Bags 2-4 include the pieces for the treasure chest.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.

- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43229>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 5 bags labeled 1 to 5, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Group 16 - Step 101 and 8 light blue 1x1 quarter tiles from Step 102.

Group 17 - 4 transparent light blue 1x1 round tiles and 8 teal 1x1 quarter tiles from Step 102.

Group 18 - 4 pink 1x1 quarter tiles from Step 102.

Group 19 - 4 light orange 1x1 quarter tiles from Step 102.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Ariel

Step 6

Locate 1 pair of legs printed with a teal tail, 1 light brown torso printed with a blue top, 1 brown head printed with dark red eyes, 1 dark red hair, and 1 pink flower. Assemble your minifigure then attach the flower to the side of her hair! Also make sure the tail faces the right!

Step 7

Locate a transparent light blue dress, 1 gold bar, and 1 transparent light blue umbrella top. Insert the gold bar into the bottom of the umbrella then attach it to her hand! Now you can take off the tail and attach the dress!

Step 8

The dress and umbrella top are also a container when you attach them to each other! You can store all of the parts of the minifigure inside!

Group 2 - Treasure Chest

Step 1

Horizontally place a teal 1x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place another 1 on top.

Step 2

Horizontally place a teal 1x2 plate underneath the 2 leftmost and 2 rightmost columns.

Step 3

Vertically place the front rows of 2 teal 2x10 plates, 1 to the right of the other, underneath the build and in between the previous 1x2 plates.

Step 4

Let's make a part! Repeat steps 1-2 again then horizontally place your part on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 5

Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 brick in front of the 1x4 plate from the previous step. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 plate in front.

Step 6

Let's make a part! Place an orange 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place 2 light grey 1x2 plates with a hinge connector on top so the hinge connectors face left and right. Then place an orange 2x2 plate on top. Now place your part in front of the 1x4 plate from the previous step so it is centered horizontally and the hinge connectors face the left and right.

Step 7

Horizontally place a light purple 2x4 brick in front of the previous part so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place 2 teal 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row so they are centered horizontally and slope inwards.

Step 8

Vertically place a tan 2x6 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally and there is no overhang in the back. Then vertically place a tan 1x8 brick to the left and right so there is no overhang in the back.

Step 9.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x6 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a teal 1x4 brick with a gap on the 4 right columns so the gap faces the front. Then horizontally place another 1 to the left so it overhangs 2 columns to the left and the gap faces the front. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total!

Step 9.2

Horizontally place the overhang of 1 part on the back right corner so the gap faces the front. Then horizontally place the overhang of another part on the front left corner so the gap faces the back.

Step 10.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x6 brick in front of you. Then horizontally place a teal 1x4 brick with a gap on the 4 left columns so the gap faces the front. Then horizontally place another 1 to the right so it overhangs 2 columns to the right and the gap faces the front.

Step 10.2

Horizontally place the overhang of 1 part on the back left corner so the gap faces the front. Then horizontally place the overhang of another part on the front right corner so the gap faces the back.

Step 11

Flip your build upside down so it is horizontal. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate in the front left and front right corner. Now horizontally place another 1 on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the back.

Group 3 - Treasure Chest

Step 12

Flip your build over so it is horizontal and the 1x2 sloped curved bricks are on the front row. Vertically place a tan 6x10 plate on the 6 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place a tan 2x10 plate to the right so it is also centered vertically. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 13

Horizontally place a tan 1x2 slope tile on the front row of the 2x6 brick that is centered horizontally so it slopes to the back. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 slope tile on the front 2 rows of the 1x8 brick that is to the left so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place a tan 1x1 round plate on the front row on top of each of the 1x2 sloped curved bricks.

Step 14

Let's make a part! Place a light grey 1x2x2 brick with 2x2 side studs in front of you so the 2 studs face the back and the 2x2 studs face up.

Step 15

Place a red 2x2 turntable plate on top of the 2x2 studs. Then place a light grey 2x2 round turntable plate on top.

Step 16

Place a light blue 2x2 round plate with 6 tentacles on top so it is centered.

Step 17

Place a white 2x2 round brick on top. Then place a white 2x2 round tile with a hole on top.

Step 18.1

Let's make another part! Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x2 log brick on top. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate on top. Then place a white 2x2 tile with a circle on top so it overhangs 1 row to the front.

Step 18.2

Flip your previous part upright so the 2x2 round tile with a hole faces the front. Then horizontally place the overhang of your part on top so the part faces the back.

Step 19

Vertically place your part in between the 3 1x2 slope tiles on the build so the 2x2 round tile with a gap faces the front.

Step 20

Place a light blue round 2x2 plate with 6 tentacles on top of the circle of the 2x2 tile so it is centered. Then place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top.

Step 21

Insert a light purple heart-shaped key into the front-facing 2x2 round tile with a hole.

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 1):

Group 4 - Treasure Chest

Step 22

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a tan 8x8 plate in front of you.

Step 23

Horizontally place a teal 1x6 brick on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 24

Vertically place a teal 1x2 brick in the back left and back right corners. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 25.1

Let's make a part! Vertically place a teal 1x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on top so it is centered vertically and the clip faces the left. Now place a tan 1x1 round plate on the front and back studs. Then vertically place a teal 1x4 plate on top.

Step 25.2

Vertically place your part on the leftmost column in between the 1x2 bricks so the clip faces the left.

Step 26

Horizontally place 4 teal 1x3 half-arches, 1 in front of the other, on the rightmost column in between the 1x2 bricks so they arch to the right.

Step 27

Horizontally place a tan 1x8 plate with a rail on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 28

Vertically place 2 tan 1x3 plates, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column in between the previous plates. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Make sure they sit on the leftmost columns of the 1x3 half arches!

Step 29

Vertically place a light blue 1x8 tile on the leftmost column on top of the previous plates so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. It should sit on the plates from the previous step! Then horizontally place 2 light blue 1x3 tiles, 1 to the right of the other, on the front row in between the previous tiles. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 30

Flip your build upside down. Then place a white 2x2 round plate with a smooth underside on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left and 2nd and 3rd rows from the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 31

Flip your build back over so the 1x3 half-arches face the right. Then vertically place a teal 1x4 sloped curved brick on the rightmost column on top of the half-arches so it slopes to the right. Then vertically place another 1 to the left so it slopes to the left.

Step 32

Now you should have 2 identical parts! These are drawers for the chest! Bring back your main build so the key faces the front. Then insert 1 part underneath the left side so the 1x4 sloped curved bricks face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 1):

Group 5 - Treasure Chest

Step 33

Horizontally place a teal 2x6 brick on the back left corner. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 brick to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally place a teal 2x6 brick in between the previous 1x2 bricks.

Step 34

Vertically place a teal 1x6 brick in the front left corner. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 brick behind it. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 35

Horizontally place a teal 1x6 brick on the front row to the right of the vertical 1x6 brick that is in the front left corner. Then place a teal 1x1 brick with a side stud on the front row to the right so the side stud faces

the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally place a teal 1x4 arch brick on the front row in between the 1x1 bricks with a side stud.

Step 36

Vertically place a light purple 1x2 tile on the back left corner. Then vertically place a light purple 1x6 plate in front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 37

Place a light purple 2x2 corner plate in the front left corner so it looks like the braille letter h. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x2 plate on the front row to the right. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x6 plate to the right. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

Group 6 - Treasure Chest

Step 38

Horizontally place a light blue 2x3 plate on the back 2 rows to the right of the 1x2 tile that is in the back left corner. Then vertically place a mint blue 1x2 tile to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 39

Place a teal 2x2 brick on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left in front of the previous 2x3 plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now place another teal 2x2 brick to the left of the 2x2 brick you placed on the right.

Step 40

Horizontally place a mint blue 1x2 brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a mint blue 1x4 brick to the left and right.

Step 41

Horizontally place a white 1x8 plate with a rail on the back row on top of the previous bricks so it is centered horizontally and the rail faces the back. Then place a white 1x1 round plate to the left and right.

Step 42.1

Horizontally place a light blue 1x10 plate on the back row on top of the previous plates so it is centered horizontally.

Group 7 - Treasure Chest

Step 42.2

Horizontally place a white 1x10 plate on the back row on top of the previous plate so it is centered horizontally.

Step 43

Let's make 2 identical parts! Place a white 2x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light blue 2x3 plate on top so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 44

Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2 side studs sticking up underneath the overhang so the side studs face the right.

Step 45

Vertically place a light yellow 1x2 plate on the rightmost column.

Step 46

Vertically place a white 1x2 brick with an axle hole on the leftmost column. Then place a light grey 1x2 brick with a hole and a 1x2 plate part to the right so the plate part is on the right.

Step 47

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the rightmost column so the side studs face the right.

Step 48

Place a white 2x2 plate upright on the right-facing 2x2 side studs. Then place a mint blue 2x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.

Step 49

Now you should have 2 identical parts! Horizontally place 1 part on the back 2 rows on the left 2x3 plate so the upright tile faces the right. Make sure the 1x2 tile in the back left corner is free. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 50

Place a white 1x1 half-cylinder brick on the back left corner of the previous part you placed on the left so it slopes to the front and back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place 4 white 1x4 half-cylinder bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the back row in between the previous 1x1 half-cylinder bricks.

Step 51

Horizontally place a white 1x4 tile in front of the previous 1x1 half-cylinder brick that is in the back left corner so there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 52

Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the back left corner of the 2x2 brick that is in front of the left 1x4 tile from the previous step. Then place a light orange 1x1 flower upright on each of the front-facing side studs that are to the left and right of the heart-shaped key.

Step 53

Place a dark tan 1x1 round tile with an upward bar to the right of the 1x4 tile that is in the back left corner. Then place a gold bow and arrow on top so it faces the right.

Group 8 - Treasure Chest

There are no steps in this group. You will have 3 extra light orange 1x1 round flower plates. Save them for later.

Group 9 - Treasure Chest

Step 54.1

Let's make a part! Place a green 1x1 round flower plate in front of you. Then insert the bar of a green plant with side studs and bars so the stud faces up. Now place a light orange 1x1 round flower plate from group 8 on top of the top-facing stud. Then place another 1 upright on the front-facing leftmost and rightmost side studs.

Step 54.2

Horizontally place your part in front of the 1x4 tile that is in the back left corner to the right of the 2x2 brick so the flower plates face the front.

Step 55

Place a gold telescope bar on the back row to the left of the 1x4 tile that is in the back right corner. Then horizontally place a red crab on the column to the left on the 4th stud from the back so the claws face the front.

Group 10 - Treasure Chest

Step 56

Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the back row to the left of the telescope bar. Then place a transparent light purple diamond on top.

Step 57

Vertically place a light purple 1x8 tile on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a light purple 1x8 tile on the front row to the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a light purple 1x2 tile on the front row in between the previous tiles.

Building Instructions (Bag 4, Book 1):

Step 58

Place a teal 2x2 slope brick in front of the 2x2 brick that is in the back left corner to the left of the plant so it slopes to the front. Then vertically place a teal 1x2 slope tile in front of the plant so it slopes to the right.

Step 59

Horizontally place a teal 1x2 slope tile in front of the 2 teal 2x2 bricks that are in the back right corner so it is centered horizontally in front of them and slopes to the front. Then place a tan 2x2 plate in front. Now horizontally place a tan 1x2 jumper plate in front.

Step 60

Place a green 1x1 round flower plate in front of the 1x2 slope tile from step 58. Then place 1 to the left of the 1x2 slope tile from step 59. Place 1 in the back right corner of the 2x2 brick that is in the back right corner. Now place another 1 on the 3rd stud from the back and 9th stud from the right. Then place another 1 on the 3rd stud from the front and 6th stud from the left.

Step 61

Place a teal 2x2 slope brick in the back right corner on top of the 2x2 bricks and to the left of the 1x1 round flower plate so it slopes to the front. Then place a teal 1x1 slope tile to the left of the back row of the 2x2 slope brick so it slopes to the left.

Group 12 - Treasure Chest

Step 62.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a brown 1x2 rounded plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top so the side studs face the front. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the left stud. Then horizontally place a tan 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs.

Step 62.2

Rotate your main build 180 degrees so it is horizontal and the key faces the back. Now horizontally place your part on the back stud row behind the 1x2 jumper plate that is on the left so the side stud faces the front.

Step 63

Place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the back row to the right of your previous part so there is a 1 column gap in between them and the leaves face the front right. Then place a green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves in the back right corner so the leaves face the front left. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of each of them.

Step 64

Rotate your build 180 degrees. Now let's make a part! Horizontally place a gold candelabra in front of you. Then horizontally place a silver fork on the middle stud. Now horizontally place your part on the back row in front of the 1x4 half-cylinder bricks so there is 1 column gap in between this and the diamond on the right.

Step 65

Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the back row to the left of the candelabra so there is a 1 column gap in between. Then horizontally place a transparent pink heart on top.

Step 66

Place a dark grey 1x1 minifigure statue on the back row to the left of the previous heart. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the left stud of the 2x2 slope brick that is in the back left corner.

Step 67

Place a white fish with black and yellow stripes behind the 1x1 round flower plate that is closest to the left of the plate with 6 tentacles in the middle of the build so there is a 1 row gap in between them. Make sure the fish faces the front!

Building Instructions (Bag 5, Book 1):

Group 13 - Treasure Chest

Step 68

Put your main build away for now while we build the treasure chest top! Horizontally place a teal 1x6 plate in front of you.

Step 69

Place a white 2x2 corner plate on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left so it overhangs to the back and looks like the braille letter j. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 70

Horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate underneath the overhang.

You will have 2 extra teal 1x6 plates. Save them for later.

Group 14 - Treasure Chest

Step 71.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a teal 1x6 plate from group 13 in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x6 plate on top so it overhangs 1 stud to the right. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

Step 71.2

Horizontally place the overhang of 1 part on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 72

Place a white 2x2 corner plate on the leftmost stud so it overhangs 1 column to the left and looks like the braille letter h. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 73

Vertically place the front 2 studs of a teal 1x10 plate underneath the leftmost overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 74

Horizontally place a white 2x10 plate in the front left corner so it overhangs 1 row to the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 75

Vertically place 3 white 1x2x2 panels, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column behind the 2x10 plate so the walls face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 76

Vertically place a white 1x2 brick with a hole in the back left corner. Then vertically place a white 1x1 slope tile with a 1x1 plate on top so it slopes to the back. Then place a white 1x1 short brick on top. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 77

Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick on the 2nd row from the front and 2 leftmost columns. Then horizontally place a tan 1x6 brick to the right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 78.1

Let's make a part! Place a light grey 2x2 plate with 2 side studs in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a tan 1x4 plate on the back row so it overhangs 2 columns to the left. Now place the back row of another 2x2 plate with 2 side studs underneath the overhang so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate on top so there is no overhang.

Step 78.2

Horizontally place your part on the front 2 rows in between the 1x6 bricks so the side studs face the front.

Step 79

Horizontally place 4 white 1x2 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, on the front left corner so they slope to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 80

Horizontally place 2 teal 1x10 plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the 2nd row from the front, behind the previous sloped curved bricks so there is no overhang.

Group 15 - Treasure Chest

Step 81

Let's make a part! Place a white 8x8 sloped curved brick in front of you so it slopes to the front and back. Then insert a black 2L pin into the front and back right-facing holes.

Step 82

Attach another white 8x8 sloped curved brick to the previous pins so it slopes to the front and back.

Step 83.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a white 2x8 sloped curved brick in front of you. Then insert a black 2L pin into the left and right front-facing holes. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

Step 83.2

Attach the pins of 1 part to the left-facing holes. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 84

Flip your build upside down so it is horizontal. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate on the 2nd row from the back and 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the front. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a white 1x2 rounded plate on the 2nd row from the back in the middle 2 columns so it is centered horizontally. Then repeat symmetrically to the front.

Step 85.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a mint blue 4x10 plate with a tile side and a sticker in front of you so the tile side faces up.

Step 85.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place stickers 1 and 2 on the mint blue 4x10 plate with a tile side. Stickers 1 and 2 have a bunch of different sea life. They have fish, snails, bubbles, clams, jellyfish, and a crab! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 85.3

Horizontally place your part in between the right column of the leftmost 1x2 rounded plates and left column of the middle 1x2 rounded plates.

Step 86.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a mint blue 4x10 plate with a tile side and a sticker in front of you so the tile side faces up.

Step 86.2

Skip this step if you have already placed your stickers! Ask a helper to place stickers 1 and 2 on the mint blue 4x10 plate with a tile side. Stickers 1 and 2 have a bunch of different sea life. They have fish, snails, bubbles, clams, jellyfish, and starfish! Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 86.3

Horizontally place your part in between the left column of the rightmost 1x2 rounded plates and right column of the middle 1x2 rounded plates.

Step 87

Vertically place a white 1x6 brick upside down on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 88

Flip your build over so it is upright and horizontal. Now horizontally place it on top of your previous build so it is centered.

Step 89

Horizontally place an orange 1x2 plate on the front row on top of the 1x4 set of studs so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved tile on top so it is centered horizontally.

Step 90

Bring back your main build and orient it so it is horizontal and the key faces the front. Now horizontally place your part on top so it is centered.

Step 91

Insert a brown 3L axle with a stop into the back left-facing hole of the 1x2 brick. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. This will allow you to open and close the top!

Step 92.1

Let's make a part! Place a pink 2x2 plate with a clam in front of you so the clam faces the back. Then horizontally place a white 1x4 sloped curved tile on the front row so it is centered horizontally. Then place a mint blue 1x1 quarter tile on the left stud so the curve faces the back left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 92.2

Horizontally place the front row of your part upright on the front-facing 1x4 set of studs so the clam faces up.

Step 93

Place a white 2x2 round plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Then place a light purple 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place another 2x2 round tile with a stud to the right so there are 2 free columns in between. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 94

Place 2 gold 1x1 clips, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the middle 2x2 round tile with a stud so the clip hands face the left and right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Step 95.1

Place a light orange flower on the leftmost and rightmost 2x2 round tiles with a stud.

Step 95.2

Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the front stud and 2nd column from the left. Then place another 1 on the back stud on the 4th column from the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 96

Horizontally attach the bar of a gold curved bar with a spiral to the front left clip so the curved bar faces the front and curves to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 97.1

Rotate your build 180 degrees so the heart-shaped key faces the back. Then ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the middle of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 2x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is a mint blue starfish. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 97.2

Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the middle of the leftmost side of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 97.3

Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the middle of the rightmost side of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 98.1

Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the middle of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 2x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is a mint blue starfish. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 98.2

Ask a helper to place sticker 10 on the middle of the rightmost side of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 98.3

Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the middle of the leftmost side of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 99.1

Rotate your build 180 degrees so the key faces the front. Then ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the middle of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 2x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is a mint blue clamshell. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 99.2

Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the front right corner of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 99.3

Ask a helper to place sticker 9 on the middle of the leftmost side of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 99.4

Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the front 2 rows of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 8x8 sloped curved brick so it sits to the right of the previous sticker. This sticker is a mint blue clamshell. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 99.5

Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the middle of the front-facing curve of the rightmost 8x8 sloped curved brick so it sits to the right of the previous sticker. This sticker is a mint blue starfish. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 100.1

Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the middle of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 2x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is a mint blue clamshell. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 100.2

Ask a helper to place sticker 8 on the front left corner of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 100.3

Ask a helper to place sticker 5 on the middle of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 8x8 sloped curved brick so it sits to the right of the previous sticker. This sticker is a mint blue starfish. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 100.4

Ask a helper to place sticker 6 on the front 2 rows of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 8x8 sloped curved brick so it sits to the right of the previous sticker. This sticker is a mint blue clamshell. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Step 100.5

Ask a helper to place sticker 7 on the middle of the rightmost side of the front-facing curve of the leftmost 8x8 sloped curved brick. This sticker is bubbles and stars. Make sure the sticker is placed on correctly and is oriented on the build correctly, ask a sighted person to check.

Group 16 - Bracelet

Step 101

Put your build away now while we make a bracelet! Horizontally place a purple bracelet band in front of you so the 5 holes are on the right.

Step 102.1

Place a mint blue 1x1 quarter tile on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left corner. Then repeat again to the back. Now place 1 on the front row to the right so the curve faces the back right. Then repeat again to the back. Now repeat all parts symmetrically to the 2 rightmost columns.

Group 17 - Bracelet

Step 102.2

Place a transparent light blue 1x1 round tile on the back row on the leftmost stud. Then place a teal 1x1 quarter tile in front so the curve faces the front left. Then place a teal 1x1 quarter tile on the front row to the right so the curve faces the back right. Then place a teal 1x1 quarter tile behind it so the curve faces the front left. Then place a teal 1x1 quarter tile on the back row to the right so the curve faces the back right. Then place a transparent light blue 1x1 round tile in front. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Group 18 - Bracelet

Step 102.3

Place a pink 1x1 quarter tile on the back row on the leftmost stud so the curve faces the front left. Then place another 1 to the right so the curve faces the back right. Then repeat symmetrically to the front right corner.

Group 19 - Bracelet

Step 102.4

Place a light orange 1x1 quarter tile on the front row on the leftmost stud so the curve faces the backleft. Then place another 1 to the right so the curve faces the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back right corner.

Step 102.5

Now you can make the band into a bracelet and put it around your wrist!

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
