

71798 Nya and Arin's Baby Dragon Battle

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Nya and Arin's Baby Dragon Battle (71798) playset is the ideal way for kids aged 4+ to learn how to build as they recreate amazing scenes from the NINJAGO® Dragons Rising TV series. The action-packed building set features 2 dragons, a jet plane and a hideout cave with energy crystals, plus 3 minifigures to inspire countless hours of gripping role play.

3 minifigures – Includes Nya with a sword and a chicken bone for Baby Riyu, Arin with a sword and grappling hook, and the Imperium Claw General with a sword.

2 dragons – The energy dragon has a posable head, wings, and tail, and a saddle for a minifigure, while Baby Riyu comes with a hideout cave with energy crystals.

On the go – The energy dragon measures over 5 in. (13 cm) high, 10 in. (25 cm) long, and 9 in. (23 cm) wide to let kids enjoy fun with the playset wherever they go.

The front of the box shows Nya riding the dragon in the back left fighting an Imperium Claw General that is on an aircraft! On the cliff, Arin and a baby dragon are also trying to take the general down!

The back of the box shows 3 minifigures, a baby dragon, 3 swords, a grappling hook, 1 chicken leg on a stick, a crystal temple, an aircraft, cover, and a baby dragon.

The top of the box shows all the minifigures fighting each other!

The build is 157 pieces in total and is for ages 4+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for a minifigure, hideout, and a fireplace.

Bag 2 includes the pieces for a minifigure, cover, and an aircraft.

Bag 3 includes the pieces for a minifigure and dragon.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.

- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/71798>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 3 bags labeled 1, 2, and 3, 3 sets of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

The steps in this set correspond to page numbers.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Nya

Steps 6 to 7

Locate 1 blue pair of legs printed with dark grey stripes and a dark red karate belt, 1 blue torso printed with dark grey stripes, 1 blue mask with a sword holder, 1 yellow head printed with a blue and dark grey mask, 1 blue helmet, and 1 gold katana. Assemble your minifigure and make sure the sword holder is in the back. Also, make sure the gap of the helmet faces the front! Then insert the sword into the holder!

Steps 8 to 9

Attach a brown bar holder with a clip to a brown bar. Then attach a light brown chicken leg to the clip. Now attach the bar to your minifigure's hand! Put everything away while we make a fireplace!

Group 2 - Fireplace

Steps 10 to 11

Place a dark grey 4x4 round plate in front of you. Then place a dark brown 2x2 round ridged brick on top so it is centered. Then place a brown 2x2 round tile with a stud on top. Now place a transparent orange flame on top so the flat side faces front and back. Put this away now while we make the temple!

Group 3 - Hideout

Steps 12 to 13

Horizontally place a green 4x8 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a dark green 1x2x2 slope brick in the back left corner so it slopes to the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 14 to 15

Place a light green 1x1 round brick with 3 leaves on the leftmost column in front of the previous slope brick so the leaves face the front left. Then vertically place a dark green 1x2x2 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Steps 16 to 17

Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 brick on the left 2 slope bricks. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 18 to 19

Horizontally place 2 dark grey 1x6 archways, 1 in front of the other, on top of the previous 1x2 bricks.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place 2 gold 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on the back 1x6 archway so together they are centered horizontally. Then vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with a bar on the long side on the leftmost column of the 1x6 archways so the bar faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place a dark blue 1x6 plate on top of the previous jumper plates and 1x2 plates with a bar so there is no overhang. Then horizontally place 2 light grey 1x3 sloped curved bricks, 1 to the right of the other, in front so they slope inwards.

Group 4 - Hideout

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place a dark blue 1x2 brick on top of the previous 1x6 plate so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a dark blue 1x3 slope brick to the left and right so they slope to the left and right.

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place 2 gold 1x2 plates with a bar on the long side, 1 to the right of the other, on top of the previous bricks so together they are centered horizontally and the bars face the front.

Steps 28 to 29

Horizontally place a gold 1x2 jumper plate on top of the previous 1x2 plates with bars so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent light blue crystal on top.

Steps 30 to 31

Locate a baby blue dragon and place it on the front row and 2nd row from the back underneath the arches so it faces the front.

Step 32

Put everything away while we build a minifigure!

Building Instructions (Bag 2, Book 2):

Group 5 - Imperium Claw General

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 black pair of legs with gold armor, 1 black torso printed with gold armor and red eyes, 1 black shoulder armor, 1 gold head printed with 4 eyes, 1 black helmet, and 1 sword. Assemble your minifigure then put the sword in his hand. Make sure the eyehole and horns of the helmet face the front! Now put him aside while we make his aircraft!

Group 6 - Aircraft

Steps 6 to 7

Horizontally place a dark grey 4x10 angled vehicle base in front of you. Then vertically place a dark red 1x2 plate on the leftmost column.

Steps 8 to 9

Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 tile with an overhead bar on the rightmost column of the 2x4 gap so the bar faces the right. Then place a short tan 2x2 ridged brick to the left. Now vertically place an orange 1x2 brick to the left.

Steps 10 to 11

Vertically place a black 3x4 sloped curved brick printed with gold armor and 2 red eyes on the 3 leftmost columns so the short end faces the left. There should be no overhang.

Steps 12 to 13

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 slope tile printed with speedometers to the right of the previous 3x4 sloped curved brick so it is centered vertically and slopes to the right. Place a red 2x2 plate on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and overhangs 1 column to the right. Then place 1 to the left so it is centered vertically.

Steps 14 to 15

Vertically place a black 2x2 plate with angled sides on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and the short end faces the right.

Steps 16 to 17

Horizontally place a dark red 1x2 plate on the front row to the left of the angled part of the previous 2x2 plate. It should sit on 1 stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 18 to 19

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with 2x4 side studs on the front row to the left of the previous 1x2 plate so the side studs face the front. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x2 sloped curved tile on the left stud of the previous 1x2 plate with side studs so it slopes to the left. It should attach to 2 studs! Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Steps 20 to 21

Horizontally place a gold 1x2 grill tile on the front row to the right of the previous 1x2 sloped curved tile. Then place a dark grey 2x2 slope brick on the front 2 rows to the right so it slopes to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Steps 22 to 23

Horizontally place a black 2x4 slope brick on the 2 rightmost columns so it is centered vertically and it slopes and overhangs 2 columns to the right. Now horizontally place a black 2x3 plate on top so there is no overhang.

Steps 24 to 25

Horizontally place the 1x2 plate part of a light grey 1x2 brick with a hole on the front right corner of the previous 2x3 plate so the 1x2 brick part overhangs to the front. Then horizontally place a dark red 1x2 sloped curved tile on the back left stud of your piece so it slopes to the left onto the 2x3 plate. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Steps 26 to 27

Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 tile with an overhead bar to the right of the 2 previous 1x2 sloped curved tiles so the bar is on the right. Then horizontally place a gold 1x2 grill tile in front and behind so there is no overhang.

Steps 28 to 29

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey wheel with a middle part that has a rounded side in front of you so the rounded side faces down. Now orient it so the side holes face the front and back. Then insert a black 2L pin into the front-facing hole. Now place a light grey rotor into the top-facing hole. Now repeat again so you have 2 parts in total.

Steps 30 to 31

Attach the pin of 1 part to the front-facing hole of the 1x2 brick so the rotor faces the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 32 to 33

Horizontally place a black 2x3 tile with a tail on the left 3 columns of the front-facing 2x4 set of studs so the tail faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now put your aircraft away while we make cover!

Group 7 - Cover

Steps 34 to 35

Place a green 6x6 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically. Now horizontally place a black 2x4 slope brick to the right so it slopes to the right.

Steps 36 to 37

Place a brown 2x2 tile with a stud on the front 2 rows on the 2nd and 3rd columns from the right. Then place a dark grey 2x2 slope brick to the left so it slopes to the front. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back.

Steps 38 to 39

Place a light green 1x1 plate with 3 leaves on the front 2x2 tile with a stud so the leaves face the front right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a brown 1x2 slope tile on top of the 2x4 slope brick so it is centered vertically and it slopes to the right.

Steps 40 to 41

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate with a slope tile on the front 2x2 slope brick so it slopes to the right. Now repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place a light grey 1x4 brick with a slot on the left stud of the previous plates so it is centered vertically.

Steps 42 to 43

Vertically place a black 1x4 tile with 2 studs on top of the previous 1x4 brick with a slot so there is no overhang. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 slope tile to the left so it is centered vertically and it slopes to the left.

Steps 44 to 45

Locate 2 gold 2x2 round tiles. You can shoot these through the slot of the 1x4 brick!

Step 46

Put your builds away while we make a minifigure!

Building Instructions (Bag 3, Book 3):

Group 8 - Arin

Steps 4 to 5

Locate 1 light orange pair of legs printed with a light grey karate belt, 1 light orange torso printed with an orange dragon, 1 light orange mask with a sword holder, 1 yellow head printed with scratch marks on his face, 1 light orange helmet with gold horns, 1 gold katana, and 1 black grappling hook. Make sure the round part of the sword holder faces the back so the helmet's gap faces the front! Assemble your minifigure, then put the sword into the holder, then attach the grappling hook to his hand!

Group 9 - Dragon

Steps 6 to 7

Horizontally place a dark grey 4x10 angled vehicle base in front of you. Then horizontally place a tan 2x4 brick in the 2x4 gap.

Steps 8 to 9

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the leftmost column so the socket faces the left. Now repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 10 to 11

Horizontally place a dark blue 4x6 sloped curved brick on the 6 rightmost columns so it slopes to the right and is centered vertically. Then place 2 dark blue 2x2 slope bricks, 1 in front of the other, to the left so they slope outwards to the front and back.

Steps 12 to 13

Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate on the leftmost column. Then vertically place a gold 2x4 angled sloped brick on the 2 leftmost columns so it slopes to the left and is centered vertically.

Steps 14 to 15

Place a dark grey ball attached to a bar and a pin into the right front-facing hole. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 16 to 17

Vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with 2 bars on the leftmost column so the bars face the right. Then place a dark blue 2x2 plate to the right. Then vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with 2 bars to the right so the bars face the left. Now vertically place a dark grey 1x2 tile with an overhead bar to the right so the bar is on the left.

Steps 18 to 19

Place a tan 2x2 tile with 2 studs on the 2 leftmost columns so the studs are on the left. Then place 1 more to the right so the studs are on the left.

Group 10 - Dragon

Steps 20 to 21

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 4x4 base with inverted sloped curved sides in front of you so the short end faces the right. Then vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate on the 2nd column from the left so it is centered vertically.

Steps 22 to 23

Vertically place a tan 1x2 brick with a hole on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then place a red 2x2 plate to the right. Now vertically place a red 1x2 jumper plate with a rounded side to the right so the rounded side faces the right.

Group 11 - Dragon

Steps 24 to 25

Insert a red pin with a ball into the left-facing hole. Then place a dark blue 2x2 plate on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically.

Steps 26 to 27

Horizontally place a dark blue and transparent yellow dragon head on top so it is centered vertically and the short end faces the right. Then place a gold 2x2 sloped curved brick with 2 studs on top so it slopes to the left.

Steps 28 to 29

Attach the left-facing ball of your part to the right-facing socket of your dragon body.

Group 12 - Dragon

Steps 30 to 31

Let's make a part! Place a dark blue 2x2 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a black 1x2 plate with a hinge on the left column so the hinge faces the left. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a ball on the right column so the ball faces the right. Now place a gold 2x2 sloped curved brick with 2 studs on top so the studs are on the right.

Steps 32 to 33

Attach the hinge connector of a transparent yellow 1x12 tail with 6 studs and extended angled sides to the left-facing hinge.

Steps 34 to 35

Attach the ball of your part to the left-facing socket of your main build.

Steps 36 to 37

Attach the pin of a dark blue leg with 3 toes to the front-facing hole so the toes face the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Steps 38 to 39

Place a black A-shaped plate in front of you so it looks like the letter A. The part where the ends of the 1x4 plates meet should face the back.

Steps 40 to 41

Vertically place a light grey 1x2 plate with a socket on the back right corner so the socket faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left so it faces the left.

Steps 42 to 43

Vertically place a dark blue 1x2 plate in front of each of the 1x2 plates with a socket.

Steps 44 to 45

Vertically place a light grey 1x3 tile with a hinge on the back 3 studs of the left column so the hinge faces the back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Steps 46 to 47

Attach the hinge connector of a transparent yellow 1x12 tail with 6 studs and extended angled sides to the left hinge so the tail faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now repeat the steps again so you have 2 parts in total.

Steps 48 to 49

Attach the socket of 1 part to the front-facing ball so the tails face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 50

Place your minifigure on top so he can ride the dragon!
