Welcome to Text-Based Building Instructions from Bricks for the Blind. Here is some helpful information on how to best use screen readers and browsers: <https://bricksfortheblind.org/help-with-screen-readers>. Before you start building, here are some terms we will be using:

- In Front of/Front: towards you.
- Behind/Back: away from you.
- Up: towards the ceiling.
- Down: towards the floor.
- Stud: the bump on a LEGO brick. Example: A 2x1 brick has two studs on it.
- Vertically: with the longest side going from front to back

- Horizontally: with the longest side going from left to right.
- Upright: pointing up towards the ceiling.
- Standing upright: The piece is perpendicular to the ground, like a wall.
- Lying flat: The piece is parallel to the ground, like a piece of toast which fell off the table.
- That one/ppp: previously placed piece.
- Plate: piece with studs.
- Tile: smooth piece without studs (unless otherwise specified)
- A jumper plate is a 1x2 plate with a single stud on top, or a 1x3 plate with only two studs on top.
- "Anti-stud" is a term for the portion of a LEGO piece which accepts studs, like the bottom of a plate or brick.
- Symmetrically: a mirror image. Example: If you place a 2x1 brick with technic connector on the front wall at the right, connector to the front, and then place another such piece symmetrically on the back wall, at the right, the technic connector of the second piece should point to the back, since it will be placed symmetrically.
- Centered-vertically: even amount of space in front of and behind piece
- Centered-horizontally: even amount of space left and right of piece.
- Row: studs lined up horizontally (left to right/side to side).
- Column: studs lined up upright or vertically (top to bottom/back to front).

A note on LEGO Technic™ part names. These parts are somewhat different from regular LEGO bricks. Here are some definitions in case the builder or helper is not familiar with LEGO Technic™.

Axles - An axle is a connector which has an X shaped cross-section. Because their cross section is not round, anything connected to an axle using an axle-hole will rotate with that axle. Axles are longer than they are wide, and the length of an axle corresponds with how many bricks long it is. Aka a 3L axle is three bricks long. Axles come in a variety of lengths, with a 2L axle being the shortest available. They may be combined with pins, or have circular stops on them. A stop prevents the axle from sliding through an axle-hole at a specific point on the axle.

Pins - A pin is a connector which has a circular cross section and a flanged notch out of one or both ends. This flanged notch allows them to click into bricks with a pin-hole. Pins come with and without friction ridges, which are small bumps on the pin which prevent them from rotating freely. For standard pins, black is a high friction pin, and gray is a low friction pin. A standard length pin is two brick lengths long, with a stop in the middle. This prevents a brick from being pushed from one side of the pin to the other. A 1L pin is one brick long and still retains the stop, however it also includes a hollow stud at the other end. A 3L pin is three bricks long, and only contains a stop at one side, allowing two bricks to be pushed onto the other side of the pin. Pins may also have one side which is an axle.

Technic brick - a brick which contains one or more holes which accept technic pins.

Lift-arms - A lift-arm is a basic structural element, similar to a brick or a plate, but usually without any studs. It is a beam with rounded ends and with holes in it, with the same spacing as the studs on a LEGO brick. lift-arms come in a variety of lengths, including a 1x1 lift-arm which looks like a cylinder. Thick lift-arms are as wide as a LEGO brick, and thin lift-arms are half as wide as a LEGO brick, but not the same thickness as a LEGO plate! The holes in a lift-arm may accept axles or pins. They also come in a variety of shapes, including tees, ells and triangles.

Gears - A gear is a functional element. They are typically discs with teeth on the outside, there are also worm gears which look like a spiraling cylinder! Gears connected by axles transmit or even transform rotational motion!

Axle and Pin Connectors - These elements are typically smaller than lift-arms and are used to connect some combination of pins or axles. They might have pins or axles, as well as axle or pin-holes. They have a lot of different angle combinations! The simplest just connects two axles or pins together in a straight line.

Bushes/Bushings - LEGO Technic™ uses bushes largely as spacers, but they also can reduce friction between rotating parts, or can form useful elements such as handles. Bushes are typically light gray, generally cylindrical, and have an axle-hole running through the middle. They have a flange at the front and back to make them easier to pull on and off.

For builders with low vision, or a sighted building partner may want to follow along with the printed visual instructions that come with each kit, or PDF versions are always online at LEGO.com for each set: (<https://www.lego.com/en-us/service/buildinginstructions/76340>) As low vision users may benefit from viewing the instructions on a personal device where they can zoom in on content and use assistive technologies to enhance the visuals.

The box folds down into a mat, the mat features a top down view of a few snowy lit up houses surrounding a christmas tree with a bunch of presents at its base!

The windows that we'll be opening are arranged in 4 rows of six windows. No grouping instructions are provided, since each build is very small.

We don't want to spoil each day's surprise for you, so we'll put lots of ***s between each day. ,

The box should be oriented with the fold-out mat on the table. The windows themselves are decorated with lit up buildings on a snowy night! The fold-out mat is decorated with a street, snow, and a pond!

Let's get to building!

Day 1: (2nd row from the bottom of the leftmost column.)

Step 1

Locate 1 dark red pair of legs printed with gold armor, 1 dark red torso printed with red and gold armor, and a light blue core, 1 light tan head printed with eyes and light blue glasses, 1 dark red helmet, 1 dark red and gold face shield, and 1 transparent blue popsicle. Assemble your minifigure, attach the face shield to the front of the helmet then put it on him, then attach the popsicle to his hand!

Today, we made Iron Man!

Day 2: (2nd row from the top of the 3rd column from the left.)

Step 1

Place a dark green 3x3 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a white 1x3 slope brick on the back row so it slopes to the left. Now vertically place a white 1x2 inverted arch brick on the front right corner so it slopes to the front.

Step 2

Horizontally place a white 1x1 round plate on the front left corner. Then stack 2 more to the right of the ppp. Now horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a stud and a clip behind the 3 ppp so the clip is on the left.

Step 3

Attach the handle of a dark green bar holder with a handle to the top-facing clip so the bar holder faces up. Now insert the handle of a white stud shooter gun into the barholder so the gun faces the right. Now insert a dark grey trigger into the top of the ppp. Now you will have 3 extra white 1x1 round plates. You can insert these into the gun and shoot them out!

Today, we made a snow blaster!

Day 3: (Top right corner.)

Step 1

Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs, 1 dark blue torso printed with a red and white belt, blue armor, and a silver star on his chest, 1 light tan head printed with eyes and a smirk, 1 light brown hair, 1 round shield printed with white and red rings with a blue center and a star in the middle, and 1 white and red candy cane. Assemble your minifigure then attach the candy cane and shield to his hands!

Today, we made Captain America!

Day 4: (2nd column from the left of the top row.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a dark grey 2x3 plate with a round side and pinhole in front of you so the round side faces the left.

Step 2

Vertically place a gold 1x2 plate with 2 bars underneath the rightmost column so the bars face the right. Then vertically place another 1 underneath the build, to the left of the ppp so the bars face the left.

Step 3

Vertically place 2 dark green 1x2 jumper plates, 1 to the right of the other, on top.

Step 4

Horizontally place a transparent black 1x2 sloped curved tile on the leftmost stud so it slopes to the left over the pinhole. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x4 tile with 2 studs to the right of the ppp so it overhangs to the right.

Step 5

Place a green 1L pin with an anti-stud on the leftmost stud of the ppp so the pin faces up. Then attach a gold pinhole with 3 blades to the ppp. Now place a dark green 1x1 slope tile on the rightmost stud so it slopes to the left.

Today, we made a helicopter!

Day 5: (3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the top.)

Step 1

Place a blue 1x1 plate with an upright side stud in front of you so the side stud faces the right. Then vertically place a white boomerang on top so it faces the front left and back left. Now place a red 1x1 slope tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the right.

Step 2

Place a white 1x1 plate upright on the right-facing side stud. Then place a blue 1x1 plate with an upright side stud, upright on the right-facing side stud, so the side stud faces up. Now place a white 1x1 star on top.

Step 3

Place a red 1x1 brick with an axle hole upright on the right-facing side stud so the axle hole faces the front and back. Then insert a light grey 3L axle into the axle hole so it is centered vertically.

Step 4

Place a blue 1x1 round tile with an upright bar, upright on the right-facing side stud. Then attach a small black pin with 2 propellers to the right-facing bar so it faces the front and back.

Step 5

Vertically attach the axle hole of a red left wing with 2 axle holes to the front-facing axle so the smooth side is on top, the short end faces the front, and the other axle hole faces the right. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Today, we made a plane!

Day 6: (3rd column from the left of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Note that today, there are some pieces that are the same but different color.

Step 1

Horizontally place a black 2x4 plate with 4 side studs hanging down in front of you so the side studs face the front. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 log brick underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a gold 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on the back left corner. Then place a red 2x2 corner tile on the 2 leftmost columns so it looks like the braille letter j. Now attach a red axle connector with a curved wing to the top-facing bar so the curved part is on the left and it faces the front.

Step 3

Place a red 2x2 tile with a stud on the 2 rightmost columns. Then place a red 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a purple 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Then place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. This is a present!

Step 4

Place a gold 1x1 round plate upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 slope tile printed with buttons upright to the right of the ppp so it slopes up.

Step 5

Let's make a part! Place a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar in front of you so the bar faces the right. Then attach the barholder of a barholder with a handle to the right-facing bar. Now attach a light grey bent arm with 2 clips to the right-facing bar so the other clip faces the top right. Then attach a gold pair of scissors to the top right clip so the scissor blades face the top left.

Step 6

Place the 1x1 round plate with a bar of your part upright on the rightmost front-facing side stud so the scissors are on top.

Today, we made a robotic table that makes presents!

Day 7: (Bottom left corner.)

Step 1

Locate 1 silver pair of legs printed with armor, 1 green torso printed with a brown belt, a gold buckle, and silver arms, 1 silver head printed with eyes, wrinkles, and a grin, 1 green hood, and 1 red and white candy cane. Assemble your minifigure then attach the candy cane to his hand!

Step 2

Let's make a part! Place a dark green 1x1 stack of balls on top of a tan 1x1 ice cream cone. Now attach it to his other hand!

Today, we made Doom!

Day 8: (2nd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Bring back your Doom minifigure from yesterday and take off his head as well as his hood!

Step 2

Place the green cape around the neck bar so it is on his back, then place the head and hood back on!

Today, we put on Doom's cape!

Day 9: (3rd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Let's make a part! Let's make the camera! Place a red 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 telescope bar on top of the ppp. Now place a blue 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on top of the ppp.

Step 2

Vertically place a black camera on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the left. Now place a black 1x1 round brick upright on the left-facing side stud. Now place a transparent aqua 1x1 round tile upright on the left-facing side stud.

Step 3

Let's make a part! Let's make a light! Place a red 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 telescope bar on top of the ppp. Now place a blue 1x1 tile with a clip on top of the ppp so the clip hands face the left and right.

Step 4

Vertically attach the bar of a dark grey 1x2 plate with a bar to the top-facing clip so the studs face the right. Now place a black 2x2 sloped curved tile upright on the right-facing side studs so it slopes up and overhangs 1 row to the top. Now place a transparent 2x2 inverted plate with a rounded bottom upright on the 2x2 left-facing anti-studs.

Step 5

Let's make a part! Let's make a chair! Place a red 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 plate with 2x2 upright side studs on the left column so the side studs face the left. Now place a white 2x2 tile with 2 studs upright on the left-facing side studs so the studs are on the bottom.

Step 6

Vertically place a blue 1x2 rounded plate on the right column. Then place a white 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top so the studs are on the left.

Today we made a photo shoot!

Day 10: (Top left corner.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 log brick underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a dark red 1x1 minifigure statue on the front left corner. Then place a dark green 2x2 round tile with a stud to the right of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and vertically. Now place a gold 1x1 skate on top of the ppp so the rounded lip faces the front. Then place a dark red 1x1 slope tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

Step 3

Place a dark blue 1x1 plate on the front right corner. Then place a blue 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp.

Step 4

Place a dark grey 1x1 telescope bar on the back left corner. Then place a dark green 1x1 tile with a clip on top of the ppp so the clip hands face the left and right. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the right. Then horizontally attach a light brown ladder to the 2 top-facing clips.

Today, we made a table display!

Day 11: (2nd column from the left of the 2nd row from the top.)

Step 1

Locate 1 black pair of legs, 1 white torso printed with a black chest, 1 white head printed with white eyes with a magenta outline, 1 white hood, 1 dark tan pair of chopsticks, 1 white 1x1 disc, and 1 tan dumplings. Assemble your minifigure, put the dumplings on the disc, then attach the chopsticks and the disc to her hands! This is a plate of dumplings!

Today, we made Ghost Spider!

Day 12: (2nd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a black 2x3 plate in front of you. Then place a red 2x2 plate with 2 pinholes underneath the 2 leftmost columns so the pinholes face the front and back. Now place another 1 to the right of the ppp, underneath the 2x3 plate so 1 column is exposed to the right and the pinholes face the front and back.

Step 2

Vertically place a black 1x2 panel with 3 walls on the rightmost column so the long wall faces the right. Then vertically place a black 1x2 tile with an upright horizontal bar to the left of the ppp so it slopes to the right.

Step 3

Vertically stack 2 blue 1x2 plates to the left of the ppp. Then vertically place a blue 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the leftmost column so the side studs face the left. Now horizontally place a red 1x2 ingot tile upright on the left-facing side studs.

Step 4

Horizontally place 2 transparent aqua 1x2 sloped curved tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the 2 leftmost columns so they slope to the left.

Today, we made a car!

Day 13: (3rd column from the right of the top row.)

Step 1

Place a white 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place 2 black 2x2 plates with pinholes underneath, 1 to the right of the other, underneath the ppp so together they are centered horizontally and the pinholes face the front and back. They will expose 1 column to the left and right.

Step 2

Vertically place a white 1x2 tile with a round side on the leftmost column so the round side faces the left. Then place 2 transparent pink 1x1 slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, to the right of the ppp so they slope to the left.

Step 3

Vertically place a white 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the rightmost column so the side studs face the right. Now place a white 2x2 sloped curved brick with 2 studs on the 2 rightmost columns so it slopes to the right and the studs are on the left.

Step 4

Horizontally place a black 1x2 rounded plate upright on the right-facing side studs. Then attach 2 transparent pink flames to the right-facing side studs so they curve up.

Step 5

Insert 2 light grey 1L pins with a stud into the 2 front-facing pinholes so the studs face the front. Then place 2 black 1x1 discs upright on the 2 front-facing side studs. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the back.

Today, we made a car!

Day 14: (Leftmost column of the 2nd row from the top.)

Note that today, there are some pieces that are the same but different color.

Step 1

Let's make an American flag themed present! Place a red 2x2 round plate in front of you. Then place a white 2x2 round plate on top of the ppp. Now place a blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Then place a white 1x1 star on top of the ppp.

Step 2

Let's make an Iron Man themed present! Horizontally place a dark red 2x3 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark red 1x2 plate underneath the ppp so it is centered horizontally. Now vertically place a gold 1x2 plate underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Vertically place a dark red 1x2 jumper plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Then place a transparent aqua 1x1 round tile on top of the ppp. Now vertically place a gold 1x2 ingot tile on the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Let's make a Doom themed present! Place a dark grey 1x1 plate with an upright side stud in front of you so the side stud faces the left. Then place a dark green 1x1 half cylinder brick upright on the left-facing side stud so it slopes up and down.

Step 5

Place a dark green 1x1 brick on top. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate with a handlebar on top of the ppp so the handlebar faces the right.

Step 6

Let's make a Wolverine themed present! Place a yellow 2x2 plate in front of you. Then place a black 2x2 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a yellow 2x2 tile with a stud on top of the ppp. Now place a black 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves on top of the ppp so the leaves face the back right.

Today, we made presents!

Day 15: (Rightmost column of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Locate 1 blue pair of legs, 1 red and blue torso printed with a web and a spider on his chest, 1 red head printed with white eyes and a web, 2 white ski sticks, and 2 red skis. Assemble your minifigure, attach the skis to his feet so the round sides face the front, and then attach the ski sticks to his hands!

Today, we made Spider-Man skiing!

Day 16: (3rd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Place a black 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a white 5.5L bar with an anti stud on top so the bar faces up.

Step 2

Place a white 1x1 brick with side studs on each side on top so the top-facing stud is on top. Now place a white 1x1 slope tile upright on the left-facing side stud so it slopes down. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Place a green 1x1 round plate with 3 leaves upright on the front-facing side stud so the leaves face the right. Then place a magenta 1x1 round flower plate upright on the ppp.

Step 4

Place a transparent yellow head on top. Now place a white 2x2 dish on top of the ppp.

Today, we made a lamp post!

Day 17: (2nd column from the left of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 log brick underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a white 1x1 coffee cup on the front right corner. Then place a pink 1x1 mug on the front left corner. Now place a brown 1x1 cone brick to the right of the ppp. Then place a black 1x1 round plate with a bar hanging down on top of the ppp so the bar is in the front. Now place a brown 1x1 slope tile on top of the ppp so it slopes to the front.

Step 3

Place a white 1x1 telescope bar on the back left corner. Then place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Horizontally place a light brown 1x4 plate on top of the back row. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate with 2 upright side studs on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a white 1x4 double sloped curved tile on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Step 5

Horizontally place a white 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate with 3 leaves upright on the ppp so the leaves face the right. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate upright on the ppp.

Step 6

Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Place a pink 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a pink 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now place this next to your table!

Today, we made a hot chocolate table!

Day 18: (3rd column from the left of the top row.)

Step 1

Place a white 2x2 half dome brick in front of you. Then place a red 1x1 brick with 2 side studs on top of the ppp so the side studs face the left and right.

Step 2

Place a blue 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down on top of the ppp so the side stud faces the front.

Step 3

Place a white head on top of the ppp. Now place a white 1x1 star upright on the front-facing side stud.

Step 4

Place a dark blue helmet on top of the head so the 2 eye holes face the front. Now place a black top hat on top of the ppp so the little bar is inserted into the tiny hole that is on the helmet.

Step 5

Insert a brown claw to the left-facing side stud so the claw hands face the front and back. Then repeat symmetrically to the right. Now attach a black shovel to the right-facing claw so the shovel head is on top.

Today, we made a Captain America snowman!

Day 19: (2nd column from the left of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a light grey 1x4 plate on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Vertically place a black 1x2 plate with 2 side studs hanging down on the leftmost column so it is centered vertically and the side studs face the left. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Place a dark grey 2x2 plate on top so it is centered horizontally. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 slope brick on the back row of the ppp so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally place a black 1x2 tile in front of the ppp.

Step 4

Place a dark grey 1x1 round tile with an upright bar on the front left corner. Then horizontally place a tiny bar with 2 rotors on top of the ppp. Now repeat both parts symmetrically to the back. Then repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Step 5

Horizontally place a light grey 1x2 tri-slope tile upright on the left-facing side studs so it slopes down. Then place 2 transparent orange 1x1 round plates, 1 in front of the other, upright on the right-facing side studs.

Step 6

Horizontally place the middle anti-stud of a black 1x3 tile on the front stud of the rightmost column so it is centered horizontally on it, diagonal, and faces the front left and back right.

Today, we made the Avengers helicarrier!

Day 20: (2nd column from the right of the bottom row.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a light brown 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a brown 1x2 log brick underneath the leftmost column. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 2

Place a blue 2x2 round tile with a stud on top so it is centered horizontally. Then place a red 1x1 cupcake wrapper on top of the ppp. Now place a white 1x1 swirl on top of the ppp.

Step 3

Place a light brown 1x1 round tile printed with a cookie on the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Place a red 1x1 telescope bar on the back left corner. Then place a blue 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Then repeat both parts symmetrically to the right.

Step 5

Horizontally place a light brown 1x4 plate on top of the back row. Then horizontally place a dark tan 1x2 plate with 2 upright side studs on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally and the side studs face the front. Now horizontally place a red 1x4 double sloped curved tile on top of the ppp so it is centered horizontally.

Step 6

Horizontally place a blue 1x2 jumper plate upright on the front-facing side studs. Then place a green 1x1 round flower plate with 3 leaves upright on the ppp so the leaves face the right. Now place a red 1x1 round flower plate upright on the ppp.

Step 7

Let's make a part! Let's make a present! Place a red 1x1 plate in front of you. Then place a blue 1x1 plate on top of the ppp. Now place a red 1x1 round flower plate on top of the ppp. Now place this next to your table!

Today, we made a snack table!

Day 21: (2nd column from the right of the top row.)

Step 1

Locate 1 dark blue pair of legs, 1 light blue torso printed with a red core with a yellow X on it, 1 light tan head printed with eyes and lips, 1 yellow and black helmet with winged ears, and 2 silver claws. Assemble your minifigure then attach the claws to his hands!

Today, we made Wolverine!

Day 22: (3rd column from the right of the 2nd row from the bottom.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then vertically place a dark blue 1x2 brick with 2 side studs on the leftmost column so the side studs face the left.

Step 2

Horizontally place a dark blue 1x2 slope tile upright on the left-facing side studs so it slopes down. Then place 2 transparent red 1x1 slope tiles, 1 in front of the other, on the leftmost column so they slope to the left.

Step 3

Vertically place a dark grey 1x2 plate with a hinge on the rightmost column so the hinge faces the right. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 plate with 2 clips on the front row, to the left of the ppp so the clips face the front. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Step 4

Place a dark blue 2x2 plate on the 2 rightmost columns. Then vertically place a black 1x2 grill tile to the left of the ppp.

Step 5

Vertically place a black 1x2 tile with an upright horizontal bar on the rightmost column so it slopes to the left. Now horizontally attach a black hockey stick to the front-facing clips so it is centered horizontally and the curved part is on the left and faces up. Then repeat symmetrically to the back.

Today, we made a sled!

Day 23: (Rightmost column of the 2nd row from the top.)

Step 1

Horizontally place a dark blue 2x4 plate in front of you. Then horizontally place a light grey 1x2 plate with a hinge connector on the back row so it is centered horizontally and the hinge connector faces the back. Then horizontally place a dark grey 1x2 rounded plate in front of the ppp.

Step 2

Place a dark blue 2x2 tile with 2 studs on top of the 2 ppp so the studs are in the front. Now place a dark blue 2x2 plate with a cutoff corner on the leftmost column so 1 column overhangs to the left and the cutoff corner faces the front left corner. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 3

Place a dark grey 1x1 plate with a side stud hanging down on the front left corner so the side stud faces the front. Then place another 1 behind the ppp so the side stud faces the back. Then vertically place a dark blue 1x2 slope brick on top of the 2 ppp so it slopes to the back. Now repeat everything symmetrically to the right.

Step 4

Place a transparent orange 1x1 round plate upright on the leftmost front-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Step 5

Place a yellow 1x1 round tile upright on the leftmost back-facing side stud. Then repeat symmetrically to the right.

Today, we made an aircraft!

Day 24: (Bottom right corner.)

Step 1

Place a brown 2x2 dish in front of you. Then place a white 1x1 brick on top of the ppp. Now place a dark green 1x1 brick with 4 side studs on top of the ppp.

Step 2

Place the top row of a green 2x2 corner slope brick upright on the front-facing side stud so 1 column overhangs to the right and it slopes to the top right. Now place a gold 1x1 round plate upright on the front-facing side stud.

Step 3

Repeat the previous step on the right-facing side, back-facing side, and left-facing side.

Step 4

Place a dark green 1x1 brick with 4 side studs on top so it is diagonal.

Step 5

Place a green 1x1 round plate upright on the front left facing side stud. Then place a gold 1x1 round plate upright on the ppp. Now place a green claw upright on the ppp so the claws face down. Then repeat everything symmetrically to the other 3 side studs.

Step 6

Place a green 1x1 round plate on top. Then insert the bar of a gold 1x1 round plate with a bar into the ppp so the side stud faces the front. Now place a gold 1x1 star upright on the front-facing side stud of the ppp.

Today, we made a Christmas tree!
