

42645 Aliya's Baby Sister's Playroom

Adapted by John Le and tested by Jolene Nemeth.

This pretend-play toy set for kids aged 6 years old and up lets girls and boys create endless babysitting friendship stories. The LEGO® Friends Aliya's Baby Sister's Playroom (42645) creative toy set comes with 2 LEGO Friends mini-dolls, a baby figure and lots of accessories for role play.

Inspire kids to build the playroom, where Aliya and Liann are caring for Aliya's baby sister, Amalia. There's everything kids need to create friendship stories. They can feed the baby at the table – a clever flip function shows just how much mess a baby can make at mealtimes! When it's time for a nap, there's a crib for Amalia. Playtime is catered for too, with a slide, playmat, ball pit, a rocking duck ride and a cute plushie-style LEGO piece. Then the friends take Amalia for a walk in the baby stroller toy.

A kids' pretend-play toy packed with stories – Aliya's Baby Sister's Playroom for girls and boys aged 6 and up comes with 2 mini-dolls, a baby figure, a toy stroller and accessories for creative play.

Social-emotional toy – This set helps kids develop their social skills as they help Aliya and Liann care for Aliya's baby sister, Amalia.

Includes 2 mini-dolls and a baby figure – The set comes with Aliya and Liann mini-dolls, plus a baby sister figure and accessories for creative fun.

Lots of extras for role play – Accessories include a bottle, spoon, ball pit with balls, duck ride-on toy, a stroller and a plushie toy in LEGO® form.

Measurements – 125-piece set with a playroom model measuring over 2 in. (5 cm) high, 5 in. (13 cm) wide and 2.5 in. (7 cm) deep.

The build is 125 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 and 2 include the pieces for Aliya, Liann, a baby, a stroller, a rocking toy, and the playroom!

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back

- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42645>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Aliya

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light blue pair of legs printed with brown and light purple shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a pink shirt with white polka dots, 1 brown head printed with light brown eyes and lips, and 1 dark brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her aside while we make a stroller and baby!

Group 2 - Stroller and Baby

Sub-build 2.1. Place a light blue stroller in front of you so 4 clips face down and a clip faces the left. Now vertically attach 2 green sets of wheels to the bottom-facing clips.

Sub-build 2.2. Attach light grey handlebars to the left-facing clip so the handles face up.

Sub-build 2.3. Place a light brown baby head printed with light brown eyes and a lime green hat on top of a brown baby body printed with a light yellow outfit. Now place your baby inside the stroller so the hands face the right! Now put it away while we make Liann.

Group 3 - Liann

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with light orange shorts and pink shoes, 1 tan torso printed with a white shirt with food splatter on it, 1 tan head printed with dark red eyes, and lips, and 1 black hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her away so we can make a rocking toy!

Group 4 - Rocking Toy

Step 1

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 inverted sloped curved brick in front of you so it slopes to the left. Then place a yellow 1x1 plate underneath the rightmost column.

Step 2

Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns.

Step 3

Place a yellow 1x1 plate with a side stud sticking up on the rightmost column so the side stud faces the right. Then horizontally place a green 1x2 jumper plate to the left. Now place a yellow 1x1 half cylinder brick to the left so it slopes to the left and right.

Step 4

Place a tan 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on the rightmost column so the side studs face the front and back. Then place a white 1x1 round tile printed with an eye upright on the front-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 5 - Rocking Toy

Step 5

Place an orange 1x1 half cylinder brick upright on the right-facing side stud so it slopes up and down. Then place an orange 1x1 round plate on the rightmost column.

Step 6

Place a red hat on top of the ppp so it faces the right. Now put it away while we make the playroom!

Group 6 - Playroom

Step 1

Horizontally place a light purple 8x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a yellow 1x2 brick on the back left corner.

Step 2

Vertically place a yellow 1x6 brick on the leftmost column in front of the ppp. Then horizontally place a yellow 1x6 brick on the back row to the right of the 1x2 brick.

Step 3

Place an orange 2x2 slope brick on the back row to the right of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the back. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x2 plate underneath the overhang.

Step 4

Vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 2nd column from the left. Then place 2 lime green 2x2 round plates, 1 to the right of the other, to the right. Now vertically place a light blue 1x2 tile to the right.

Step 5

Horizontally place a light blue 1x6 tile in front of the 4 ppp. Then vertically place the front row of a blue 2x3 plate to the right.

Step 6

Horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the back row of the ppp.

Step 7

Place a blue 1x1 brick on the back row on the 5th column from the right. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 brick to the left.

Step 8

Place a blue 1x6 curved brick to the right of the 1x1 brick from the previous step so the curve faces the back right.

Step 9

Vertically place a blue 1x2 slope brick on the rightmost column, in front of the 1x6 curved brick so it slopes to the front. Then place a green 2x2 round tile with a stud on the front right corner.

Step 10

Place a green 1x1 round tile on the 2nd column from the left on the 4th row from the front. Then vertically place an orange 1x3 jumper plate to the right. Then vertically place another 1x3 jumper plate to the right.

Step 11

Horizontally place a yellow 1x2x2 brick on the back left corner. Then vertically place a light blue 1x4 plate on the leftmost column in front of the ppp. Now place a light blue 1x1 plate with a clip in front so the clip faces the left.

Step 12

Vertically place a yellow 1x2 plate with a stud and a hole on the front left corner so the hole is in front and faces the left and right. Now place a light grey 1L pin with a stud into the right-facing side of the hole so the stud faces the right.

Step 13

Vertically place a yellow 1x2 plate on the leftmost column, in front of the 1x2x2 brick. Then vertically place a yellow 1x4 tile with 2 studs in front.

Group 7 - Playroom

Step 14.1

Let's make a part! Place a yellow 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 plate with a clip on top so the clip faces the front.

Step 14.2

Horizontally place a yellow 1x1 sloped curved brick with a 1x1 plate part on top so it slopes and overhangs to the left.

Step 14.3

Horizontally place your part on the back left corner so the clip faces the front.

Step 15.1

Horizontally place a white 1x4x3 panel with a sticker on the back row to the right of the ppp so the wall faces the back.

Step 15.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the white 1x4x3 panel. This sticker has a stack of books, baby diapers, a pacifier, and toys! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 16

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 tile with 2 studs on the back row to the right of the ppp. Then horizontally place a transparent blue 1x2x3 panel to the right so the wall faces the back.

Step 17

Place a yellow 1x1 brick on top of each of the studs of the 1x4 tile with 2 studs from the previous step. Then place an orange 1x1 round plate on top of each of the 1x1 bricks.

Step 18.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 arch brick in front of you. Then horizontally place 2 yellow 1x2 plates with 2 side studs sticking up, 1 to the right of the other, on top so the side studs face the front.

Step 18.2

Horizontally place your part on top of each of the 1x1 round plates from step 17 so the side studs face the front.

Group 8 - Playroom

Step 19

Horizontally place a yellow 1x8 plate on the back left corner. Then horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate to the right.

Step 20

Horizontally place a yellow 1x1 half cylinder brick on the back row on the 7th column from the left so it slopes to the left and right. It should sit behind the leftmost front-facing side stud! Then horizontally place a red 1x2 jumper plate to the right. Now place a yellow 1x1 half cylinder brick to the right so it slopes to the left and right.

Step 21.1

Horizontally place a light pink 1x2 rounded tile with a sticker, upright on the front-facing side studs so it is centered horizontally on them.

Step 21.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the light pink 1x2 rounded tile. This sticker has a smile on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 9 - Playroom

Step 22

Place a red 1x1 half cylinder brick on the back row on top of the 1x2 jumper plate so it slopes to the left and right. Now place a white 1x1 round tile printed with a black eye upright on the left front-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 23

Place a blue 1x1x3 brick on the rightmost column on top of the 1x2 slope brick. Then place a transparent light blue 1x6x3 curved panel behind it so the curve faces the back right and there is no overhang.

Step 24

Place a blue 1x8 curved plate on top of the 2 ppp so there is no overhang and the curve faces the back right.

Step 25

Place an orange 1x3 sloped curved corner brick on the back right corner, in front of and to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the back right. Now place another 1 to the left so it slopes to the back left and the front row is aligned with the front row of the 2x3 plate to that is to the left.

Step 26

Repeat the previous step symmetrically to the front so together they make a circle! This is a kiddie pool!

Step 27

Place a round orange cat figure printed with eyes, a nose, and whiskers, on the front right corner on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud so it faces the front left. Then place a lime green hat on top so it faces the front left.

Step 28.1

Place a white 4x4 tile with a sticker on the 4 front rows on the 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th columns from the left.

Step 28.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the white 4x4 tile. This sticker has a 3x3 puzzle on it made up with light blue, yellow, purple, and green pieces! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 29

Vertically place a green 2x3 sloped curved brick behind the 2 rightmost columns of the ppp so it slopes to the front. This is a slide!

Group 10 - Playroom

Step 30

Let's make a part! Let's make a baby crib! Vertically place an orange 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs sticking up in front of you so the side studs face the left. Then horizontally place a white 2x4 plate on top so it overhangs 3 columns to the right.

Step 31

Vertically place an orange 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs sticking up underneath the rightmost column so the side studs face the right.

Step 32

Place an orange 2x2 plate underneath your part so it is centered horizontally.

Step 33

Horizontally place a light pink 1x4 tile on the back row.

Step 34

Horizontally place a white 1x4x1 fence panel on the front row so the wall faces the front.

Step 35

Vertically place 2 white 1x2 grill tiles, 1 to the right of the other, upright on the right-facing side studs. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 36

Horizontally place your part on the back left corner on top of the 2 2x2 round plates so it is centered horizontally on them and the fence panel faces the front.

Step 37

Attach the bar of a white 1x1 round plate with a bar to the front-facing clip on the back left corner so the stud is on the right and faces up. Now place a green plant on top of the stud. Then flip it upside down so the plant faces down.

Step 38.1

Let's make a part! Let's make a baby high-chair! Horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs sticking up in front of you so the side studs face the back. Then place an orange 2x2 tile upright on the back-facing side studs.

Step 38.2

Place a light pink 2x2 tile with a stud on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front. Then horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate underneath the overhang.

Step 38.3

Vertically place your part on top of the 2 1x3 jumper plates that are on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so the upright 2x2 tile faces the back.

Step 39

Place a light blue baby bottle on the leftmost column of the 4th row from the back so the handle faces the right. Then attach a silver spoon to the left-facing clip on the leftmost column.

Step 40.1

Let's make a table! Horizontally place a white flag with 2 clips and 2 stickers in front of you so the clips face the right. Then vertically attach a t-shaped bar to the right-facing clips so the middle bar faces the right.

Step 40.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the white flag with 2 clips. This sticker has a light blue plate with uneaten toast, bananas, and grapes. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 40.3

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the white flag with 2 clips. This sticker has a light blue plate with eaten toast, bananas, and grapes. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 40.4

Horizontally attach the bar of your part to the right-facing stud that is on the front left corner so the flag is horizontal and flat. This is a table with food on it!

Step 41

Place 4 light yellow 1x1 round tiles, 4 light pink 1x1 round tiles, 4 light blue 1x1 round tiles, and 4 green 1x1 round tiles inside the kiddie pool that is on the back right corner. This is a ball pit!

Step 42

Place a yellow 1x1 duck with an orange beak inside the ball pit!
