The set is packed with friendship moments as art-lover Liann joins musician Paisley for a day of creativity. The set comes with 2 LEGO Friends minidolls, a pet bunny figure and a special plushie-style LEGO piece.

Kids can act out the story as Paisley and Liann learn to paint figurines while watching a tutorial on the tablet. There's also lots of opportunity for musical role play with Paisley's guitar, microphones, speakers and more, making this set a great gift for music-lovers.

A bedroom playset for kids – Create friendship and fun with this LEGO® Friends Paisley's Room pretend-play building kit for girls, boys and any fans of arts and crafts aged 6 and up.

2 LEGO® Friends characters – This set comes with Paisley and Liann minidolls, a pet bunny figure and a special plushie-style LEGO piece, plus lots of creative accessories for role-play fun.

The build is 199 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Paisley, Melody the bunny, Liann, the art table, and the bedroom.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for the bedroom.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.

- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42647>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 2 bags labeled 1 and 2, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 3 - Steps 1-3 and 1 green 1x1 round plate from Step 4.

Group 6 - Steps 18-28 and 1 nougat 1x1 brick from Step 29.

Group 7 - Rest of Step 29 and Steps 30-32.

Group 8 - Steps 33-40.

Bag 2 - Bedroom

Group 9 - Steps 41-56 and 3 transparent pink 1x1 round plates from Step 57.

Group 10 - Rest of Step 57 and Steps 58-63.

Group 11 - Steps 64-74.

Group 12 - Steps 75-84.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Paisley and Melody the Bunny

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 white pair of legs printed with pink and blue dots and pink shoes, 1 white torso printed with pink and blue dots, 1 tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, 1 dark red hair, 1 brown paint brush with a blue tip, and 1 sand blue bunny. Assemble your minifigure then attach the paint brush to her hand and place the bunny next to her! Now put them away while we make another minifigure!

Group 2 - Liann

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with pink shorts, white socks, and blue slippers, 1 white and pink torso printed with clouds, 1 tan head printed with dark red eyes and light red lips, 1 black hair, 1 brown paint brush with a green tip, and 1 nougat palette printed with red, green, yellow, and blue paint. Assemble your minifigure then attach the palette and brush to her hands! Now put her away while we make the book and art table!

Group 3 - Book and Art Table

Step 1.1

Vertically place a green 1x2 bottom book cover with a bar and 2 studs in front of you so the bar faces the right. Then vertically attach a top book cover with a sticker to the left side so the sticker faces up.

Step 1.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the top 1x2 book cover. This sticker has Paisley's name on it, flowers, and a lock. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 1.3

Vertically place a white 1x2 tile printed with a sticker on top of the 2 studs, then close the book! Now put this book away for now while we make the art table!

Step 1.4

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the white 1x2 tile. This sticker has a notebook with words on it and a heart. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 2

Place a tan 4x4 round plate in front of you.

Step 3

Place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 4.1

Place a green 1x1 round plate on the left stud of the front row.

Group 4 - Art Table

Step 4.2

Place a blue 1x1 round plate on the right stud of the front row.

Step 5

Place 2 light grey 1x1 plates with a clip, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row so they are centered horizontally and the clips face the back.

Step 6

Horizontally place a teal 1x2 jumper plate with a round side on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front. Then place a white 1x1 tile with a clip on top so the clip hands face front and back.

Step 7.1

Horizontally attach a black 1x2 top book cover with a sticker to the back top-facing clip so the sticker faces the front.

Step 7.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the top 1x2 book cover. This sticker is a screen of someone painting a cat figure. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 8

Place a white 1x1 cat figure with 2 ears on the left 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place 2 white 1x1 round tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row.

Step 9

Let's make a part! Place a magenta 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 round table on top so it is centered. Now place your build on top so it is centered.

Step 10

Locate the brown paint brush with a blue tip and attach it to the left back-facing clip! Now put everything away while we build the bedroom!

Group 5 - Bedroom

Step 11

Horizontally place a mint blue 8x16 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a nougat 1x4 brick on the front right corner.

Step 12

Let's make 2 identical parts! Stack 2 red brown 1x1 round plates, then place a tan 1x1 round tile on top. Now you should have 2 parts! Place 1 on the front row on the 2nd column from the right. Then place the other on the front row on the 5th column from the right. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2x1 panel in between them so the wall faces the front.

Step 13

Horizontally place a nougat 1x6 brick on the back right corner.

Step 14

Vertically place a tan 1x4x1 panel on the 2nd column from the right, behind the 1x1 round tile so the wall faces the right. Then vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a stud and a hole behind it so the hole is in the back. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 tile to the left of the back row of the previous 1x4 panel.

Step 15

Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with a stud and a hole on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back on the 5th column from the right so the hole is in the back. Then vertically place a tan 1x4x1 panel in front so the wall faces the left.

Step 16.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a hole on the short side on the right column so the hole and 1 row overhang to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 16.2

Horizontally place a black 1x2 inverted sloped curved tile underneath the left column of overhang so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 16.3

Horizontally place your part on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th rows from the back, in between the 1x2 plates with a stud and a hole. It should not connect to any studs!

Step 17

Insert a lime green 2L pin with a 1L axle hole into the right-facing hole so the axle hole faces the right. Now insert a red 2L axle into the right-facing axle hole. Then attach a black gear to it.

Group 6 - Bedroom

Step 18

Place a light grey 1x1 brick with an axle hole on the 2nd row from the back on the 6th column from the right so the axle hole faces the left. Then place a green 1x1 round plate on top.

Step 19

Insert a yellow 3L axle into the left-facing axle hole and push it all the way in.

Step 20

Vertically place a nougat 1x2 brick on the rightmost column on the 5th and 6th rows from the front.

Step 21

Let's make a part! Let's make the bed! Vertically place a white 4x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 2x4 tile with 2 studs on the back 2 rows.

Step 22

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile in front of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs so it is centered horizontally. Then vertically place a white 2x3 plate in front so it is centered horizontally.

Step 23

Place a bright pink 1x1 tile on the left stud of the 2x4 tile with 2 studs. Then rotate it 45 degrees so it is diagonal. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 24

Horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved tile on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

Step 25

Horizontally place 2 light purple 1x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2nd row from the front so they are centered horizontally and slope outwards to the left and right. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 26

Now vertically place your bed on the front 6 rows on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right so the 1x4 sloped curved tiles are in the front.

Step 27

Twist the right-facing gear to lift up the bed, then place your book you made in group 3 under the bed, then close it back up!

Step 28

Place a black 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on the front right corner. Then place a nougat 1x1 brick behind it. Now vertically place a nougat 1x6 brick behind that.

Step 29.1

Place a nougat 1x1 brick on the back row on the 7th column from the right.

Group 7 - Bedroom

Step 29.2

Place a tan 1x1 plate on the 3rd row from the back on the 6th column from the right. Then place a bright pink 1x1 brick on top.

Step 30

Horizontally place a tan 1x4x2 panel on the back row on the 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th, columns from the left, to the left of the 1x1 brick so the wall faces the back. Now horizontally place a teal 1x2 tile in front of the left 2 columns of the ppp. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 jumper plate with a round side in front of the ppp so the round side faces the front.

Step 31

Horizontally place a tan 1x4x2 panel on the back row to the left of the previous 1x4x2 panel so the wall faces the back. Then place a tan 2x2 triangle tile in front of the left 2 columns of the ppp so the right angle faces the back left.

Step 32.1

Vertically place a light yellow 2x4 rounded tile with a sticker on the front 4 rows to the left of the bed.

Step 32.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 2 on the light yellow 2x4 rounded tile. This sticker has a checkered purple and red flower rug. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 8 - Bedroom

Step 33

Vertically place a nougat 1x4 brick on the back left corner. Then place a nougat 1x1 brick on the back left corner. Now vertically place a nougat 1x2 brick in front of the ppp. Then place a tan 1x1 brick with a bar in front so the bar faces the left.

Step 34.1

Place a white 4x4 plate with a cutoff corner on the back left corner so the cutoff corner faces the front right. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x3 plate on the back row to the right. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 plate to the right.

Step 34.2

Place a light purple pair of headphones on the left-facing bar.

Step 35

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the front.

Step 36

Place the back row of a light purple 1x4 curved tile on the back row of the 2nd column from the left so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 37

Place a magenta 4x4 round plate on the back 2 rows so it is centered horizontally and overhangs 2 rows to the back.

Step 38

Horizontally place the overhang of your part on the front left corner so the leftmost column of the 4x8 plate with a round side aligns with the leftmost column of the build.

Step 39

Place 2 light purple 1x4 curved tiles, 1 to the right of the other, behind the 4x4 round plate so together with the other 1x4 curved tiles, they form a circle around it!

Step 40.1

Let's make a part! Vertically place a black 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then place a black 1x1 round brick on the back row.

Step 40.2

Place a light grey 1x1 round plate on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 40.3

Place a black 1x1 round plate with a bar on the back row so the bar faces the front. Now vertically place your part on the leftmost column on the 5th and 6th rows from the back so the bar faces the front.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 9 - Bedroom

Step 41

Vertically place a light yellow 1x4 brick on the back right corner. Then place a light yellow 1x1 brick in front. Now vertically place a light yellow 1x2 plate in front.

Step 42

Place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the back right corner. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x4 brick in front.

Step 43

Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 plate on the back right corner. Then vertically place a light yellow 1x2x2 slope brick on the rightmost column on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it slopes to the front.

Step 44

Place a bright pink 3x3 heart shaped plate on the rightmost column behind the ppp so the right angle faces the front right. Now place a light purple 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the front left corner of the ppp.

Step 45.1

Horizontally place a light yellow 1x6x5 panel with a sticker on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the wall faces the front.

Step 45.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 1 on the 1x6x5 panel. This sticker has a bunch of pictures on a wall, and has a stack of books, a plant, and a music award. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 46

Let's make a part! Let's make a window! Horizontally place a light grey 1x6 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a red brown 1x4x3 rounded window on top so it is centered horizontally and the window faces the back.

Step 47

Place a red brown 1x1 plate on the leftmost column. Then place a light yellow 1x1 brick on top. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 48

Horizontally place a light yellow 1x6x2 arch brick on top so it is centered horizontally.

Step 49

Horizontally place your part on the back row to the left of the 1x6x5 panel.

Step 50

Place a light yellow 1x1 brick on the back row on the 3rd column from the left.

Step 51

Place a teal 1x1 brick with a side stud on the back row on the 3rd column from the left so the side stud faces the front. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2x2 slope brick to the left so it slopes to the left.

Step 52

Vertically place a yellow 1x4 brick on the back right corner. Then vertically place another 1 on top.

Step 53

Vertically place a light yellow 1x2x2 slope brick on the rightmost column in front of the ppp so it slopes to the front. Then horizontally place another 1 on the back row on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it slopes to the left.

Step 54

Place a light grey 1x1 plate with a clip on the back row on the 2nd column from the right so the clip faces the front. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate to the left. Now place 2 light grey 1x1 plates with a clip, 1 to the right of the other, to the left so the clips face the front. Now horizontally place a light yellow 1x4 plate to the left. Then place another light grey 1x1 plate with a clip to the left so the clip faces the front.

Step 55

Horizontally place a teal 1x4 tile on the back right corner. Then vertically place another 1 on the rightmost column in front of the ppp. Now horizontally place a teal 1x6 tile on the back row to the left of the 1x4 tile. Then horizontally place a teal 1x4 tile to the left.

Step 56

Horizontally attach a white 5L bar with a stop to the left 2 front-facing clips so the stop is on the left. Then horizontally attach another 1 to the right 2 front-facing clips so the stop is on the left.

You will have 3 extra transparent pink 1x1 round plates. Save them for later!

Group 10 - Bedroom

Step 57.1

Let's make 3 identical parts! Let's make some lights! Place a transparent light blue 1x1 round plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 tile with a clip on top so the clip hands face the front and back. Now you should have 3 identical parts! Attach 1 to the leftmost and rightmost sides of the left 5L bar with a stop so the anti-stud faces down. Then attach the other 1 to the middle of the right 5L bar with a stop so the anti-stud faces down.

Step 57.2

Let's make 3 identical parts! Let's make some lights! Place a transparent pink 1x1 round plate from group 9 in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 tile with a clip on top so the clip hands face the front and back. Attach 1 to the leftmost and rightmost sides of the right 5L bar with a stop so the anti-stud faces down. Then attach the other 1 to the middle of the left 5L bar with a stop so the anti-stud faces down.

Step 58

Place a silver 1x1 wine glass on the 2nd column from the right, behind the 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place a transparent purple 1x1 cone brick on top. This is a lava lamp!

Step 59.1

Let's make a chair! Stack 2 white 2x2 round plates so there is no overhang then place them in front of you.

Step 59.2

Place a bright pink 2x2 round tile with a sticker on top.

Step 59.3

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 3 on the bright pink 2x2 round tile. This has pink and yellow rings. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 59.4

Place your part on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left and 3rd and 4th rows from the back, so it sits to the right of the front 2 rows of the 4x4 plate with a cutoff corner that is in the back left corner.

Step 60

Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a light purple 1x1 round brick on the back right corner.

Step 61

Place a tan 1x1 brick with a clip on the back left corner so the clip faces the left. Now place 2 tan 1x1 bricks with a side stud and bottom lip, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so the side studs face the front.

Step 62

Horizontally place a bright pink 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs.

Step 63

Let's make another part! Let's make a record player! Horizontally place a magenta 2x3 plate in front of you.

Group 11 - Bedroom

Step 64

Place 2 silver 1x1 round plates, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 65

Horizontally place a white 1x3 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x3 tile in front.

Step 66.1

Place a black 2x2 round tile with a sticker on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Step 66.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the black 2x2 round tile. This sticker has a purple circle on it. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 67

Place a light grey 1x1 round part with an antenna on the back right corner so the antenna faces the front left and touches the 2x2 round tile.

Step 68

Horizontally place your part on top of your previous part so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 69

Place a light grey 1x1 faucet on the left-facing clip so the bar faces the left and the anti-stud faces up. Now place a transparent blue 1x1 round brick on top of the anti-stud.

Step 70

Horizontally place your part on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back, to the left of the bed so the overhang sits on top of a 1x1 round plate and a 1x1 brick.

Step 71.1

Place a magenta 2x2 tile with a sticker upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud so it is centered on it.

Step 71.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the magenta 2x2 tile. This sticker is a girl with pink hair singing with a mic! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 72

Place a light purple 1x1 round brick on the leftmost column on the 3rd row from the back. Then place a pink flower on top.

Step 73

Place a transparent 1x1 mug in front of the ppp so the handle faces the left. Then place another 1 to the right of the previous pink flower so the handle faces the right.

Step 74.1

Let's make a part! Place a brown candle stick in front of you so the bar faces up. Now place a brown candle stick with a branch on top so the branch faces the right.

Step 74.2

Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the branch so the leaves face the front. Now place a brown candle stick with a branch on top so the branch faces the front.

Step 74.3

Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top of the front branch so the leaves face the front. Now place another 1 upside down on the bar so the leaves face the back right.

Step 74.4

Place your part on the front right corner on top of the 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar.

Group 12 - Bedroom

Step 75.1

Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 brick with a hole in front of you. Then place a black 1x1 tile on top.

Step 75.2

Attach a silver 1x1 round plate upright to the front-facing hole.

Step 75.3

Place a black 1x1 telescope bar underneath your part! This is a camera! Now place it on the 5th row from the front of the 8th column from the left. It should sit behind the 4x8 plate with a rounded side.

Step 76

Let's make a part! Let's make a piano! Horizontally place a black 1x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on top so it is centered horizontally and the bar faces the back.

Step 77

Place a black 1x1 plate with a clip on the leftmost column so the clip faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 78

Horizontally place 2 white 1x2 tiles printed with piano keys, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

Step 79

Place a black 1x1 telescope bar underneath the leftmost and rightmost columns.

Step 80

Attach a light grey microphone to each of the back-facing clips so the round part faces up.

Step 81.1

Horizontally attach the clips of a light grey 1x2 plate with 2 clips to the back-facing bar so it is centered horizontally and the studs face the front. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a sticker upright on it so 1 row overhangs to the top.

Step 81.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your sticker! Ask a helper to place sticker 4 on the white 2x2 tile. This sticker is piano sheet music! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 82

Horizontally place your part on the 2nd row from the back of the 4x4 round plate that is on the front left corner so the upright tile faces the front.

Step 83

Vertically place a white guitar in front of the front-facing bar of the 1x1 round plate with a bar that is on the leftmost column.

Step 84

Place a light blue round penguin figure with small arms on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right.
