to 79

Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row to the left and right of the corner tiles.

Steps 80 to 81

Horizontally place a tan 1x4 tile in between the 2 previous 1x4 tiles with 2 studs. Then vertically place a tan 2x3 tile in front of the previous tile so it is centered horizontally.

Now you can place your build on top of the previous build so it is centered and you have a 2-story building!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 9 - Adult Minifigure

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 pair of legs printed with light blue jeans and black and white shoes, 1 torso printed with a red jacket over a white and dark blue striped shirt, 1 tan head printed with red lipstick, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure and put her in front of you.

Group 10 - Kid Minifigure

Steps 6 to 7

Locate 1 kid body printed with teal pants and shoes, and a blue top, 1 brown head printed with red glasses, and 1 black hair. Assemble your minifigure and put him in front of you.

Steps 8 to 9

Horizontally place a red 1x1 rollerskate in front of you so the top lip faces the front. Then place a dark blue minifigure statue on top so it faces the front. Put it next to your kid minifigure! Now put everything aside while we build the rooftop garden!

Group 11 - Rooftop Garden

Steps 10 to 11

Horizontally place a tan 6x16 plate in front of you.

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place 2 white 1x8 bricks next to each other on the back row.

Steps 14 to 15

Horizontally place 2 light purple 1x8x4 slope bricks on the back row on top of the 1x8 bricks so they slope outwards.

Steps 16 to 17

Horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with 2 side studs on top of the previous slope bricks so the side studs face the front.

Steps 18 to 19

Place a white 4x4 tile printed with a clock upright on the 2 side studs from the previous plate so it is centered horizontally and faces the front. Make sure to attach the side studs to the 2nd row from the bottom of the 4x4 tile.

Steps 20 to 21

Vertically place a white 1x4 panel with a lattice on the leftmost column so it sits in front of the bricks and the wall faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 22 to 23

Vertically place a green 1x2 tile to the right of the back 2 rows of the left 1x4 panel. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place 3 green 2x4 tiles with 2 studs next to each other in between the 2 previous 1x2 tiles.

Steps 26 to 27

Insert the stem of 3 green leaves into the top of a carrot. Now insert the bottom of the carrot to the rightmost stud of the 3 previous 2x4 tiles.

Steps 28 to 29

Horizontally place a light green watering can to the left of the carrot so the handle faces the right. Place a red 1x1 round tile printed with a strawberry on the front row and 3rd column from the right. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate to the left of the watering can so there is a free stud in between them.

Steps 30 to 31

Insert the stem of 3 green leaves into the orange pumpkin. Now place the pumpkin to the left of the previous flower plate.

Steps 32 to 33

Now place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of a red head. Now place this part to the left of the pumpkin.

Step 34

Now you can put your minifigures on the rooftop garden and put the watering can in the teacher's hand so she can water the plants!

Now place your build on top of the 2 story building so it is centered.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 4):

Group 12 - Kid Minifigure

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 kid body printed with blue pants, green top, and a pink apron, 1 tan head printed with brown eyes, 1 black hair, 1 black pirate hat, and 1 black propeller with 2 blades. Assemble your minifigure, then attach the propeller to the pirate hat, then place it next to him. You can switch out his hair with this hat!

Steps 6 to 7

Horizontally place 1 red 1x1 rollerskate in front of you so the upper lip faces the right. Then place a light blue 1x1 rounded brick on top so the curve goes left and right. Then place it next to your minifigure! Put everything away while we build the slide!

Group 13 - Slide

Steps 8 to 9

Place a green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front. Then vertically place a tan 2x3 sloped curved brick on the back row so it is centered, slopes and overhangs 2 rows to the back.

Steps 10 to 11

Vertically place 1 light brown 2x4 rock formation on the back left corner so the inner side faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place 1 light brown 1x6 brick on the back row on top of the rock formations. Then horizontally place another one on the front row of the rock formations. Then vertically place a green 1x2 plate with a vertical bar on the long side on the back left corner of the build so the bar faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Place a light brown 2x2 plate in front of the previous left 1x2 plate with a bar so it overhangs in the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 plate with a horizontal bar on the long side in between the 2 previous plates so it sits on the 1x6 brick and the bar faces the front.

Steps 16 to 17

Place a yellow 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then horizontally place the bottom of a large yellow slide on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally and the top of the slide is on the left.

Steps 18 to 19

Now place the 1x4 plate part of the top of the slide on the back row of the build so it sits in between the 2 plates with vertical bars.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place 2 light purple 2x6 plates, 1 in front of the other, in front of the top of the slide so there is no overhang on the edges.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place a tan 1x6x6 archway brick on the back row so it sits in front of the slide and centered horizontally.

Steps 24 to 25

Vertically place a tan 2x3 sloped curved brick on the back row in between the pillars of the archway so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x2 brick with a side stud in front so the side stud faces the front.

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place a light brown 1x4 tile printed with wood upright on the front-facing side stud of the previous brick so it is slightly slanted towards the right.

Steps 28 to 29

Vertically attach 2 clips of a light purple ladder to the front-facing bar underneath the previous tile you placed. Make sure to push the ladder all the way down so people can climb up!

Steps 30 to 31

Horizontally place the back stud of a large green leaf to the left-facing vertical bar so the leaves face the left. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on the leftmost stud of the leaves.

Steps 32 to 33

Repeat symmetrically to the right but this time, use a transparent 1x1 round tile printed with a bee instead of a flower plate.

Steps 34 to 35

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a large green leave in front of you so the leaves face the left. Then place a short light brown 1x1 brick on the right stud. Then place a transparent 1x1 round tile printed with a bee on the left stud.

Steps 36 to 37

Horizontally place your part on the back left corner so it sits on the leftmost stud of the archway and so the leaves face the left.

Steps 38 to 41

Repeat symmetrically to the right but this time use a red 1x1 round flower plate instead of a 1x1 round tile printed with a bee.

Steps 42 to 43

Horizontally place a light purple 1x6 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally on top of the archway.

Steps 44 to 45

Horizontally place a light brown 1x2 brick with a side stud on top of the previous plate so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the front.

Steps 46 to 47

Horizontally place a light brown 1x4 tile printed with wood upright on the side stud of the previous brick so it slants slightly towards the left.

Steps 48 to 49

Place the anti-stud of a white bar on top of the left stud of the 1x2 brick with a side stud on the back row. Then attach the clips red flag to the top of the bar so the flag faces the left.

Steps 50 to 51

Place a light brown bunny on the left stud on the front row of the build so it faces the front.

Steps 52 to 53

Locate the light blue rounded brick on top of a rollerskate you previously made from group 12. Place it on the leftmost stud of the 2nd row from the front so the upper lip faces the front right.

Step 54

Now place your minifigure at the top of the slide so he can go down!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 5):

Group 14 - Adult Minifigure

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 pair of legs printed with light blue jeans and light purple shoes, 1 torso printed with a yellow and blue short sleep with foods on the shirt, 1 tan head printed with dark brown eyes and light red lipstick, 1 black hair, and 1 red mug. Assemble your minifigure and put the mug in her hand! Now put her away while we build the picnic table!

Group 15 - Picnic Table

Steps 6 to 7

Place a green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front.

Steps 8 to 9

Horizontally place a tan 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light purple 2x2 tile with a stud to the left and right.

Steps 10 to 11

Place a light purple 2x2 tile on the front 2 rows so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a tan 2x4 tile with 2 studs behind it so it is centered horizontally. Then place another light purple 2x2 tile with a stud behind it so it is also centered horizontally.

Steps 12 to 13

Vertically place a light brown 1x2 log brick on the leftmost column in front of the 2x2 tile with a stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front 2x2 tile with a stud so the leaves face the front. Then place 1 on the back left 2x2 tile so the leaves face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 16 to 17

Place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the previous leave plates.

Steps 18 to 19

Horizontally place a tan 2x8 plate on top of the 2 1x2 log bricks.

Steps 20 to 21

Place a red mug on the back left corner of the 2x8 plate so the handle faces the left. Then place a light orange 2x2 round dish in the middle of the studs on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right of the 2x8 plate. This dish is used for eating!

Steps 22 to 23

Place a light brown croissant on top of the plate. Then place a banana to the left. They should not attach to any studs! Now put your build away while we build the seesaw!

Group 16 - Seesaw

Steps 24 to 25

Place a green 8x8 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the right.

Steps 26 to 27

Place a light purple 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered horizontally.

Steps 28 to 29

Vertically place a light brown 1x2 log brick to the left of the previous tile.

Steps 30 to 31

Vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a pin to the left of the previous brick so the pin faces the left.

Steps 32 to 33

Place a light purple 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the 2 previous bricks.

Steps 34 to 35

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tan 2x8 plate in front of you. Vertically place a red 1x2 sloped curved brick on the leftmost column so it slopes to the right. Then place a light purple 2x2 tile with a stud to the right. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Steps 36 to 37

Vertically place 2 white 1x2 panels with a middle wall in the middle of the 2x8 plate so the middle walls face outwards. Now flip your part over so it is still horizontally. Place a light grey 2x2 plate with a hole underneath upside down in the middle of the 2x8 plate so the holes face the front and back.

Steps 38 to 39

Flip your part over and orient it so it is vertical. Now attach the right-facing hole of the part to the left-facing pin of the build.

Steps 40 to 41

Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the rightmost 2x2 tile with a stud so the leaves face the right. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of it.

Step 42

Now place your minifigure on the seesaw so she can ride it!
