

43234 Elsa Frozen Treats

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Captivate Disney fans and kids aged 5 and up with this LEGO® I Disney Frozen Elsa's Frozen Treats (43234) building toy set. The box contains a buildable ice cream cart with an ice cream maker, 2 ice cream cones, 2 ice pops, and other story starters. It includes an Elsa LEGO I Disney mini-doll figure and a Snowgie LEGO I Disney figure to get the role-play started, plus 2 collectible rings with interchangeable decorations.

Elsa and the Snowgie – The buildable set includes an ice-cream cart, an Elsa LEGO® I Disney mini-doll figure, a Snowgie LEGO I Disney figure, and 2 collectible rings with interchangeable decorations.

Ice-cream cart – Kids can push the colorful ice-cream cart around, set up the ice cream cones, and role-play scenes where Elsa and the Snowgie deliver frosty treats to the market.

Dimensions – The 82-piece building set features an ice-cream cart buildable toy that measures over 4.5 in. (11 cm) high, 3.5 in. (9 cm) long, and 1.5 in. (4 cm) wide.

The front of the box shows the frozen treat cart in the back equipped with chocolate and strawberry ice cream, a cool globe, and a little snowman figure! In the front, Elsa is holding up a popsicle!

The build is 82 pieces in total and is for ages 5+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for Elsa and her frozen treat cart.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.

- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43234>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 1 bag labeled 1, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Bag 1 - Elsa and Frozen Treat Cart

Group 1 - Pages 5.

Group 2 - Page 6.

Group 3 - Page 7.

Group 4 - Steps 1-13.

Group 5 - Steps 14-15 and 4 dark blue 1x1 plates with an angled sloped part from Step 16.

Group 6 - Rest of Step 16, Step 17, and 1 pink 1x2 tile from Step 18.

Group 7 - Rest of Step 18, and Steps 19-23.

Group 8 - Steps 24-37.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Elsa and Snowman

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 teal dress, 1 light tan torso printed with a dark teal and teal sleeveless top with teal and pink dots, 1 light tan head printed with light blue eyes and pink lips, 1 light yellow hair, 1 light grey spoon, 1 white 1x1 dome with a stud, and 1 white 1x1 sphere printed with 2 black dots for eyes and a light blue open mouth with buckteeth at the top. Assemble your minifigure then put the spoon in her hand! Now place your dome in front of you and put the sphere on top to make a snowman! Now put them aside while we build rings!

Group 2 - Ring 1

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 purple ring with a stud on top and 1 light aqua 2x2 round tile printed with snowflakes and a side view of Elsa in teal! Put the tile on top of the ring so it is centered, then put it aside!

Group 3 - Ring 2

Sub-build 3. Locate 1 purple ring with a stud on top and 1 light aqua 2x2 round tile printed with snowflakes and a white snowman face! Put the tile on top of the ring so it is centered, then put it aside!

Group 4 - Frozen Treats Cart

Step 1

Horizontally place a white 4x10 plate in front of you.

Step 2

Vertically place a light aqua 1x4 plate on the leftmost column of the plate.

Step 3

Vertically place a black 1x4 plate with 2 pins vertically on top of the previous 1x4 plate.

Step 4.1

Vertically place a light aqua 1x4 plate on top of the 1x4 plate with 2 pins.

Step 4.2

Vertically place a teal 1x4 brick to the right of the previous plate.

Step 5

Vertically place a teal 2x4 brick on the 2 leftmost columns of the build so it sits on the previously placed pieces.

Step 6

Vertically place a tall teal 1x2 brick to the right of the back 2 rows of the 2x4 brick.

Step 7.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tall teal 2x3 cabinet in front of you.

Step 7.2

Horizontally insert a white 2x3 drawer into the front top row of the cabinet.

Step 7.3

Now horizontally place the cabinet to the right of the previously placed tall 1x2 brick so the inside faces the front.

Step 8.1

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a tall teal 2x3 cabinet in front of you so the inside faces the front.

Step 8.2

Horizontally insert a transparent teal 2x3 window into the front of the cabinet so it opens to the right.

Step 8.3

Horizontally place it to the right of the previous cabinet.

Step 9

Open the right cabinet and insert 2 transparent blue popsicles, then close it up so they don't melt!

Step 10

Vertically place a teal 1x4 brick to the right of the cabinet so it sits on the rightmost column of the 4x10 plate.

Step 11

Vertically place a light aqua 1x4 plate on top of the previous brick.

Step 12

Vertically place 2 white 1x2 plates with bars on top of the previous plate so the bars overhang to the right.

Step 13

Vertically place a light aqua 1x4 plate on top of the previous plates.

Group 5 - Frozen Treat Cart

Step 14.1

Vertically place a 1x2 plate with a bar on the front right corner of the 2x4 brick that is on the 2 leftmost columns so the bar overhangs to the right.

Step 14.2

Vertically place a purple 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous plate with a bar so there is no overhang.

Step 15

Horizontally place a light aqua 1x4 plate behind the jumper plate so the leftmost column of the 1x4 plate aligns with it. Then horizontally place another light aqua 1x4 plate to the right.

You will have 4 extra dark blue 1x1 plates with an angled sloped part. Save them for later.

Group 6 - Frozen Treat Cart

Step 16.1

Rotate your build 180 degrees. Place a light aqua 1x1 plate with a vertical tooth in front of the rightmost column of the 2 previously placed 1x4 plates so the tooth faces the front. Then place 3 more to the left so there is a 1 stud gap in between them all.

Step 16.2

Place 4 dark blue 1x1 plates with a vertical tooth from group 5 in front of the leftmost column of the 1x4 plates and in between the previously placed 1x1 plates so the teeth face the front.

Step 17.1

Place a light aqua 2x2 brick on top of the 2 rightmost columns of the 1x4 plates and 2 rightmost 1x1 plates with a vertical tooth. Then vertically place 2 purple 1x2 jumper plates to the left of the 2x2 brick.

You will have 1 extra 1x2 pink tile. Save it for later.

Group 7 - Frozen Treat Cart

Step 18.1

Horizontally place a brown 1x2 tile to the left of the jumper plate so it sits on the 1x4 plate. Then horizontally place a pink 1x2 tile from group 6 to the left.

Step 19

Horizontally place 2 transparent light blue 1x2 panels with a long wall in front of the previously placed tiles so the wall faces the front.

Step 20

Place a purple 2x2 jumper plate on top of the 2x2 brick that is on the right.

Step 21

Place a light aqua head-shaped part with a small teal print of Elsa's castle on top of the 2x2 jumper plate so the print faces the front. Ask a sighted person to make sure it is correct!

Step 22

Place a transparent sphere with a hole on top of the head to make a snow globe!

Step 23

Place a brown 1x1 ice cream top on top of a tan ice cream cone, then place it to the left of the snow globe on the right jumper plate.

Group 8 - Frozen Treat Cart

Step 24

Place a pink 1x1 ice cream top on top of a tan ice cream cone, then place it to the left of the previously placed ice cream cone.

Step 25

Vertically place 2 dark blue 1x4 window frames on the leftmost and rightmost columns of the build.

Step 26

Put your build aside while we make the roof now! Horizontally place a white 4x10 plate in front of you.

Step 27.1

Place a purple 1x1 round flower plate in the back left and back right corners of the plate.

Step 27.2

Horizontally place 2 transparent light aqua 1x4 tiles in between the flower plates.

Step 28

Place 5 tall light aqua 2x2 slope bricks in front of the previously placed tiles and 1x1 plates so they slope to the front.

Step 29

Horizontally place a light aqua 1x2 slope tile in the front left corner of the 4x10 plate so it slopes to the back. Then repeat symmetrically for the right.

Step 30.1

Horizontally place a dark blue 1x2 brick with 2 side studs in the center of the front row so the side studs face the front.

Step 30.2

Vertically place a 1x1 brick attached to a scroll with a stud to the left and right of the 1x2 brick with side studs so the scrolls face outwards to the left and right.

Step 31

Horizontally place a purple 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the previous bricks in the center of the front row.

Step 32.1

Place a purple 1x1 round flower plate in the leftmost and rightmost columns of the 2x2 slope bricks.

Step 32.2

Horizontally place 2 transparent light aqua 1x4 tiles between the 2 previously placed flower plates.

Step 33

Bring back your build so it is horizontal and the vertical teeth of the 1x1 plates face the front. Now horizontally place your roof on top of the build so the 2 side studs face the front.

Step 34

Place a transparent light aqua arrow tip on top of each of the flower plates that are on top of the slope bricks so the arrowheads are horizontal.

Step 35

Horizontally place a teal 2x4 rounded tile printed with vanilla and strawberry ice cream cones and snowflakes on the sides upright on the 2 front-facing side studs. Make sure the 2 side studs attach to the top 2 center anti-studs of the 2x4 tile. Ask a sighted person to make sure it is oriented correctly!

Step 36

Attach 2 light aqua wheels to the pins that are in the front right and back right of the build. Make sure the dots on the wheels face outwards!

Step 37

Vertically place a white 1x4 arch brick underneath the leftmost column of the build.
