

42672 Creative Beach and Travel Suitcase

Adapted by John Le and tested by Hannah Kinsey.

This 2-in-1 buildable toy takes kids on a journey of creativity as they build and rebuild different beach scenes. The LEGO® Friends Creative Beach and Travel Suitcase toy set (42672) for kids makes a great gift for girls and boys aged 5 years old and up. Kids build the 3 models, then rebuild them to create an alternative scene, or use the pieces to create their own imaginative creations.

This pretend-play set has everything kids need to build a seaplane toy with spinning propeller, a relaxation area with a surfboard, and a beach café hangout with sandcastles, seating and ice cream accessories. The models rebuild into a speedboat toy, an outside seating area and a pizza shop with a pizza oven. The building toy comes with 2 minidolls and dog and dolphin figures for role play.

After building and rebuilding the models, all the pieces can be packed away in the suitcase, ready for the next adventure. The building kit comes with a sticker sheet so kids can have fun customizing the suitcase.

Buildable toy – This Creative Beach and Travel Suitcase playset for girls and boys aged 5 and up has 3 models that kids can rebuild to create a new scene, plus 2 minidolls, a dog and a dolphin.

Build, then rebuild – The set includes a beach scene with a seaplane, relaxation area and beach café hangout, which rebuilds into a new scene with a speed boat toy, an outdoor seating area and a pizza shop.

Customizable organizer case – This LEGO® set comes with a sticker sheet so kids can have fun customizing the suitcase, which stores the pieces ready for the next creative vacation adventure.

Includes 2 mini dolls and dog and dolphin figures – This set comes with characters and lots of beach-themed accessories, including a surfboard, radio, pizza, sunscreen and ice cream.

Measurements – 188-piece set with a plane measuring over 1.5 in. (3 cm) high, 4. in. (11 cm) long and 4.5 in. (11 cm) wide.

The front of the box shows the beach in the back. It has a sand castle, palm trees, and a bar! In the front, there are some chairs by the water! And there is a seaplane that is about to land so the friends can vacation!

The build is 188 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Bags 1 and 2 include the pieces for Aliya, and either a seaplane or a jetski.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for Olly, and either a relaxation area or a seating area.

Bags 4 & 5 include the pieces for Aira, and either a bar or a cafe.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/42672>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bags 1 & 2 - Aliya and Seaplane

Group 1 - Page 8-9.

Group 2 - Steps 1-5 and 1 lime green 2x2 plate with extended angled sides from Step 6.

Group 3 - Rest of Step 6, Steps 7-17, and 1 transparent red 1x1 round tile from Step 18.

Group 4 - Rest of Step 18 and Steps 19-23.

Bag 3 - Olly and Relaxation Area

Group 5 - Pages 3-5.

Group 6 - Steps 1-16.

Bags 4 & 5 - Aira and Bar

Group 7 - Page 3.

Group 8 - Steps 1-9.

Group 9 - Steps 10-18 and 1 orange 1x2x2 brick from Step 19.

Group 10 - Rest of Step 19 and Steps 20-25.

Group 11 - Steps 26-29

Group 12 - Steps 30-37.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bags 1 & 2, Book 1):

Group 1 - Aliya

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 light blue pair of legs printed with light brown and pink shoes, 1 brown torso printed with a pink shirt with white dots, 1 orange life vest, 1 brown head printed with red eyes and dark red lips, 1 dark brown hair, and 1 purple 1x2 tile printed with a passport. Assemble your minifigure, make sure the life vest faces the front, then attach the passport to her hand! Now put her away while we make a seaplane!

Group 2 - Seaplane

Step 1

Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate in front of you.

Step 2

Horizontally place a light blue 4x6 angled plate with inverted sloped sides on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the short side overhangs 4 columns to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Starting from the right, skip the 2 rightmost columns then horizontally place a white 2x6 plate so it is centered vertically.

Step 4

Place a white 2x2 brick on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically.

Step 5

Vertically place a light orange 1x2 panel with a long wall and middle wall on the 5th column from the left so it is centered vertically and the middle wall faces the right. Then vertically place another 1 on the 5th column from the right so it is centered vertically and the middle wall faces the right. Now place a light orange 2x2 tile with a stud to the right of each of the 2 ppp so they are centered vertically.

Step 6.1

Horizontally place a lime green 2x2 plate with 1x4 extended angled sides on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the studs are on the right.

Group 3 - Seaplane

Step 6.2

Vertically place a light grey 2x2 plate with 1x3 extended angled sides on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the studs are on the left.

Step 7

Place a light purple 1x1 plate on the front row in front of the right 1x2 panel with a long wall and middle wall. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 8

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with a pin on the long side on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the pin faces the left. Now horizontally place 2 yellow 1x2 bricks with 2 side studs, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp so they are centered vertically and the studs face outwards to the front and back.

Step 9

Attach a black rotor with 3 blades to the left-facing pin.

Step 10.1

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a light purple 1x1 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x3 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes and overhangs 2 columns to the left.

Step 10.2

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 part upright on the 2 front-facing side studs so it slopes and overhangs 1 column to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 11

Place a white 2x2 tile with a round side on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the left.

Step 12.1

Let's make a part! Let's make the tail of the plane! Horizontally place a white 2x6 plate with a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces the front. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a plane tail behind it so it is centered horizontally and the tail faces the back.

Step 12.2

Vertically place your part on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the tail faces the right.

Step 13

Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make the wings! Horizontally place a white 2x4 inverted sloped curved brick in front of you.

Step 14

Horizontally place a yellow 1x4 plate on the back row. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 15.1

Vertically place a white 4x6 plate with 2 cutoff corners on top so it is centered vertically and the cutoff corners face the left.

Step 15.2

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Vertically place the back row of 1 part on the front row to the left of the 1x1 plate so the cutoff corners face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 16

Vertically place a lime green 1x10 plate on the leftmost column of the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically.

Step 17

Horizontally place a purple 1x2 plate on the 6th row from the front, to the right of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 18.1

Place a transparent red 1x1 round tile on the rightmost column of the front row.

Group 4 - Seaplane

Step 18.2

Place a transparent green 1x1 round tile on the rightmost column of the back row. Then place a lime green 1x2 curved tile on the front 2 rows in front of the 1x10 plate so the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 19

Place a white 2x2 corner plate on top of the 1x10 plate so it looks like the braille letter h and there are 3 free studs of the 1x10 plate in front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Together they should be centered vertically!

Step 20

Vertically place white 1x4 plate on top of the left column of the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically.

Step 21

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 tile printed with buttons and speedometers on top of the ppp so it is centered vertically.

Step 22

Vertically place a transparent 2x4 curved windshield to the left of the ppp so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left.

Step 23

Horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved brick to the right of the front row of the ppp so it slopes to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now put your build away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 5 - Olly

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 tan pair of legs printed with white and green shoes, and dark blue shorts, 1 white torso printed with a pink sweater wrapped around his shoulder, 1 orange life vest, 1 tan head printed with glasses and light blue eyes, 1 blonde hair, 1 light purple surfboard, and 1 light blue dolphin. Assemble your minifigure and make sure the life vest is on his chest, and then attach the surfboard to his hand! Now place the dolphin by his side! Now put everything away while we make the relaxation area!

Group 6 - Relaxation Area

Step 1

Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you. Then place a light green 1x1 round flower plate on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 2

Place a purple 2x2 round brick on the back 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on the back 2 rows in between the 2 ppp.

Step 3

Place a purple 2x2 round brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, in front of the 2x2 round brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Horizontally place a white 1x2 panel on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, in front of the 2x2 round brick so the wall faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick in between them.

Step 5

Horizontally place a white 1x2 panel on the back row, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so the wall faces the back. Then vertically place an orange 2x3 tile in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. These are beach chairs!

Step 6

Horizontally place a light purple 1x2 brick on the 3rd row from the front so it is centered horizontally.

Step 7

Place a yellow 2x2 plate on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front so it is centered horizontally.

Step 8

Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the 2 rightmost columns of the 3rd row from the front so the side studs face the front. Then place a yellow round part with a black antenna on top of the left column of it so the antenna faces the top right. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile upright on the front-facing side studs. This is a radio!

Step 9

Place a white 1x1 brick printed with a sun on the leftmost column on the 3rd row from the front so the print faces the front. Then place a light blue 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.

Steps 10 to 11

Horizontally place a blue 2x4 plate on the front left corner so it overhangs 1 row to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 12

Horizontally place a light blue 4x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so it is centered horizontally to the build and the round side faces the front.

Step 13

Horizontally place 2 white 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 5th row from the front, so they are centered horizontally.

Step 14

Horizontally place a white 1x2 tile with a round side on the 2nd and 3rd columns, in front of the ppp so the round side faces the front. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right, on the 3rd row from the front so the round side faces the front. Now place a light orange 1x1 star on the leftmost column of the 2nd row from the front.

Step 15

Place a transparent 1x1 wine glass on top of the back left corner of the 2x2 plate that is centered on the build. Then place another 1 on the front right corner of the 2x2 plate.

Step 16

Place a light grey 5L bar with a stop on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud that is centered horizontally on the back row so the stop faces up. Then place a transparent pink umbrella on top. Now put everything away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bags 4 & 5, Book 1):

Group 7 - Aira and Crab

Sub-build 3. Place 1 red brown dog printed with light blue eyes and tan paws in front of you so it faces the front. Then attach a transparent purple pair of sunglasses to the top of his head! This is Aira!

Sub-build 4. Place a red crab in front of you so the clips face the front. Now place a white 1x1 swirl on top of a tan 1x1 ice cream cone, then attach it to the crab's hand! Now put everything away while we make the bar!

Group 8 - Bar

Step 1

Place a tan 8x8 plate with a round side in front of you so the round side faces the left.

Step 2

Place 2 light blue 1x6 curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they are centered vertically and there is no overhang. The curves should align with the curve of the plate! Then place a light orange 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows to the right.

Step 3

Place a red brown 1x1 round brick on top of the ppp. Then place a light green 1x1 round flower plate on the 2nd row from the back and 2nd column from the right.

Step 4

Horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick on the 3rd row from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left.

Step 5

Horizontally place a black 1x2 panel on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally on them and the wall faces the front.

Step 6

Place a tan 1x1 brick to the left and right of the ppp.

Step 7

Horizontally place 2 tan 1x4 arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, in front of the 2 ppp, on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right.

Step 8

Vertically place 2 tan 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so they are centered horizontally on them and slope outwards to the left and right.

Step 9

Place a tan 1x1 round brick on top of the right 1x1 brick that is on the 3rd row from the back. Then place another 1 in front so there is a 1 row gap in between. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left. This is a sand castle!

Group 9 - Bar

Step 10.1

Let's make a part! Let's make a palm tree! Stack 4 red brown 1x1 round bricks on top of each other, then place them in front of you.

Step 10.2

Place a lime green 1x1 brick with a side stud on each side on top. Then place a lime green 1x1 round plate with leaves upright on the front-facing side stud so the leaves face down. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now place a lime green 1x1 round plate with leaves upright on the left-facing side stud so the leaves face down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 10.3

Place your tree on top of the 1x1 round brick that is on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud on the back row. Then orient the tree so the leaves face the front left, front right, back left, and back right!

Step 11

Place a red 1x1 bucket on the 2nd row from the front on the 3rd column from the right. Then vertically attach a gold bucket handle to the top of the bucket.

Step 12

Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on the back right corner so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 13

Place a tan 8x8 plate underneath the overhang so the front row is aligned with the front row of the build.

Step 14

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile on the 4th row from the front, on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left.

Step 15

Place a light green 1x1 round flower plate on the front right corner. Then horizontally place 2 light purple 1x4 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, to the left. Now horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front, on the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th columns from the right. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left.

Step 16

Place a nougat 2x2 round barrel on the back row on top of the 2x2 round tile with a stud.

Step 17

Vertically place an orange 1x2x2 brick on the back 2 rows to the right of the ppp.

Step 18

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4x5 door frame on the back row to the right of the ppp so the thinner sides face the front.

Step 19.1

Vertically place an orange 1x2x2 brick on the back 2 rows to the right of the ppp.

Group 10 - Bar

Step 19.2

Horizontally place 2 tan 1x2x2 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the 1x4x5 door frame.

Step 20

Horizontally place a purple 1x4 brick in front of the 2 ppp so 2 columns are free to the right. Now horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile in front.

Step 21

Horizontally place 2 purple 1x2 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 1x4 brick from the previous step.

Step 22

Place a light purple 1x1 plate on the back row to the left and right of the 1x4x5 door frame.

Step 23

Place a yellow 3x3 quarter plate on the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th columns from the right, in front of the 1x4x5 door frame so the curve faces the front right. Then place another 1 to the left so the curve faces the front left.

Step 24

Horizontally place a black 1x2 panel on the 2nd row from the back on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so the wall faces the back. Then place 2 nougat 1x1 bricks with a clip, 1 to the right of the other, to the left of the ppp so the clips face the front.

Step 25

Horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile on top of the 2 ppp. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 3rd row from the back, in front of the 1x2 panel.

Group 11 - Bar

Step 26

Vertically place an orange 1x2x2 brick on the back 2 rows to the left and right of the 1x4x5 door frame.

Step 27

Place an orange 1x1 brick on the back row to the left and right of the 1x4x5 door frame.

Step 28

Place a white 1x1 brick with a side stud in front of each of the 2 ppp so the side studs face the front.

Step 29

Vertically place a nougat 1x2 plate with claws on the back 2 rows to the right of the door frame so the claws overhang to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Group 12 - Bar

Step 30

Place 2 light green 1x1 round flower plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row on top of the 1x4x5 door frame so they are centered horizontally on it. Now place a nougat 1x2 plate with claws on the back 2 rows to the left and right of the 2 ppp so the claws face outwards to the left and right.

Step 31

Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile on the back row on top of the 4 ppp so it is centered horizontally on them.

Step 32

Place a lime green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud so the leaves face up. Then place a light yellow 1x1 round flower plate upright on it. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 33

Attach a tan 1x1 ice cream cone to the right front-facing clip so the stud faces up. Then place a white 1x1 swirl on top.

Step 34

Horizontally place a tan 1x1 hot dog bun in front of the left clip. Then horizontally insert a red hot dog into it.

Step 35.1

Let's make 2 identical parts! Let's make the chairs! Place a dark tan 2x2 half cone brick in front of you. Then place a yellow 2x2 round tile on top.

Step 35.2

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Place 1 part on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Then place another 1 to the left so there is a 2 column gap in between.

Step 36

Insert a brown kayak oar and a silver shovel into the 2x2 round barrel that is on the back row.

Step 37

Place a tan 2x2 round tile printed with a pizza on top of the 1x2 panel and 1x2 grill tile that are to the right of the ice cream. Then place another 1 on top! They should not attach to any studs!

Congratulations on finishing your build, let's make some alternate builds now!

Bags 1 & 2 - Jetski (Starts from Page 40)

Group 1 - Steps 1-9 and 1 transparent red 1x1 round tile from Step 10.

Group 2 - Rest of Step 10 and Steps 11-16.

Bags 4 & 5 - Beach Cafe (Starts from Page 50)

Group 4 - Steps 1-13.

Group 8 - Steps 34-36.

Building Instructions (Bags 1 & 2, Book 1):

Group 1 - Jetski

Step 1

Horizontally place a light blue 4x6 angled plate with inverted sloped sides in front of you so the short side faces the left.

Step 2

Horizontally place 2 yellow 1x4 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the 4 rightmost columns so they are centered vertically.

Step 3

Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate on the 4 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Step 4

Place a lime green 2x2 plate with extended angled 1x4 sides on the 2 leftmost columns so the studs are on the left.

Step 5

Horizontally place 2 purple 1x2 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so they are centered vertically.

Step 6

Vertically place a white 4x6 plate with 2 cutoff corners on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the cutoff corners face the left.

Step 7

Horizontally place 2 white 2x4 inverted sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, underneath the 2 rightmost columns so they are centered vertically and 2 columns are exposed to the right.

Step 8

Vertically place a white 2x6 plate on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Step 9

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 brick with a pin on the long side on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the pin faces the right. Then attach a black rotor with 3 blades to the right-facing pin.

Step 10.1

Place a transparent red 1x1 round tile on the rightmost column in front of the 1x2 brick with a pin.

Group 2 - Jetski

Step 10.2

Place a transparent green 1x1 round tile on the rightmost column behind the 1x2 brick with a pin. Then vertically place a black 1x2 grill tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically.

Step 11

Place 2 light orange 2x2 tiles with a stud, 1 in front of the other, on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right so they are centered vertically. Now vertically place 2 light orange 1x2 panels with a long wall and a middle wall, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 2 ppp so they are centered vertically and the middle walls face the right.

Step 12

Place a white 2x2 tile with a round side on the 3rd and 4th columns from the left so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right. Then place a white 2x2 brick to the right so it is centered vertically.

Step 13.1

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a light purple 1x1 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x3 sloped curved brick on top so it slopes and overhangs 2 columns to the left.

Step 13.2

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 part in front of the 2x2 brick so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 14

Horizontally place 2 white 1x4 sloped curved bricks, 1 in front of the other, on the 4 leftmost columns so they are centered vertically and slope to the left.

Step 15

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 tile printed with buttons and speedometers, to the left of the 1x2 panels with a long wall and middle wall so it is centered vertically.

Step 16

Vertically place a transparent 2x4 curved windshield to the left so it is centered vertically and slopes to the left. Now put your jetski away while we make the next part!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 3 - Seating Area

Step 1

Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you.

Step 2

Vertically place an orange 2x3 tile on the back right corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 3

Place a purple 2x2 round brick on the 2 leftmost columns in front of the 2x3 tile. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place another 1 in between them so it is centered horizontally. Now place a yellow 2x2 plate on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the front so it is centered horizontally.

Step 4

Vertically place a white 1x2 panel on the leftmost column on top of the 2x2 round brick so it is centered vertically and the wall faces the left. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile with a round side to the right so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 5

Horizontally place a yellow 1x2 with 2 side studs on the 2 rightmost columns of the 2nd row from the front so the side studs face the front. Then place a yellow round part with a black antenna on top of the left column of it so the antenna faces the top right. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile upright on the front-facing side studs. This is a radio!

Step 6

Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 7

Place 2 light green 1x1 round flower plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row, on top of the ppp.

Step 8

Place a purple 2x2 round brick on top of the 2x2 round brick that is centered on the build.

Step 9

Place a white 1x1 brick printed with a sun on the 2nd row from the front on the 2nd column from the left so the print faces the front. Then place a light blue 1x1 round tile with a top-facing bar on top.

Step 10

Vertically place 2 white 1x4 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2x2 round brick that is centered so they are centered vertically.

Steps 11 to 12

Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate on the back 2 rows of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 13

Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the 2 ppp so it is centered vertically and horizontally.

Step 14

Place a transparent 1x1 wine glass to the left of the back row of the previous 2x2 round tile with a stud. Then place another 1 to the right of the front row of the 2x2 round tile with a stud.

Step 15

Place a light grey 5L bar with a stop on top of the previous 2x2 round tile with a stud so the stop faces up. Then place a transparent pink umbrella on top.

Building Instructions (Bags 4 & 5, Book 1):

Group 4 - Beach Cafe

Step 1

Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 panel on the back left corner so the wall faces the back and it overhangs 1 column to the left.

Step 2

Place a tan 8x8 plate with a round side underneath the overhang so the round side faces the left and the front row is aligned with the main build.

Step 3

Horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile on the 2nd row from the back so it sits in front of the 1x2 panel.

Step 4

Vertically place a tan 1x2x2 brick to the left and right of the ppp.

Step 5

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile in front of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate in front. Now horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile in front.

Step 6

Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate on the back 2 rows on top of the 1x2x2 bricks.

Step 7

Horizontally place a black 1x2 panel on the back row on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the wall faces the back. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 grill tile in front.

Step 8

Place a tan 1x1 brick on the back row to the left and right of the 1x2 panel. Then place a nougat 1x1 brick with a clip in front of each of them so the clips face the front.

Step 9

Horizontally place a tan 1x4 arch brick on the back row on top of the 1x1 bricks. Then horizontally place another 1 in front.

Step 10

Vertically place 2 tan 1x2 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the 2 ppp so they are centered horizontally.

Step 11

Vertically place a tan 1x2 sloped curved brick to the left and right of the 2 ppp so they slope outwards to the left and right. This is a pizza oven!

Step 12

Place 2 red brown 1x1 bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row on top of the 1x2 bricks.

Step 13

Place a dark tan 2x2 half cone brick on the back 2 rows on the 5th and 6th columns from the right. Then place another 1 on the 2 rightmost columns on the 3rd and 4th rows from the front. Now place a yellow 2x2 round tile on top of each of them so they are centered on them.

Group 5 - Beach Cafe

Step 14

Place a nougat 2x2 barrel on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right on the 3rd and 4th rows from the back. Then place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

Step 15

Horizontally place a tan hot dog bun on top of the ppp. Then horizontally place a red hot dog inside the bun.

Step 16

Vertically attach a brown kayak oar to the left front-facing clip so the oar faces up.

Step 17

Place a light orange 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2nd and 3rd rows from the back of the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left.

Step 18

Horizontally place a magenta 1x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns on the 2nd row from the front. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile to the left. Now horizontally place a magenta 1x4 brick to the left. Then horizontally place another magenta 1x2 brick to the left.

Step 19

Place a red brown 1x1 round brick on the 2nd row from the front, to the left of the ppp. Now place a red brown 1x1 round brick on the back stud of the leftmost column. Then place another 1 on the 2nd stud from the front of the 2nd column from the left.

Step 20

Place a light green 1x1 round flower plate on the front stud of the leftmost column. Then place another 1 on the front stud of the 2nd column from the left.

Step 21

Place a light blue 1x6 curved tile on top of the 3 1x1 round bricks on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile on the 2nd row from the front, to the right.

Step 22.1

Let's make a part! Let's make a plant! Place a light green 1x1 round plate with leaves in front of you so the leaves face the left. Then place another 1 on top so the leaves face the back. Now place another 1 on top so the leaves face the right. Then place 1 more on top so the leaves face the front.

Step 22.2

Place your part on the back left corner on top of the 2x2 tile with a stud.

Step 23

Horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick on the 2 rightmost columns of the 2nd row from the front. Then horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front to the left and right of the 1x4 tiles.

Step 24

Horizontally place an orange 1x2x2 brick on top of each of the 2 ppp.

Group 6 - Beach Cafe

Step 25

Place a white 1x1 swirl on the rightmost column on top of the ppp. Then place an orange 1x1 brick to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the 1x2x2 brick that is to the left.

Step 26

Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 brick with claws on the front right corner so the claws overhang to the front.

Step 27

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4x5 door frame to the left of the ppp.

Step 28

Horizontally place 3 nougat 1x2 bricks with claws, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row to the left of the door frame so the claws overhang to the front.

Step 29

Place a light green 1x1 round flower on the front row to the left and right of the door frame. Then place a light green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the front row on top of the right stud of the leftmost 1x2 plate with claws so the leaves face the front left. Then place another 1 to the right so the leaves face the front right.

Group 7 - Beach Cafe

Step 30

Place a light yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of the previous 1x1 round plates with 3 leaves.

Step 31

Place a yellow 3x3 quarter circle plate on top of the door frame and left 1x1 brick so it overhangs 1 row to the front and the curve faces the front left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 32

Horizontally place a light purple 1x4 tile on the back row of the 2 ppp so it is centered horizontally on them.

Step 33

Place 2 white 1x1 bricks with a side stud, 1 to the right of the other, in front of the ppp so they are centered horizontally to the ppp and the side studs face the front. Then place a tan 1x1 round brick to the left and right of the 2 ppp.

Group 8 - Beach Cafe

Step 34

Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 tile on top of the 4 ppp.

Step 35

Place a tan 2x2 round tile printed with a pizza upright on the 2 front-facing side studs above the door frame.

Step 36

Place a tan 2x2 round tile printed with a pizza on top of the upper 1x2 panel and 1x2 grill tile, inside the pizza oven!

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
