Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: <https://bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers>. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.

- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same

thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, els and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/43298>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

The box folds down into a mat, the mat features a top down view of a few snowy lit up houses surrounding a christmas tree with a bunch of presents at its base!

The windows that we'll be opening are arranged in 4 rows of six windows. No grouping instructions are provided, since each build is very small.

We don't want to spoil each day's surprise for you, so we'll put lots of ***s between each day. ,

The box should be oriented with the fold-out mat on the table. The windows themselves are decorated with a large snowy mountainside, snowy pine trees, and a huge castle in the middle. The foldout mat is decorated with a pathway with different colored squares! You can use the spinner to decide which square to go to!

Let's get to building!

Day 1: (2nd row from the bottom of the leftmost column.)

Step 1

Locate 1 light tan body printed with a light blue dress with white stripes, 1 light tan head printed with light blue eyes, nose, eyelashes, and pink lips, 1 blonde hair printed with a light blue headband, and 1 gold crown. Assemble your minifigure then place the crown on top of her head!

Step 2

Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Place a pink 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made Elsa!

Day 2: (2nd row from the top of the 3rd column from the left.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a pink 2x3 plate with a round side and a pinhole in front of you so the round side faces the right. Then vertically place a white 1x2 tile printed with piano keys on the leftmost column so the white keys are in the back.

Step 2

Place a dark pink 2x2 round plate to the right of the ppp. Now place a pink 2x2 tile with a round side on top of the ppp so the round side faces the right.

Step 3

Place a gold 1x1 round plate underneath the front left corner. Then place another 1 to the right of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Today, we made a piano!

Day 3: (Top right corner.)

Step 1

Vertically place a light blue 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a silver skate underneath the front right corner so the curved part faces the front and it overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 2

Place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows. Then horizontally place a light blue 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp.

Step 3

Place a light brown mouse printed with a yellow shirt and red nose on the 1x2 jumper plate so he faces the front. Then horizontally place a brown pair of reindeer antlers on top of his head so it points to the top left and top right.

Step 4

Let's make a part! Let's make a tree! Place a brown 1x1 round tile with an upright bar in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 flower plate upside down on the ppp so the anti-stud faces up. Now place a light green 1x1 ice cream cone upside down on top of the ppp so the bar faces up.

Today, we made Gus the mouse riding a sled!

Day 4: (2nd column from the left of the top row.)

Step 1

Horizontally place 2 light blue 1x4 plates, 1 in front of the other, in front of you.

Step 2

Vertically place a light brown 1x2 rounded plate underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Place a pink 2x2 round tile with a stud on the 2 leftmost columns. Then place a white 1x1 tea cup on top of the ppp so the handle faces the left.

Step 4

Place a pink 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then place 4 tan 1x1 round tiles printed with a white cookie and red and green sprinkles, 1 next to the other, on top of the ppp.

Today, we made a table with milk and cookies!

Day 5: (3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the top.)

Note that today, there are some pieces that are the same but different color!

Step 1

Place a white 2x2 plate with a pin underneath in front of you so the pin faces down.

Step 2

Horizontally place a black 1x2x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with side studs on 3 sides on the front row so the 2x2 side studs face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back using a white one.

Step 3

Place a white 2x2 dome brick on top. Then place a lime green 2x2 tile upright on the front-facing side studs. Now place a pink 2x2 tile upright on the back-facing side studs.

Step 4

Place a yellow 2x2 tile upright on the left-facing side studs. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile upright on the right-facing side studs.

Today, we made a spinner!

Day 6: (3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a light blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light brown 1x2 rounded plate underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a light brown 2x2 brick printed with a brown door, windows, and white frosting coming from the top on top of the 2x4 plate so it is centered horizontally and the print faces the front. Then place a white 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the ppp so the studs are in the back.

Step 3

Place a light brown 1x1 round brick on the back left corner. Then place a white 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Horizontally place a light brown 1x2 brick with a side stud on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the side stud faces the front.

Step 5

Place a white 1x1 swirl on the left column of the ppp. Then place a light brown 1x1 round brick to the right of the ppp. Now place a white 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp.

Step 6

Place a white 1x1 plate with a tooth upright on the front-facing side stud so the tooth faces up. Now place a light brown 1x1 round tile printed with a pink donut upright on the ppp.

Today, we made a gingerbread castle!

Day 7: (Bottom left corner.)

Step 1

Locate 1 light tan body printed with a light green dress and a blue apron with a yellow bottom half and pink flowers, 1 light tan head printed with dark red eyes, nose, lips, and eyelashes, and 1 black hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you.

Step 2

Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Place a light yellow 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a teal 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made Mulan!

Day 8: (2nd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Place a brown 3x3 cross-shape plate in front of you. Then place a transparent orange 1x1 round plate on top so it is centered. Now place a transparent orange candle flame on top of the ppp.

Step 2

Let's make a part! Let's make a marshmallow on a stick! Place a white 1x1 round plate on top of a brown 3L bar so the stud faces up.

Today, we made a campfire with a marshmallow!

Day 9: (3rd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Vertically place a light yellow 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a silver skate underneath the front right corner so the curved part faces the front and it overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 2

Place a teal 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows. Then horizontally place a light yellow 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp.

Step 3

Place a red dragon printed with 2 eyes on the 1x2 jumper plate so he faces the front.

Step 4

Let's make a part! Let's make a candle! Place a short red 1x1 brick in front of you. Then place a white candle stick on top of the ppp. Now place a transparent orange candle flame on top of the ppp.

Today, we made Musha the dragon riding a sled!

Day 10: (Top left corner.)

Step 1

Place a light blue 2x2 round brick in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Now place a gold 1x1 star on top of the ppp.

Step 2

Let's make a part! Let's make another present! Place a light orange 2x2 box in front of you. Then place a transparent aqua 1x1 gem tile inside the box. Now place a white and red 1x1 Santa hat inside the box.

Step 3

Place a light orange 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Now place a light yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made 2 presents!

Day 11: (2nd column from the left of the 2nd row from the top.)

Step 1

Vertically place a lime green 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a silver skate underneath the front right corner so the curved part faces the front and it overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 2

Place a red 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp.

Step 3

Place a white pig printed with 2 eyes, pink nose, and light grey spots on the 1x2 jumper plate so it faces the front. Now horizontally place a red bow tie on top of his head so the angled parts face the back.

Step 4

Let's make a part! Let's make a tree! Place a tan 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Step 5

Place a brown 4L bar on top of the ppp. Now place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top of the bar so the stud faces up and the leaves face the right.

Today, we made Pua the pig riding a sled!

Day 12: (2nd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Place a light brown 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then vertically place a green 1x2x1 $\frac{2}{3}$ brick with side studs on 3 sides on the left column so the 2x2 side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round plate upright on the bottom left front-facing side stud. Then place a light green 1x1 slope tile upright above the ppp so it slopes up. Now place a light green 1x1 slope tile

upright on the bottom right front-facing side studs so it slopes up. Then place a pink 1x1 dome tile upright above the ppp.

Step 3

Repeat the previous step on the right-facing, back-facing, and left-facing side.

Step 4

Place a green 2x2 tile with a stud on top. Then place a dark green 1x1 brick with a side stud on each side on top of the ppp.

Step 5

Place a transparent yellow 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 6

Place a light green 1x1 slope tile upright on the left-facing side stud so it slopes up. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 7

Place a light green 1x1 cone brick on top. Then insert the bar of a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar into the stud of the ppp so the stud faces the front. Now place a gold 1x1 star upright on the front-facing side stud of the ppp.

Today, we made a Christmas tree!

Day 13: (3rd column from the right of the top row.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a light blue 2x6 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a white 1x2 grill tile on the leftmost column. Now place a white 2x2 tile with a raised circle in the middle to the right of the ppp.

Step 2

Vertically place a white 1x2 grill tile to the right of the ppp. Then vertically place another 1 to the right of the ppp. Now place a white 2x2 sloped curved tile to the right of the ppp so it slopes and overhangs to the right.

Step 3

Let's make a part! Place a light blue 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a light blue 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the ppp so it is centered. Now place a transparent aqua 1x1 pyramid tile on top of the ppp.

Step 4

Horizontally place a white 1x2 jumper plate with a round side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the round side faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place 1 on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the round side faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 5

Now place your part on top of the 2x2 tile with a raised circle so it is centered on it and can freely spin!

Today, we made a carousel!

Day 14: (Leftmost column of the 2nd row from the top.)

Step 1

Locate 1 light brown body printed with a dark tan dress printed with red stripes, 1 light brown head printed with dark red eyes, nose, lips, and eyelashes, and 1 brown hair. Assemble your minifigure then place her in front of you.

Step 2

Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Horizontally place a red 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp. Now place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made Moana!

Day 15: (Rightmost column of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a magenta 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place a transparent orange 1x1 slope tile on the 2nd column from the left of the back row so it slopes to the left. Then place another 1 to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

Step 2

Horizontally place a tan 1x4x2 arch brick on the back row so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x1 plate with a 1x1 slope tile on the 2 leftmost columns of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Horizontally place a nougat 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on top of the 2 ppp so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a light brown 1x2 masonry brick on top of the ppp so the brick grooves face the front.

Step 4

Place a green 2x2 round plate upright on the front-facing side studs so it overhangs 1 row to the bottom. Now place a red 1x1 tile with a round side upright on the bottom left corner of the ppp so the round side faces the top right. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Today, we made a fireplace!

Day 16: (3rd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Locate 1 light tan body printed with a pink dress printed with a white and light pink stripes, 1 light tan head printed with light blue eyes, red lips, nose, and eyelashes, and 1 red hair. Assemble your minifigure then put her in front of you.

Step 2

Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Horizontally place a pink 1x2 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made Ariel!

Day 17: (2nd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Place a light blue 2x2 round tile with a stud in front of you. Then place a pink 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top of the ppp. Now place a gold clip with a barholder on top of the ppp so the clip is on top and the clip hands face the front and back.

Step 2

Horizontally attach the bar of a gold 1x2 plate with a bar to the top-facing clip so it is centered horizontally and the studs face the front. Now place a white 2x2 tile printed with gold lines and black music notes upright on the front-facing side studs so 1 row overhangs to the top.

Step 3

Place a white wand next to your stand!

Today, we made a stand with sheet music!

Day 18: (3rd column from the left of the top row.)

Step 1

Vertically place a teal 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a silver skate underneath the front right corner so the curved part faces the front and it overhangs to the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Step 2

Place a pink 2x2 tile with a stud on the back 2 rows. Then horizontally place a teal 1x2 jumper plate in front of the ppp.

Step 3

Place a red crab with 2 claws printed with 2 eyes on the 1x2 jumper plate so the claws face the front.

Step 4

Let's make a part! Let's make a clam shell with a gem! Place a white clam shell in front of you so the stud is in the front. Now place a transparent aqua 1x1 gem tile on top of the ppp.

Today, we made Sebastian the crab riding a sled!

Day 19: (2nd column from the left of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a red 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a gold 1x1 skate underneath the leftmost column so the rounded part faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a gold 1x1 round plate on the leftmost column. Then place a dark green 1x1 round tile with an upright bar upside down on the ppp so the anti-stud faces up.

Step 3

Place a red 1x1 half cylinder brick to the right of the ppp so it slopes to the front and back.

Step 4

Place a red 1x1 brick with a bar to the right of the ppp so the bar faces the right. Then place a dark green 1x1 tile on top of the ppp.

Step 5

Let's make a part! Let's make the other half of the train! Horizontally place a red 1x3 plate in front of you. Then place a gold 1x1 skate underneath the leftmost column so the rounded part faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 6

Place a short blue 1x1 brick on the rightmost column. Then place a light blue 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Step 7

Place a teal 1x1 plate to the left of the ppp. Then place a light yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Step 8

Place a gold 1x1 plate with a clip to the left of the ppp so the clip faces the left. Then place a short dark pink 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Step 9

Attach the left-facing clip of your part to the right-facing bar of your previous part!

Today, we made a toy train!

Day 20: (2nd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Vertically place a light blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then place 2 white 2x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on top so they slope and overhang 1 column to the right.

Step 2

Horizontally place 2 white 2x4 slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top so they overhang 3 columns to the left and slope to the right.

Step 3

Vertically place a light blue 2x4 plate underneath the 2nd and 3rd columns from the left. Now vertically place a light blue 1x4 plate underneath the leftmost column.

Step 4

Place a brown 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on the back left corner. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate upside down on the ppp so the anti-stud faces up. Now place a light green 1x1 ice cream cone upside down on top of the ppp so the bar faces up. This is a tree!

Today, we made a snowy slope!

Day 21: (2nd column from the right of the top row.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Now vertically place a magenta 1x2 slope brick on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the front. Then place a light yellow 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

Step 2

Place a white 1x1 brick with a clip on the 2nd column from the right, on top of the 1x1 brick so the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the left. Now horizontally attach a gold 4L bar to the 2 front-facing clips so it is centered horizontally.

Step 3

Horizontally place a black 1x4 double sloped curved tile on the back row so it is centered horizontally.

Step 4

Attach a brown claw to the 4L bar so it is centered horizontally and the handle faces the front. Now attach the clip of a transparent 1x1 round plate with a clip underneath to the end of the handle so the stud faces up. Then place a gold 2x2 dish on top of the ppp.

Step 5

Push the 2x2 dish down so it hangs down and the stud faces the front.

Step 6

Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with an upright bar on the rightmost column so the bar faces the right.

Step 7

Place a green 1x1 round plate on the front left corner so the leaves face the front left. Then place a light yellow 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made a gong!

Day 22: (3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Place a tan 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a clip on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the clip faces the left. Then vertically place a pink 1x2 rounded plate on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on the 2nd row from the front so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a white 1x2 plate with an upright bar in front of the ppp so the bar faces the front.

Step 3

Place a gold barholder with a clip on top of the bar of the ppp so the clip is on top and the clip hands face the left and right. Now attach a magenta microphone to the clip so the ball part faces the back.

Step 4

Stack 2 white 1x1 cone bricks on the front row of the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a pink 1x2 rounded plate on top of the previous cone bricks so it is centered vertically. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Step 5

Horizontally place 2 light tan 1x4 arch bricks, 1 in front of the other, on top of the 2 previous 1x2 rounded plates. Now horizontally place a tan 2x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 ppp.

Today, we made an arch with a microphone!

Day 23: (Rightmost column of the 2nd row from the top.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a tan 2x6 plate in front of you. Now vertically place a lime green 1x2 jumper plate on the 2nd column from the right so it slopes to the front. Then place a tan 1x1 round brick on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the left.

Step 2

Place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on the 2nd column from the left, on top of the 1x1 round flower plate. Then place a light brown 1x1 round brick on top of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on the 2nd column from the left, on top of the 1x1 round brick so the leaves face the front left. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Now horizontally place a light brown 1x4 double sloped curved tile on top of the 2 previous 1x1 round flower plates.

Step 4

Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with an upright bar on the leftmost column so the bar faces the left.

Step 5

Place a green 1x1 round plate on the front right corner so the leaves face the front right. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Today, we made a drum!

Day 24: (Bottom right corner.)

Step 1

Place a tan 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x2 curved brick on the front left corner so the curve faces the front left. Then place a white 1x1 brick on the leftmost column behind the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a white 1x1 brick on the back stud of the leftmost column. Then place a gold 1x1 round flower plate in front of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Horizontally place a white 1x4 plate on the 2nd row from the back, on top of the 1x1 bricks. Then place a teal 1x1 cone brick on the leftmost column of the ppp. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Horizontally place a white 1x2 brick with 2 side studs in between the 2 ppp so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top of the ppp. Now place a teal 1x1 cone brick on top of the ppp. Now horizontally place a pink flag on top of the ppp so it faces the right.

Step 5

Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the left front-facing side stud of the previous 1x2 brick with 2 side studs so the leaves face the bottom left. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate upright on the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Today, we are making a rooftop of a castle!
