This set is a 2 in one set, this means you get one set of pieces that can build two different official models. The set includes instructions for both builds, and each model uses all 958 pieces. To build the alternate model, you first take apart the main model and then rebuild it using the same bricks. This set is for ages 12+ and contains 9 labelled paper bags.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: [bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers](https://bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers). Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back.
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified).
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece.
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the

shortest available. They may be combined with pins or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

**Pins** - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop; however, it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

**Technic brick** - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

**Lift-arms** - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, elts, and triangles.

**Gears** - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder!

Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

**Axle and Pin Connectors** - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

**Bushes/Bushings** - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make it easier to pull on and off.

#### Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a sighted friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted into groups according to the building steps in the set. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, Numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be collected

into a small Number from steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collecting all the parts used in steps 1, 2 and 3, and putting them in one container.

This set comes with 9 labelled paper bags, and 2 instruction sets one for each building option as it is a 2 in 1 set. There are no sticker sheets.

Sort the pieces into groups as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split across two groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder!

LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

## Description:

Here is a description of the final set, so you blind builder can imagine what the set looks like before or during the building process. The Lionel Messi figure stands on a horizontal rectangular base covered with smooth green tiles that represent the grass of a football pitch. ## General placement guidelines

### Start Building

#### Step 1

Rows and Columns Across the Whole Build:

Unless we say otherwise, rows are counted from front to back or back to front, and columns are counted from left to right or from right to left across the entire build.

Example: Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> rows from the front on the 3<sup>rd</sup> column from the left. or place a white 2x2 tile with stud on the 2 back rows on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> columns from the right.

This uses the full build's row and column Layout.

#### Step 2

Why we Sometimes Count Columns from a Specific Row:

Each row can have a different number of columns. This happens when the build becomes narrower or wider toward the sides, or when certain rows have cutouts, curves, or irregular shapes.

So, if a row is shorter or wider than the rows above or below it, counting columns across the whole build becomes misleading. To avoid confusion, we count columns within that specific row.

Example: Instead of: Place the 1x2 plate on the front row on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> columns from the right. We say: Place the 1x2 plate on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> columns from the right of the front row.

This makes it clear that the row itself is the reference, not the whole build.

#### Step 3

Why We Sometimes Count Rows from a Specific Column:

Each column can have a different number of rows. This happens when one column extends further back than the next, another extends forward, some columns are tall, others short, or the shape is staggered or irregular. When columns vary in height or depth, counting rows across the entire build becomes confusing. To avoid this, we count rows within that specific column.

Example: Place a tan 1x1 round plate on the 3<sup>rd</sup> row from the back of the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the right.

This avoids the problem of columns with different lengths.

#### Step 4

Using Landmarks for Tactile Orientation:

When rows and columns alone aren't enough, we add landmarks—nearby pieces that help the builder feel where the new piece belongs.

Example: Vertically place a green 2x4 plate on the 2nd through 5th rows from the back on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left, so the back row sits on the front row of the back left 2x2 corner plate, and the front row sits on the back row of the front left 2x2 corner plate.

These tactile cues confirm the correct placement.

## General technic guidelines

### Step 1

In this set, you will use Technic elements such as liftarms, pins, axles, and connectors. Liftarms may appear in different shapes (for example, straight, L-shaped, bent, or T-shaped), and they may include both pin holes (round) and axle holes (cross-shaped). Liftarms also come in two thicknesses, which affects how far pins and axles extend when inserted.

Liftarm Thickness: Thick vs. Thin:

- A thick liftarm is the standard type and is 1L thick.
- A thin liftarm is 0.5L thick (half the thickness of a regular liftarm).

When a step uses a thin liftarm, the instruction will always say so. If the instruction does not mention thickness, you should assume the liftarm is the standard 1L thick type.

This is important because they are half as thick, and a pin or axle inserted through a thin liftarm will extend 0.5L farther on 1 side compared to the same pin inserted through a thick liftarm.

### Example

- In a 3L thick liftarm, inserting a 2L pin from front to back leaves 1L extending toward the front.
- In a 3L thin liftarm, inserting the same 2L pin from front to back leaves 1.5L extending toward the front.

### Step 2

Counting the holes:

- When a liftarm has both pin holes and axle holes, we count all holes in order, from one end of the liftarm to the other.
- Unless the instruction specifically says, in the axle hole or in the pin hole, you should assume the counting includes both types of holes together.
- The instruction will always tell you which direction to count from: from the right or from the left.

### Examples

- Insert a tan 2L pin into the 2nd back-facing hole from the right.

Count all holes (pin and axle) starting at the right end. Place the pin in the second hole.

- Insert a black 2L axle into the 3rd hole from the left.

Count all holes from the left end until the third one, regardless of type.

- Insert a blue pin into the axle hole in the 4th position from the right.

Here, the instruction specifies axle hole, so place the pin in the cross-shaped hole at that position.

### Step 3

Directional guidance for inserting or attaching pieces:

To make Technic building smoother for blind builders, we always specify the exact direction a pin, axle, or connector moves when it is inserted or attached.

We use the following terms:

- front to back — the piece moves away from you
- back to front — the piece moves toward you
- top to bottom — the piece moves downward
- bottom to top — the piece moves upward

### Examples

- Insert a black 2L pin from front to back into the second front-facing hole from the right of your 5L liftarm.
- Insert a 3L pin from back to front into the 3<sup>rd</sup> back facing pin hole from the left, so 2L of the pin extends to the back. Attach the leftmost front facing hole of your 7L liftarm from back to front onto the 2L back extending pin.

### Step 4

Specifying how far a pin or axle extends:

After inserting or attaching a piece, we always tell you how much of the pin or axle extends in each direction, using Technic length units (L).

This measurement automatically accounts for whether the liftarm is thick or thin.

### Examples

- Insert a black 2L pin from front to back into the second front-facing hole from the right of the 5L liftarm, so 1L of the pin extends toward the front.
- Attach the leftmost back-facing hole of a 7L liftarm from front to back onto the 1L pin extending at the front.

These technic guidelines help to make Technic-set building easier for blind builders.

Let's get to building!

## Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

### Group 1

#### Step 1

Horizontally place a black 1x12 plate in front of you. Vertically place the back row of a black 2x8 plate on the 2 right columns of the ppp, so 7 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 2

Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate to the right of the back row of the ppp. Horizontally place another to the right of the ppp.

#### Step 3

Horizontally place a black 1x12 plate underneath the front row of your build, so it is parallel to the back one. Place 2 pink 1x4 plates one to the right of the other on the ppp, so together they are centered horizontally.

#### Step 4

Vertically place a black 1x8 brick on top of your build on the rightmost column, so there's no overhang.

#### Step 5

Horizontally place a white 1x10 plate to the left of the front row of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Then, vertically place a dark pink 1x6 plate in front of the rightmost column of the ppp. Now, repeat symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 6

Let's make a sub build! Place a green 2x2 plate in front of you. Next, place a green 2x4 brick with 3 axle holes horizontally on the ppp, so it is centered horizontally.

#### Step 7

Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs underneath the left overhang, so the side studs face the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 8

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top of your sub build, so there's no overhang.

#### Step 9.1

Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs on the leftmost column of the ppp, so the side studs face the left. Place a green 1x1 brick on the back row of the ppp. Place a dark pink 1x1 round plate with open stud in front of the ppp.

### Group 2:

#### Step 9.2

Place a blue 1x1 round plate on the ppp.

### Group 3:

#### Step 9.3

Place a dark pink 1x1 round plate with open stud on top of the ppp.

#### Step 10

Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs on top of your sub build on the rightmost column, so the side studs face the right.

#### Step 11

Place a green 2x2 plate to the left of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally. Vertically place 2 green 1x2 bricks with pin hole on the ppp, 1 to the right of the other, so the pin holes face the left and the right. Insert a blue 3L pin from right to left into the right facing pin hole of the right one, so 1L of the pin extends to the right. Vertically attach the front left facing pin hole from right to left of a black 16L brick with 15 holes onto the right facing pin, so 14 rows overhang to the back.

#### Step 12

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top of your sub build, so there's no overhang.

#### Step 13

Place a green 2x2 plate on top of your sub build, so it is centered horizontally. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs to the left of the ppp, so the side studs face the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 14

Horizontally place a green 2x4 brick with 3 axle holes on top of your sub build, so there's no overhang.

#### Step 15

Horizontally place a green 2x4 plate on top of your sub build, so there's no overhang.

#### Step 16

Place a green 2x2 plate on top of your sub build, so it is centered horizontally. Vertically place a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs to the left of the ppp, so the side studs face the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 17

Horizontally place a green 2x4 brick with 3 axle holes on top of your sub build,

#### Step 18

Place 2 green 2x2 tiles with upright 1x2 plate 1 to the right of the other on top of your sub build, so the side studs face the back.

#### Step 19

Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place a green 2x8 plate in front of you. Place 4 green 2x2 tiles with upright 1x2 plate on top of the ppp, so the side studs face the front. You should now have 2 identical parts. Bring back your sub build so it is horizontally in front of you and the 14 overhanging columns of the 1x14 brick with 15 pin holes face the front. Flip your sub build so it sits on its back side and the 1x16 brick with 15 pin holes points upright with its pin holes facing the right and the left, and the antistuds face the front. Attach 1 of your parts upright to the right facing side studs, so the side studs of your part face up. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 20

Attach 2 green 1x2 bricks with 2 side studs on 1 long side 1 to the right of the other on the front facing antistuds using the side studs.

#### Step 21

Bring back your main build and position it horizontally in front of you so the high wall is on the right. Rotate your sub build 90 degrees clockwise, so the 2 ppps face the right. Place your sub build horizontally on top of your main build so it is centered horizontally and vertically, and it fills the gap.

#### Step 22

Vertically place a dark pink 1x2 plate with clip on the 2 front rows on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the right, so the clip faces the front. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Then, repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

#### Group 4:

#### Step 23

Place a blue 1x1 round plate on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row from the front on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the right so it sits on the front right 1x2 plate with clip on 1 sort side. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Step 24

Horizontally place the rightmost column of a white 1x10 plate behind the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Then Vertically place a dark pink 1x6 plate behind the leftmost column of the ppp.

#### Step 25

Rotate your build 90 degrees counterclockwise. Horizontally place 2 black 1x4 bricks with 4 side studs on 1 long side one to the right of the other on the front row of your build, so the side studs face the front and there's no overhang. Horizontally place a black 1x4 slope tile upright on each ppps, so they slope upward.

#### Step 26

Rotate your build 180 degrees. Horizontally place a green 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top of your build on the front row, so it is centered horizontally. Place the front row of a green 2x2 tile to the right of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the left. Vertically place a green 1x2 tile behind the left column of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 27

Rotate your build 180 degrees so the slopes face the front. Horizontally place 2 green 2x4 tiles one to the right of the other on the 2 front rows, so there's no overhang. Vertically place a green 1x2 tile on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> rows from the front on the rightmost column of your build. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

You've built the strong base where Lionel Messi will stand later in the model. Bag 1 is complete—get ready, because Bag 2 will begin bringing Messi himself to life.

Rotate your build 90 degrees clockwise. Vertically upright place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down on the 2 left visible bottom facing side studs of the 1x16 brick with 15 pin holes, so the 2x2 side studs face the front. Place a white 1x1 quarter round tile upright on the right column of the top row of front facing side studs, so the right angle faces the bottom left and the rounded edge faces the top right. Place another on the bottom row of front facing side studs on the left column, so the right angle faces the bottom right, and the rounded edge faces the top left. Place a white 1x1 tile upright to the right of the ppp. Place another upright on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row from the bottom of the left facing side studs.

#### Step 29.1

Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 plate with 1x2 upright side studs in front of you, so the side studs face the left. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick with pin hole on the ppp, so the pin holes face the front and the back.

#### Step 29.2

Insert a red 1L pin with stud from front to back into the front facing pin hole.

#### Step 29.3

Place a black 1x1 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down on top of your part, so the side studs face the right. Place a white 1x1 plate with clip upright on the top row of right facing side studs, so the clip faces the top. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Place the back row of a black 4x4 curved slope wedge tile in front of the ppps, so it slopes to the front.

#### Group 24:

#### Step 101.2

Turn your part upside down, so the slope tile is on the bottom front. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the 3<sup>rd</sup> row from the back of antistuds, so it is centered horizontally. Turn your part right side up, so the 4x4 curved slope wedge tile slopes to the front. Bring back your sub build, so it is vertically in front of you, with the antistuds and the inverted slope tiles facing the right. place your part vertically on top of your sub build.

#### Step 102

Rotate your sub build 90 degrees clockwise. Flip it, so the pin holes face the back. Insert a red 1L pin with stud from back to front into the rightmost back facing pin hole.

#### Step 103.1

Place a light blue 1x1 tile upright to the right of the ppp.

#### Group 25:

#### Step 103.2

Place a black 1x1 tile upright to the left of the ppp.

#### Step 104

Rotate your sub build 180 degrees. Then flip it so it sits on its left side and the ppps are on the front. Bring back your leg sub build, so the boot points to the left. Attach the top right facing axle hole of the leg to the red 1L axle on the bottom of your sub build.

#### Step 105

Bring back your main build, and position it horizontally in front of you, so the side with slopes faces the right. Attach the 2 back facing pin holes and the back facing axle hole onto the front protruding 2 pins and 1 axle of the previous leg, so the boot points to the right.

on the rightmost column of antistuds of your part, so the side stud of the back one faces the right, and the side stud of the front one faces the front.

Place 2 red 1x1 short bricks with a round side and a side stud one to the right of the other on the front row of antistuds of your part, so their side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

Turn your part right side up so it is horizontally in front of you and the side with no studs faces the left. Place a white 1x1 slope tile on top of your part on the back right corner, so it slopes to the front. Vertically place the back row of a reddish brown 1x2 curved right slope wedge tile on the front left corner, so it slopes to the front, and 1 row extends to the front. Place a reddish brown 2x2x2/3 curved corner slope tile to the right of the ppp, so the right angle faces the back left.

Step 172.2

Place a dark tan 2x2x2/3 curved corner slope tile symmetrically to the back. Place a tan 1x1 quarter round tile to the left of the front row of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right and the rounded edge faces the back left. Rotate your part 90 degrees counterclockwise. Bring back your sub build and position it horizontally, so the bar handles face the left. Place your part upright on the front facing side studs.

Step 173

Orient another white, black, coral, and medium blue 4x4x2 half sphere so the hollow side faces down and insert the top facing 1L pin into the bottom facing pin hole. You have built a soccer ball. Now, insert a black 2L bar with stop ring from top to bottom into the top facing pin hole of your ball, so 1L protrudes to the top. Slide a green 1x1 round plate with open stud from top to bottom through the top end of the ppp. Turn your ball build upside down so the bar is on the bottom. Vrinb back your main build and position it horizontally, so Lionel Messi is facing forward. Locate a small slot or gap with a clip on the base of your main build on the front left section. Attach the bottom bar to this clip.

Bag 8 is complete—you've built two strong side structures behind Messi, one on each side, ready to support the big number 10 in the next bag. You've also created the tall vertical name sign with raised letters spelling "Messi," giving the display a proud, heroic look. Finally, you've built the official FIFA soccer ball and placed it on the base. Your scene is now full of energy and detail—fantastic work. Open the last bag to finish the gorgeous work!

#### Description:

In this alternative build, Lionel Messi is displayed in a dynamic running pose, dribbling a football. The figure stands on the same horizontal rectangular base, fully covered with smooth green tiles that represent the pitch. - And the blue captain's armband on his left wrist.

His hair is built from LEGO pieces, forming a short, slightly lifted hairstyle. His face is a molded element, with the beard printed on in dark tones around the jaw and chin, reflecting Messi's real-life short beard. The printed eyes, nose, and mouth give him a focused, determined expression appropriate for a running pose.

Behind the figure, two vertical LEGO-built numbers — 1 and 0 — stand upright in gold and blue, forming his iconic 10.

Between Messi's legs, horizontally aligned and standing upright, there is a LEGO-built nameplate spelling MESSI in raised brick lettering.

This alternative build captures Messi in motion, dribbling with precision and speed, offering a dynamic contrast to the celebratory victory pose of the main model.

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 2):

Step 1

Horizontally place a black 1x12 plate in front of you. Vertically place the back row of a black 2x8 plate on the 2 right columns of the ppp, so 7 rows overhang to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 2

Horizontally place a pink 1x4 plate to the right of the back row of the ppp. Horizontally place another to the right of the ppp.

Step 3

Horizontally place a black 1x12 plate underneath the front row of your build, so it is parallel to the back one. Place 2 pink 1x4 plates one to the right of the other on the ppp, so together they are centered horizontally.

Step 4

Vertically place a black 1x8 brick on top of your build on the rightmost column, so there's no overhang.

Step 5

Horizontally place a white 1x10 plate to the left of the front row of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Then, vertically place a dark pink 1x6 plate in front of the rightmost column of the ppp. Now, repeat symmetrically to the left.

Let's make a sub build! Place a green 2x2 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 brick on the back row of the ppp, so it is centered horizontally.

Step 7

Vertically place the back row of a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs underneath the leftmost column of the ppp, so the side studs face the left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Let's make a part! Horizontally place an upside down green 2x8 plate in front of you. Take a green 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side stud and orient it vertically so the side studs face the right. Then, flip it, so it sits on its right side. In this position place it on the 2 right columns of antistuds of your part. Vertically place the 2 back rows of a dark grey 2x3 inverted slope brick to the left of the ppp, so it slopes to the front. Turn your part right side up so the 2 ppps are on the bottom left. Horizontally place a green 1x2 slope tile on the front row of the ppp, so it slopes to the front. Bring back your sub build so and position it vertically in front of you, so the pin hole faces the left. Hold your part vertically upright so the 3 ppps are on the top and the antistuds face the back. Attach your part to the front facing side studs of your sub build.

Bring back your main build, so the side with slopes is on the front. Horizontally place your part upright on the front facing side studs of the light blue 1x1 plate with 1x2 side studs hanging down from this same step.

#### Step 27

Vertically upright place a white 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs on the 2 right bottom facing antistuds of the 1x16 brick with 15 pin holes, so the 2x2 side studs face the front. Place a white 1x1 quarter round tile upright on the right column of the top row of front facing side studs, so the right angle faces the bottom left and the rounded edge faces the top right. Place another on the bottom row of front facing side studs on the left column, so the right angle faces the bottom right, and the rounded edge faces the top left. Place a white 1x1 tile upright to the right of the ppp.

#### Step 28

Insert a red 1L pin with stud into the front bottommost facing pin hole. Skip 1 pin hole to the top and insert another.

#### Step 29

Attach a black 1x4 tile vertically upright onto the front facing side studs of the 2 ppps, so only 5 pin holes of the 1x16 brick are visible.

Place a white 1x1 tile upright to the left of the ppp. Place another upright on the 3<sup>rd</sup> row from the bottom of right facing side studs.

Let's make a part! Place a black 1x1 plate with 1x2 upright side studs in front of you, so the side studs face the right. Place a dark grey 1x1 brick with pin hole on the ppp, so the pin holes face the front and the back.

Insert a red 1L pin with stud from front to back into the front facing pin hole.

#### Step 35.3

You've now built Messi's running boot, the lower leg, and the thigh that will support his dynamic pose. The tip of the boot is designed to touch the ground lightly, and the small heel support piece helps the figure stay balanced while running. This section is an important part of the final movement of the model.

Take a moment to feel the structure: the leg is strong, angled forward, and ready to connect to the rest of the body.

Now you're ready for the next step —

open Bag 3 to build Messi's waist and continue shaping his running pose.

Let's make a sub build. Stack 2 tan 2x3 plates and place your stack horizontally in front of you.

#### Step 66

Horizontally place a yellow 1x3 plate on the back row of the ppp, so there's no overhang. Horizontally place a dark grey 1x3 jumper plate in front of the ppp.

#### Step 67

Place a red 1x1 brick with axle hole on the back right corner of your part, so the axle holes face the right and the left. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Insert a red 2L axle from right to left into the right facing axle hole, so 1L of the axle extends to the right.

#### Step 108

Place a yellow 1x1 round plate on the leftmost column of the back row of your sub build (here, we are counting only the columns within this mentioned row). Place a black 1x1 slope tile on the ppp, so it slopes to the front.

#### Step 109

Horizontally place a black 1x2 curved slope tile to the right of the ppp, so it slopes to the back.

#### Step 110

Horizontally place a black 1x4 plate on the front row, so 1 column overhangs to the right. Place a black 1x1 plate on the rightmost column of the ppp. Horizontally place the rightmost column of a black 1x3 curved slope tile on the ppp, so it slopes to the left. Place a black 1x1 slope tile to the left of the ppp, so it slopes to the front.

#### Step 111

Vertically place a light blue 1x2 slope tile with 2/3 inverted cutout on the rightmost column of the back row (here, we are counting only the columns within the mentioned row), so it slopes to the back and 1 row overhangs to the front

#### Group 22:

#### Step 112

Flip your sub build, so it sits on its back side and the antistuds face the front. Vertically place a black 1x2 plate upright on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the right of front facing antistuds. Place the right column of a black 2x2 curved inverted slope tile upright on the ppp, so it slopes to the left.

#### Step 113

Place a black 1x1 round plate upright on the leftmost column of the bottom row facing antistuds (here, we are counting only the columns within this mentioned row). Vertically place the front row of a black 1x2 inverted curved slope tile on the ppp, so it slopes upward.

Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2x2/3 ribbed plate with axle hole in front of you. Turn your part upside down, so the slope tile is on the bottom front. Horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the 3<sup>rd</sup> row from the back of antistuds, so it is centered horizontally. Turn your part right side up, so the 4x4 curved slope wedge tile slopes to the front. Bring back your sub build, so it is vertically in front of you, with the antistuds and the inverted slope tiles facing the right. place your part vertically on top of your sub build.

Step 115

Rotate your sub build 90 degrees clockwise. Flip it, so the pin holes face the back. Insert a red 1L pin with stud from back to front into the rightmost back facing pin hole.

Step 116.1

Place a light blue 1x1 tile upright to the right of the ppp.

Group 24:

Step 116.2

Place a black 1x1 tile upright to the left of the ppp.

Step 117

Rotate your sub build 180 degrees. Then flip it so it sits on its left side and the ppps are on the front. Bring back your leg sub build, so the boot points to the left. Attach the top right facing axle hole of the leg to the red 1L axle on the bottom of your sub build.

Step 118

Bring back your main build, and position it vertically in front of you, so the side with slopes faces the back. Attach the 2 back facing pin holes and the back facing axle hole onto the front protruding 2 pins and 1 axle of the previous leg, so the boot points to the right.

Step 119

Attach a black 1x2 curved inverted slope tile upright on the free left facing antistuds, so it slopes to the front.

Great work finishing Bag 4!

You've now built Messi's second leg, the one that stretches back in his running pose. This leg does not touch the ground, giving the figure a sense of speed and motion. The boot and thigh are firmly assembled and connected to the waist, completing the lower half of Messi's dynamic run.

Feel how the leg angles backward, lifted and extended — it adds energy and movement to the whole model. With both legs now in place, Messi's running posture is clearly taking shape.

You're ready for the next step:

open Bag 5 to continue building Messi's upper body, bringing the figure even closer to life.

## Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 2):

### Group 25:

#### Step 120

Let's make a sub build! let's start building the torso. Horizontally place a dark grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Vertically place a dark pink 1x2 plate on the rightmost column of the ppp.

#### Step 121

Vertically place a dark green 1x2 brick with rotation joint socket on the top of the ppp, so the joint socket faces the right.

#### Step 122.1

Horizontally place a light orange 1x2x1 2/3 brick with 2x2 side studs to the left of the front row of the ppp, so the side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

### Group 26:

#### Step 122.2

Vertically place a grey 1x2x1 2/3 brick with studs on 3 sides to the left of the 2 ppps, so the 2x2 side studs face the left.

#### Step 123

Horizontally place the 4 right columns of a black 1x5 plate on the front row of your sub build, so 1 column overhangs to the left. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Step 124

Horizontally place a dark tan 2x3 plate on top of your sub build on the 3 left columns. Vertically place a dark pink 1x2 plate on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the left of the ppp, Place the left column of a light blue 2x2 curved slope tile with the number 10 in black on the ppp, so it slopes to the right.

#### Step 125.1

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2x2 side studs hanging down to the left of the ppp, so the side studs face the left. Rotate your sub build 90 degrees counterclockwise. Place a black 1x1x1 quarter rounded dome tile upright on the top row of front facing side studs on the leftmost column, so the right angle faces the top left. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 125.2

Place the back row of a light blue 1x2 right wedge tile on top of your sub build on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row from the front on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the right. so, the point faces the front. Place a light blue 1x2 left wedge tile to the left of the ppp, so the point faces the front.

#### Step 126

Vertically place a light blue 2x3 tile on top of your sub build on the 2 back rows, so 1 row overhangs to the back.

#### Step 127

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place an upside down white 2x2 plate in front of you. Place 2 red 1x1 short bricks with a round side and a side stud one to the right of the other on the front row of antistuds of the ppp, so the side studs face the front. Repeat both placements symmetrically to the back. You should now have 2 identical parts. Bring back your sub build and position it horizontally in front of you, so the black 1x1x1 quarter rounded dome tiles face the left. Horizontally place the left column of a white 1x2 curved slope tile upright on the top row of the ppp, so it slopes to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the front.

Place a white 1x1 curved slope tile on top of your sub build on the front row on the right column, so it slopes to the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Step 131

Let's make 2 identical parts! Horizontally place an upside down white 2x3 plate in front of you. Place 3 red 1x1 short bricks with a round side and a side stud one to the right of the other on the front row of antistuds, so the side studs face the front. Repeat the 3 placements symmetrically to the back. Turn your part right side up. Then, rotate it 90 degrees clockwise. Place a light blue 2x2 tile on the 2 front rows. You should now have 2 identical parts. Bring back your sub build, so the rotating joint socket is on the front and the antistuds face the right. place your part vertically on top of the sub build in front of a 1x2 slope tile and a 2x2 plate. Let's make a part! Vertically place a dark grey 2x4 plate in front of you. Vertically place a black 1x4 plate on the left column of the ppp, so there's no overhang. Vertically place a grey 1x2 plate with socket on 1 short side to the right of the 2 front rows of the ppp, so the socket faces the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Step 136.2

Stack 2 black 1x2 rounded plates. Vertically place your stack on top of your part on the right column, so it is centered vertically.

#### Step 136.3

Insert the black 1L bar with claw from top to bottom into each open stud of the ppp, so the hands of the claws face the right and the left. Let's make a part! Place an upside down white 4x6 curved wedge plate with the number 10 in black, so the side with studs is on the bottom back.

#### Step 137.2

Vertically place a dark pink 1x2 plate on the 2 back rows on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the left of antistuds. Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with bar handle on 1 short side to the right of the ppp, so the bar handle faces the back. Repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 137.3

Place a white 2x2 round corner plate with 1x1 cutout on top of your part on the 2 front rows on the 2 left columns of antistuds, so the outside curving edge faces the front left. Great work finishing Bag 5! You've now built Messi's torso, complete with the iconic Argentina jersey in white and light-blue stripes. This section is solid and detailed, and it

connects neatly to the waist you assembled earlier. With the torso in place, Messi's upper body is starting to take shape, and the model is gaining height and presence.

Now you're ready for the next step — open Bag 6 to build Messi's other leg, completing the lower body and strengthening his dynamic running pose.

You're doing an amazing job. Let's keep going.

Horizontally place the rightmost column of a tan 1x6 plate in front of the left column of the ppp., so 5 columns are exposed to the left.

Step 149

Horizontally place the 1x2 plate of a tan 2x2 tile with upright plate on the back row of your sub build, so the antistuds face the back. Place a black 2x2 plate upright on the antistuds of the ppp.

Step 150

Horizontally place the front row of a tan 2x4 right wedge plate on the front row on the 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> columns from the left, so the studs face the front, and the cut corner faces the back left, and 1 row overhangs to the back.

Step 151

Let's make a part! Place a tan 2x2 plate with cut corner in front of you, so the right angle faces the back left. Place a white 1x1 2/3 short brick with 2 side studs to the left of the ppp, so the side studs face the front. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Vertically place a grey 1x2x1 2/3 with studs on 3 sides to the left of the ppps, so the 2x2 side studs face the left.

#### Step 190

Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on top of your sub build on the rightmost column of visible studs.

#### Step 191

Turn your part upside down so the slopes are on the bottom right. Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on the leftmost column of antistuds.

#### Step 192

Horizontally place the left column of a reddish brown 1x2 curved inverted slope tile on the front row of the ppp, so it slopes to the right. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Step 193

Vertically place a tan 1x2 plate on the 2<sup>nd</sup> column from the right of antistuds. Place 2 tan 1x1 rounded plates with bar handle 1 in front of the other on the ppp, so the bar handles face the right.

#### Step 194

Place the right column of a tan 2x2 curved inverted slope tile on the ppps, so it slopes to the right.

#### Step 195

Rotate your sub build 90 degrees counterclockwise, so the bar handle faces the back. Place a reddish brown 2x2 plate with 2 side studs upright on the front facing side studs,

Great work finishing Bag 6! You've now built Messi's arms and his head, completing the entire upper body. The arms attach firmly to the torso and can be positioned slightly forward or backward to match his running motion. The molded head, with printed facial details and the brick-built hair, gives the figure its final personality and expression.

Take a moment to feel how everything connects: the torso, the waist, and both legs now support the arms and head, forming a complete and dynamic figure. Messi is almost ready to take the field.

Insert a black 2L pin from top to bottom into the top facing pin hole, so 1L of the pin extends to the top. Repeat symmetrically to the bottom. Place a white, black coral and medium blue 4x4x2 half sphere with pin hole upside down in front of you, so the hollow side faces up. Insert the bottom facing 1L pin of your part into the top facing pin hole of the half sphere. Orient another white, black, coral, and medium blue 4x4x2 half sphere so the hollow side faces down and insert the top facing 1L pin into the bottom facing pin hole. You have built a soccer ball. Now, insert a black 2L bar with stop ring from top to bottom into the top facing pin hole of your ball, so 1L protrudes to the top. Slide a green 1x1 round plate with open stud from top to bottom through the top end of the ppp. Turn your ball build upside down so the bar is on the bottom. Vrinb back your main build and position it

horizontally, so Lionel Messi is facing the left. Locate a small slot or gap with a clip on the base of your main build on the front left section in front of the supporting foot. Attach the bottom bar to this clip.

Great work finishing Bag 7! You've now completed the full base, adding the final green tiles and placing the black signature plaque with Lionel Messi's golden autograph. The field is now complete, smooth, and ready to support the entire figure in both poses.

Take a moment to explore the base with your hands: the surface is even, the edges are firm, and the signature plaque sits proudly at the front. This foundation ties the whole model together and gives Messi his place on the pitch.

With the base fully assembled, you're ready for the final steps of the build. You're doing wonderfully — let's keep going.

Building Instructions (Bag 9, Book 2):

Group 48:

Step 267

Rotate your main build 180 degrees, so Messi is facing the right. Locate 2 2x2 round tiles with hole on the front side. Insert the axle end of a black 3L pin axle from top to bottom into the right top facing hole you have found, so the 1L pin end protrudes to the top. Repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 268

Let's make a sub build. let's build the number 1. Horizontally place a black 4x12 plate in front of you. Horizontally place a light blue 2x6 plate on the back left corner of the ppp.

Step 269

Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 plate in front of the 4 left columns of the ppp. Horizontally place the 4 left columns of a light blue 2x6 plate in front of the ppp, so 1 row overhangs to the front.

Step 270

Horizontally place a black 1x12 plate in front of the 4x12 plate, so the back left corner attaches to the front overhang.

Group 49:

Step 271

Horizontally place the 8 left columns of a red 1x12 plate on top of your sub build on the 8 right columns, so it is centered vertically and 4 columns overhang to the right.

Step 272

Place a light blue 2x2 plate on the 2 back rows on the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> columns from the left. Horizontally place a light blue 2x6 plate to the right of the ppp, so 2 columns overhang to the right. Repeat the 2 placements symmetrically to the front.

Step 273

Horizontally place a black 4x6 plate to the right of the bottom 4x12 plate, so it attaches underneath the right overhang. Only the 2 right columns of the front row of your sub build should overhang still.

Group 50:

Step 274

Place the 6 left columns of a black 1x12 plate in front of the ppp, so 6 columns are exposed to the right.

#### Step 275

Place the front row of a light blue 2x2 plate on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> columns from the right of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the back.

#### Step 276

Horizontally place a light blue 1x4 plate to the right of the front row of the ppp, so 2 columns overhang to the right. Horizontally place another in front of the ppp. Horizontally place the 4 left columns of a light blue 2x6 plate in front of the ppps, so the back right corner overhangs.

#### Step 277

Place the front left corner of a black 6x6 plate with cut corner underneath the 2nd row from the front and the 6th column from the right counting the entire build, so the right angle faces the front left.

#### Group 51:

#### Step 278

Place a green 2x2 plate on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows from the back on the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> columns from the right counting the entire build. Place a light blue 2x2 plate with cut corner to the left of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right and 1 row overhangs to the back.

#### Group 52:

#### Step 279

Place a light blue 2x2 plate on the 2 front rows of your sub build on the 2 right columns. Place the 2 right columns of a light blue 4x4 plate with cut corner behind the ppp, so the right angle faces the front left.

#### Step 280

Horizontally place the right column of a light blue 1x2 left wedge tile behind the left column of the ppp, so it points to the right. Place a light blue 1x2 right wedge tile horizontally to the left of the ppp, so the point faces the left.

#### Step 281

Horizontally place a metallic gold 2x2 tile on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows from the front on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> columns from the left. Horizontally place a metallic gold 1x2 tile behind the ppp.

#### Step 282

Horizontally place 3 metallic gold 1x6 tiles one in front of the other to the right of the 2 ppps. Horizontally place 3 more one in front of the other to the right of the 3 ppps, so there are 6 in total.

#### Step 283

Horizontally place a metallic gold 1x6 tile to the right of the front ppp. Place a metallic gold 2x2 tile behind the 2 left columns of the ppp. Place a metallic gold 1x1 quarter round tile to the right of the front row of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front left and the rounded edge the back right. Place the right column of a metallic gold 2x2 curved corner tile to the right of the ppp, so the outside curved edge faces the back right.

#### Step 284

Horizontally place a metallic gold 1x2 tile to the right of the front row of the ppp. Place a metallic gold 2x2 tile behind the ppp.

#### Step 285

Place a metallic gold 2x2 triangular tile to the right of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front left. Place a metallic gold 2x2 tile in front of the ppp.

#### Step 286

Place a metallic gold 2x2 triangular tile on the 2 back rows behind a 2x2 tile, so the right angle faces the front left. Place another to the left of the ppp, so the right angle faces the front right. Place another in front of the ppp, so the right angle faces the back right.

#### Group 53:

#### Step 287

Turn your sub build upside down, so the flag is on the right. Horizontally place a black 1x1 plate on the front left corner of your upside down sub build.

#### Step 288

Let's make a sub build. Horizontally place a black 1x14 brick with 13 pin holes in front of you, so the pin holes face the front and the back. Insert a red 1L pin with stud from front to back into the front facing centered pin hole.

#### Step 289

Let's make 2 identical parts! Vertically place a black 2x5 stair plate in front of you, so the stairs lead down to the back. Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 brick with axle hole on the 2<sup>nd</sup> row from the back. You should now have 2 identical parts. Bring back your sub build and position it horizontally so the pin holes face the front and the back and the stud of the 1L pin with stud faces the front. Place the back row of 1 of your parts underneath the 2 left columns of your sub build. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 290

Insert a red 1L pin with stud from front to back into the rightmost front facing pin hole on the left of the right stair plate. Insert another into the front facing hole to the left of the ppp. Repeat both placements symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 291

Horizontally place the 2 left columns of a black 1x3 tile upright on the 2 ppps. Horizontally place a black 1x4 plate upright to the right of the ppp. Horizontally place a black 1x3 tile upright to the right of the ppp.

#### Step 292

Horizontally place a black 1x3 tile on the back row on the 5<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> columns from the right. Horizontally place a black 1x2 left wedge tile to the left of the ppp, so the point faces the left.

#### Step 293

Turn your sub build upside down so the stair plates face the back. Bring back your number 1 sub build and turn it upside down so the flag is on the back right. Place the 4 right columns of your sub build on the 4 left columns of your number 1 build on the 5 front rows. so 10 columns overhang to the left. And 4 rows overhang to the back.

#### Group 54:

#### Step 294

Let's make a sub build! Let's build the number 0. Horizontally place an upside down light blue 6x6 quarter round plate in front of you, so the rounded edge faces the front right and the right angle faces the back left. Vertically place the right column of a black 2x3 plate on top of your sub build on the 3 front rows on the left column of antistuds, so 1 column overhangs to the left.

#### Step 295

Place a light blue 6x6 quarter round plate to the left of the ppp, so the right bangle faces the back right and the rounded edge the front left, and the 3 front rows of the right column attach underneath the left overhang.

#### Step 296

Vertically place a pink 2x8 plate behind the 2x3 plate, so it is centered horizontally and 5 rows overhang to the back.

#### Step 297

Vertically place 2 upside down light blue 6x12 plates one to the right of the other behind the 2 quarter round plates, so they attach underneath the back overhang.

#### Step 298

Horizontally place a black 2x12 plate on top of your upside down sub build on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> rows of antistuds from the back, so there's no overhang. Vertically place a pink 2x8 plate behind the ppp, so it is centered horizontally and 3 rows overhang to the back.

#### Step 299

Let's make a part! Horizontally place an upside down light blue 6x6 quarter round plate in front of you, so the rounded edge faces the front right and the right angle faces the back left. Vertically place the right column of a black 2x3 plate on top of your sub build on the 3 front rows on the left column\_\_\_0 of antistuds, so 1 column overhangs to the left. Place a light blue 6x6 quarter round plate to the left of the ppp, so the right bangle faces the back right and the rounded edge the front left, and the 3 front rows of the right column attach underneath the left overhang. Turn your part 180 degrees. Bring back your upside down number 0 build and position it vertically so the rounded side is on the front. Place your part behind the 2 vertical 6x12 plates and underneath the back overhang.

#### Step 300

Place a black 5x5 round corner plate with 4x4 cutout on the front right corner of your upside down sub build., so the rounded edges are even. Repeat symmetrically to the back. Then, vertically place the right column of a black 2x6 plate in front of the ppp. Repeat symmetrically to the front. Now, repeat the 4 placements symmetrically to the left.

#### Group 55:

#### Step 301

Turn your number 0 build right side up, so it is vertically in front of you. Place a metallic gold 2x2 tile on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows from the back, so it is centered horizontally. Horizontally place a metallic gold 1x2 tile in front of the ppp.

#### Step 302

Place a metallic gold 2x2 curved corner tile to the right of the ppp, so the outside curving edge faces the back right. Place a metallic gold 3x3 curved corner tile to the right and behind the ppp, so the outside curving edge faces the back right. Place a metallic gold 4x4 curved corner tile behind and to the right of the ppp, so the outside curving edge faces the back right. Repeat the 3 placements symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 303

Vertically place 3 metallic gold 1x6 tiles 1 to the right of the other in front of the 3 ppps. Repeat the 3 placements symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 304

Place a metallic gold 2x2 tile in front of the 2 right 1x6 tiles. Vertically place a metallic gold 1x2 tile to the left of the ppp. Repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 305

Vertically place 3 metallic gold 1x6 tiles one to the right of the other in front of the 2 ppps. Repeat the 3 placements symmetrically to the right.

#### Step 306

Place a metallic gold 2x2 tile on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rows from the front, so it is centered horizontally. Horizontally place a metallic gold 1x2 tile behind the ppp. Place a metallic gold 2x2 curved corner tile to the right of the ppp, so the outside curving edge faces the front right. Place a metallic gold 3x3 curved corner tile to the right and in -front of the ppp, so the outside curving edge faces the front right. Place a metallic gold 4x4 curved corner tile in front of and to the right of the ppp, so the outside curving edge faces the front right. Repeat the 3 placements symmetrically to the left.

#### Step 307

Turn your sub build upside down. Place the 5 rows and the 4 left columns of your sub build on the 5 front rows of antistuds of your number 0 build, so it is centered horizontally on the number 0 build.

#### Step 308

Bring back your main build, so Leo Messi is facing the right. Locate the 2 pins. Hold your sub build upright, so the antistuds face the front and the pin holes face up and down. Attach the 6<sup>th</sup> bottom hole from the left from top to bottom onto the left pin. Repeat symmetrically to the right.

Great work finishing Bag 9! You've now completed the full base, adding the final green tiles and placing the black signature plaque with Lionel Messi's golden autograph. The field is now complete, smooth, and ready to support the entire figure in both poses.

Take a moment to explore the base with your hands: the surface is even, the edges are firm, and the signature plaque sits proudly at the front. This foundation ties the whole model together and gives Messi his place on the pitch.

And now your Messi is flying forward with the ball at his feet — you've built his speed, his balance, and his magic touch. To finish the pose, imagine him taking one last light tap on the ball, his body leaning into the run, and his free arm lifting just a little in celebration. It's that tiny, happy moment right before he breaks into a smile — the "I did it!" feeling captured in bricks.

Your build ends with Messi standing proud and ready, the ball close beside him, as if he's about to score the winning goal. You've completed the whole dynamic motion, and it looks fantastic. Great job, builder — you've brought the excitement of the pitch right into your hands.
