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Kids can recreate Star Wars: The Clone Wars scenes and play out their own thrilling missions with the 332nd Ahsoka's Clone Trooper Battle Pack (75359). It includes 4 LEGO® Star Wars™ minifigures – a new-for-August-2023 Clone Captain Vaughn LEGO minifigure with a special helmet and 3 332nd Clone Troopers, plus a blaster rifle, 3 blasters and 2 jetpack accessory elements to inspire imaginative play. A great gift idea for Star Wars: The Clone Wars fans aged 6 and up, this buildable toy playset also features a Clone Infantry Support Speeder vehicle with 2 stud shooters and seats for 2 LEGO minifigures, plus a stud-shooting laser cannon.

332nd Ahsoka's Clone Trooper Battle Pack (75359) – Youngsters can recreate Star Wars: The Clone Wars scenes and play out their own stories with this detailed LEGO® brick-built playset.

4 LEGO® Star Wars™ minifigures – Clone Captain Vaughn with a special helmet and 3 332nd Clone Troopers, plus a blaster rifle, 3 blasters, and 2 jetpack accessory elements.

Built for action play – The set includes a Clone Infantry Support Speeder, featuring seats for 2 LEGO® minifigures, clips for their blasters, 2 stud shooters, and a stud-shooting laser cannon.

Build and play – This brick-built Star Wars™ Clone Infantry Support Speeder vehicle measures over 2 in. (5 cm) high, 3.5 in. (9 cm) long and 3 in. (8 cm) wide.

The front of the box shows clone troopers walking and fighting shooting towards the enemy! One is riding a speeder vehicle equipped with cover and weapons to take on the enemies!

The build is 108 pieces in total and is for ages 6+.

Bag 1 includes the pieces for the clone troopers, a turret, and a vehicle.

Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back
- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the

table.

- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/75359>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

Sorting the pieces:

To begin a successful build, it helps to sort the pieces into groups, bags, or small containers. Have a friend or family member do this in advance following the instructions below. You will see that the pieces should be sorted according to the building steps in the kit. Doing this in advance makes locating the pieces for each step easier. See below on how to sort the pieces to correspond to the steps in this set. Number the containers using letters A-Z, numbers, or meaningful names. The parts will be sorted into one or a small number of steps in the instructions. Example: Steps 1-3 means collect all the parts used in steps 1,2 and 3, and put them in one container.

This LEGO set comes with 1 bag labeled 1, 1 set of instructions, and some loose pieces. Sort the pieces into groups or piles as described below. Note that where there are multiple colors of the same brick in a step, the colors will be split into 2 groups to make telling the difference easier for the builder! LEGO includes a few spare parts in case you lose something. Set these into their own group away from the rest, in case you need them later.

Let's get to building!

Building Instructions (Bag 1, Book 1):

Group 1 - Clone Troopers

Sub-build 1. Locate 1 white pair of legs printed with white and light blue armor, 1 white torso printed with armor and a blue triangle on his chest, 1 blue jetpack, 1 tan head printed with a mean face and scars on his cheeks, 1 white and orange helmet, and 1 black pistol blaster. Assemble your minifigure then put the blaster in his hand! Now repeat again so you have another identical trooper!

Group 2 - Clone Troopers

Sub-build 2. Locate 1 white pair of legs printed with white and light blue armor, 1 white torso printed with armor and a blue triangle on his chest, 1 tan head printed with a mean face and scars on his cheeks, and 1 white and orange helmet. Assemble your minifigure then repeat the steps so you end up with 2 identical figures. Now attach a orange visor to 1 of the minifigure's helmet, then attach a pistol blaster to his hand! Then attach a rifle blaster to the other minifigure's hand! Now put everything away while we build a turret!

Group 3 - Turret

Step 1

Place a black 2x2 round plate with 4 bars in front of you.

Step 2

Place a light grey 2x2 round tile with a hole on top so there is no overhang.

Step 3

Flip your part over so it sits on the bars. Then insert a dark grey 1L pin into the top-facing hole so the stud faces up.

Step 4

Locate 1 light grey stud shooter and 1 dark grey piece with an angled side and rounded side (the stud shooter's trigger). Insert the rounded side into the top of the stud shooter. Then insert the shooter's handle into the stud of the pin so the shooter faces the right.

Step 5

Locate 2 transparent light blue 1x1 round plates. This is ammo for the gun! Now put this away while we build the vehicle!

Group 4 - Vehicle

Step 1

Horizontally place a dark grey 1x5 plate in front of you.

Step 2

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate on the leftmost column so it overhangs to the front.

Step 3

Horizontally place a dark grey 1x5 plate underneath the overhang so it aligns with the previous 1x5 plate.

Step 4

Vertically place a dark grey 2x6 plate to the right of the 1x2 plate so it is centered vertically.

Step 5

Place a light grey 4x4 quarter plate underneath the front overhang so the curve faces the front right. Make sure it is aligned with the rightmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 6

Place a light grey 1x4 curved tile on the front 4x4 quarter plate so it aligns with the curve and there is no overhang. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 7

Horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 plate in between the curved tiles so it overhangs 1 column to the right.

Step 8

Flip your build upside down so it is vertical and the previous 2x3 plate faces the right. Vertically place a black 3x6 plate with a rounded side and a 1x2 gap on the 2nd column from the right so it is centered vertically and the curve faces the right.

Step 9

Horizontally place a black 2x8 plate in the 1x2 gap of the previous plate so it overhangs 5 columns to the left.

Step 10

Horizontally place a black 1x2 plate on the 2nd row from the front so it is aligned with the left side of the 4x4 quarter plate. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 11

Flip your build over so it is horizontal and the exposed studs of the 2x8 plate face the left. Place a dark grey 2x2 tile on the 3rd and 4th columns from the right so it is centered vertically. Then vertically place 2 dark grey 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the left of the other, to the left of the 2x2 tile so they are centered vertically.

Step 12

Place a black 2x2 chair on the 2x2 set of studs in front of the previous 2x2 tile and 1x2 jumper plate so the back of the chair faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 13

Place 2 dark grey 1x1 bricks with holes, 1 in front of the other, to the left of the 1x2 jumper plate so the holes face the front and back. Then insert a black 2L pin into the front and back-facing holes.

Step 14

Vertically place 2 dark grey 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the left of the other, to the left of the previous 1x1 bricks with holes so they are centered vertically.

Group 5 - Vehicle

Step 15

Vertically place a light grey 2x6 plate with a rounded side on the 2 leftmost columns so the rounded side faces the left and it is centered vertically.

Step 16

Place a light grey 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on the leftmost jumper plate so the side studs face the front and back. Then place a blue 1x1 brick to the right so it sits on the jumper plate.

Step 17

Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 jumper plate to the right of the previous 1x1 brick so there is no overhang. Then vertically place 2 dark grey 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the left of the other, on top of the 2x6 plate with a rounded side so they are centered vertically.

Step 18

Horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a clip and a stud on top of the 2 leftmost jumper plates so the clip faces the left.

Step 19

Place a light grey 1x1 round plate on the stud of the previous 1x2 plate with a clip for a stud. Then horizontally place a black 1x2 plate to the right so it sits on the 2 1x1 bricks.

Step 20

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 sloped curved tile on the previous 1x1 round plate and 1x2 plate so it slopes to the left. Then place a light grey 1x4 sloped curved brick to the right so it slopes to the right.

Group 6 - Vehicle

Step 21.1

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 3x3 plate with a missing corner in front of you so the missing corner faces the back right.

Step 21.2

Vertically place a blue 1x2 plate with a hole and a stud on the front left corner so the hole faces the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 round plate on the front row to the right of the hole.

Step 21.3

Place a light grey 3x3 sloped curved brick on the back 2 rows so it overhangs and slopes to the back right.

Step 21.4

Attach the left-facing hole of your part to the front-facing pin of the main build so the curved side face the left. Make sure the anti-studs face the right towards the chair.

Step 22.1

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 3x3 plate with a missing corner in front of you so the missing corner faces the back left.

Step 22.2

Vertically place a blue 1x2 plate with a hole for a stud on the front right corner so the hole faces the front. Then place a light grey 1x1 round plate on the front row to the left of the hole.

Step 22.3

Place a light grey 3x3 sloped curved brick on the back 2 rows so it overhangs and slopes to the back left.

Step 22.4

Attach the right-facing hole of your part to the back-facing pin of the main build so the curved side face the left. Make sure the anti-studs face the right towards the chair.

Step 23

Locate 1 light grey stud shooter and 1 dark grey piece with an angled side and rounded side. Insert the rounded side into the top of the stud shooter. Now attach the handle upright to the front-facing stud on the right so the gun faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Group 7 - Vehicle

Step 24

Let's make a part! Place a dark grey 4x4 round plate in front of you.

Step 25

Stack 2 light blue 2x2 round plates together so there is no overhang then place it in the center of the 4x4 round plate.

Step 26

Place a light grey 4x4 round plate with a 2x2 hole on top so it surrounds the 2x2 round plates.

Step 27

Horizontally place a blue 1x2 plate with a clip on the long side on the front row so it is centered horizontally and the clip faces the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back. Now vertically place another 1 on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the clip faces the left. Then vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with an upright 2x2 tile on the rightmost column so it is centered vertically and the antistuds of the 2x2 tile face the right.

Step 28

Place a light grey 4x4 round brick with a recessed center on top so it is centered.

Step 29

Place your part on its side so it sits on the 2x2 tile and the previous brick you placed faces the right. Now attach a black round disc with an axle hole to 1 end of a light grey 3L axle, then insert the axle into the right-facing hole of the brick with a recessed center so the axle goes all the way in and the disc faces the right.

Step 30

Attach a light grey 4x4 dish to the left-facing axle so the stud faces the left.

Step 31

Place a dark grey 2x2 dish upright onto the left-facing stud of the previous dish.

Step 32

Make sure the stud shooters face the right. Then place your part on the 2 leftmost columns so it is centered vertically and the previous 2x2 dish faces the left.

Group 8 - Vehicle

Step 33

Let's make a part! Horizontally place a dark grey 1x5 plate in front of you.

Step 34

Place a light grey 1x1 tile on top so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a clip on the short side to the right so the clip faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the left.

Group 9 - Vehicle

Step 35

Place a blue 1x1 tile on the rightmost stud. Then horizontally place a blue 1x4 tile to the left.

Group 10 - Vehicle

Step 36

Attach the bar of a dark grey 1x1 plate with 2 bars to the left-facing clip. Then place a light grey 1x1 tile on top.

Step 37.1

Let's make another part! Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with 2 bars in front of you.

Step 37.2

Horizontally place a blue 1x2 jumper plate on top.

Step 37.3

Attach a transparent light blue 1x1 round plate to the 1x1 plate part of a 1x1 plate with 1x2 side studs. Now horizontally attach the 1x2 side studs of your part underneath the 1x2 plate with 2 bars so the 1x1 round plate faces the left.

Step 37.4

Attach the left-facing bar of your part to the right-facing clip of your previous part. Make sure the 1x1 round plate underneath faces the left.

Step 38

Now rotate your main build 180 degrees so the 2x2 dish faces the right. Now horizontally attach the right-facing bar of your part to the rightmost top-facing clip. Then attach the clip at the other end of your part to the top-facing clip on the left side.

Steps 39 to 40

Locate 4 transparent light blue 1x1 round plates. This is ammo for the stud shooters! Insert them into the shooters, then shoot them out!
